A		BEDROCK 50087-7 Parchment	1 5/8	(6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips for length using diagonal seams. From the long strip, subcut the following: (2) 2 1/2" x 50 1/2" Side Border strips. (2) 2 1/2" x 54 1/2" Top/Bottom Border strips. (24) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut the following: (26) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. (50) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles. (24) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles.
B		53095-1 White	3/8	Fussy cut (4) 6 1/2" squares.
C		53095-2 Light Grey	3/8	Fussy cut (4) 6 1/2" squares.
D		53095-3 Navy	3/8	Fussy cut (4) 6 1/2" squares.
E		53096-5 Pale Yellow	1/4	(1) 6 1/2" square.
F		53096-6 Blue	1/2	(2) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (8) 6 1/2" squares.
G		53097-8 Yellow	1/4	(1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 6 1/2" squares.
H		53099-1 White	5/8	(10) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut the following: (24) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles. (24) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles.
I		53099-3 Navy INCLUDES BINDING	3/4	(4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut the following: (8) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles. (8) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles. FOR BINDING: (6) 2 1/4" x WOF strips for binding.
J		53099-9 Grey	1/4	(4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut the following: (8) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles. (8) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles.
K		53099-10 Red	3/8	(5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut the following: (10) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles. (10) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles.

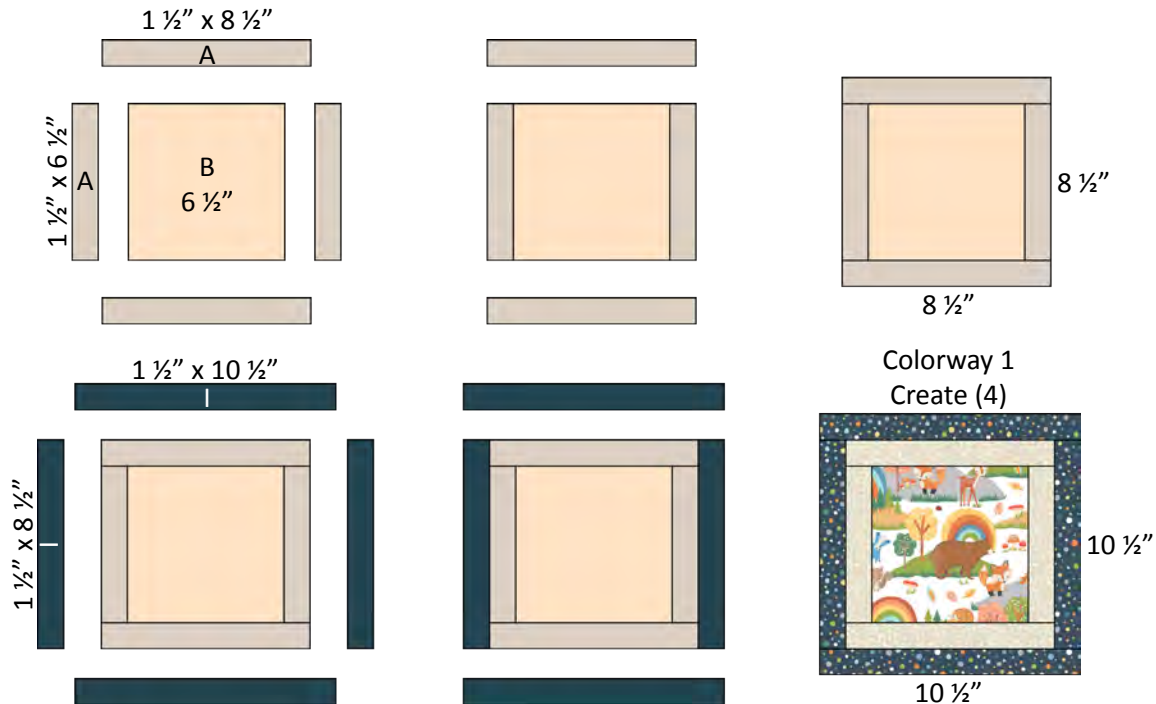

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

Designer Note: Blocks are pieced using the courthouse steps method. Sew the rectangles onto the center square in the order written. The quilt features blocks in (6) Colorways. Diagrams indicate piecing methods using Colorway 1. A written guide and diagrams show accurate fabric combinations for each additional colorway.

1. Create Block Colorway 1. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric A** rectangle to either side of (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric B** square. Press outward.
2. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric A** rectangle to the top and bottom of the same **Fabric B** square. Press outward. The block should measure $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished at this step.
3. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric I** rectangle to either side of the block. Press outward.
4. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric I** rectangle to the top and bottom of the same block. Press outward to complete block assembly. Block should measure $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
5. Repeat to create (4) identical Block Colorway 1.



6. Repeat the assembly methods described above to create Block Colorways 2-6. Use the fabric combinations, diagrams and quantities listed and shown below and on Page 3.

a. Colorway 2: Create (8)

Fabric F: $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Fabric H: $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " and $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

Fabric A: $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " and $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

b. Colorway 3: Create (4)

Fabric G: $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Fabric A: $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " and $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

Fabric K: $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " and $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

c. Colorway 4: Create (4)

Fabric C: 6 ½" square.

Fabric H: 1 ½" x 6 ½" and 1 ½" x 8 ½" rectangles.

Fabric A: 1 ½" x 8 ½" and 1 ½" x 10 ½" rectangles.

d. Colorway 5: Create (4)

Fabric D: 6 ½" square.

Fabric A: 1 ½" x 6 ½" and 1 ½" x 8 ½" rectangles.

Fabric J: 1 ½" x 8 ½" and 1 ½" x 10 ½" rectangles.

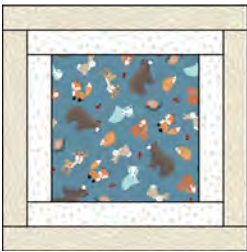
e. Colorway 6: Create (1)

Fabric E: 6 ½" square.

Fabric A: 1 ½" x 6 ½" and 1 ½" x 8 ½" rectangles.

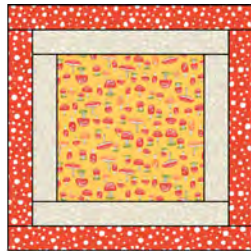
Fabric K: 1 ½" x 8 ½" and 1 ½" x 10 ½" rectangles.

QUILT ASSEMBLY:

7. Lay out the blocks in a 5 x 5 grid as shown in the diagram on Page 4. Note the placement of Colorways 1-6. Sew the blocks into horizontal rows first, alternating the direction in which you press the seams in each row.

8. Sew horizontal rows together to complete the quilt top center. The quilt top center should measure 50 ½" x 50 ½" unfinished.

9. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 50 ½" **Fabric A** Side Border to either side of the quilt top center. Press outward.

10. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 54 ½" **Fabric A** Top/Bottom Border to the top and bottom of the quilt top center. Press outward to complete assembly. The quilt top should measure 54 ½" x 54 ½" unfinished.

FINISHING THE QUILT:

11. Sandwich the quilt top with batting and backing. Baste quilt layers together using your preferred method.
12. Quilt as desired.
13. Bind quilt using (6) 2 1/4" x WOF **Fabric I** strips.
