

Page 2 Block Size – 24"



Fabric Requirements

2 ½ yds Ivory solid (25029-Ivory)

15/8 yds Butter print (40438-5)

1 1/3 yds Navy solid (35362N-2) - includes binding

3/4 yds Navy paisley print (40439-2)

½ yd Aqua paisley print (40439-4)

½ yd Aqua print (40438-4)

½ yd Celery paisley (40439-1)

½ yd Celery solid (35362N-1)

1 ½ yds Navy paisley outer border (40437-2)

7 2/3 yds backing (or 5 ¼ with scraps pieced up the center to expand the width)

Cutting Instructions

From the Ivory Solid, cut:

4 - 7 ½" strips; cut into 20 - 7 ½" squares

2 - 11 1/4" strips; cut into 5 - 11 1/4" squares; cut squares in half diagonally twice

14 - 2 ½" strips; cut into 216 - 2 ½" squares, cut 72 of these squares in half diagonally once



Page 3

From the Butter Print cut:

4 – 7 ½" strips; cut into 16 – 7 ½" squares

2 - 11 1/4" strips; cut into 4 - 11 1/4" squares; cut squares in half diagonally twice

From the Navy Solid cut:

9 - 2 ½" strips; cut into 144 - 2 ½" squares

9 - 2 1/4" strips for binding

From the Navy Paisley cut:

4 - 2 1/8" strips; cut into 72 - 2 1/8" squares

6 - 2 1/8" strips; cut into 72 - 45° diamonds

From both the Aqua Paisley and Aqua Print cut:

3 – 3 7/8" strips; cut into 20 – 45° diamonds

From both the Celery Paisley and Celery Solid cut:

3 - 3 7/8" strips; cut into 16 - 45° diamonds

From the Outer Border cut 8 - 6 1/2" strips

Piecing Instructions

Using the Ivory Solid 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and the Navy Solid 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, make 288 Half Square Triangles.

Trim to 2 1/8" if necessary.

Sew HST into pairs, half like this:



And half like this:




Add an Ivory triangle to the end of each pair to achieve this:





Using 36 - 2 1/8" navy paisley squares, make 36 Unit A:





Using the remaining 36 - 21/8" squares and the 72 - 21/8" diamonds, make 18 Unit B with Ivory and 18 Unit B with Yellow Print.




Mark 3 7/8" diamonds at 3 corners with ¼" seam allowance. You will need to stop sewing at the intersections of these marks to help with your set-in seams.




Sew Aqua Paisley and Aqua print diamonds into pairs making sure all pairs have the fabrics in the same position.

Sew Green Paisley and Green Solid diamonds into pairs, also making sure all pairs have the fabrics in the same position.

Sew a Unit A into the right angle made by each pair of diamonds.



Sew two of these units together.

Sew a Unit B into the right angle created in this pair of diamonds. Pair the Ivory Solid Unit B with the Aqua diamonds and the Yellow Print Unit B with the Green diamonds.

Sew star halves together across the middle. Add a Unit B to the remaining two sides.



Complete blocks by adding the 7 ½" squares to the four corners.

You should have 5 blocks with Ivory backgrounds and 4 with Yellow Print backgrounds.

Sew blocks together in 3 rows of 3. Measure well and add borders. Quilt and bind.
