Piecing Instructions: (Refer to unit and block images below for proper placement and rotation)

1. Draw diagonal line on back of the following 3" squares: 72 C, 144 F and 72 G.

UNIT 1:

2. Place (1) **G** 3" square right sides together with (1) **D** 3" X 5-1/2" rectangle and sew on diagonal line. Press, then trim excess fabric on reverse side to ½". Repeat on other side of **D** rectangle using (1) **F** 3" square. Square to 3" X 5-1/2", make (36).











UNIT 2:

3. Place (1) **G** 3" square right sides together with (1) **D** 3" X 5-1/2" rectangle and sew on diagonal line. Press, then trim excess fabric on reverse side to ½". Repeat on other side of **D** rectangle using (1) **F** 3" square. Square to 3" X 5-1/2", make (36).











UNIT 3:

4. Place (1) **F** 3" square right sides together in bottom left corner of (1) **B** 5-1/2" square and sew on diagonal line. Press, then trim excess fabric on reverse side to ½". Repeat on bottom right corner of **B** square using (1) **F** 3" square. Square to 5-1/2", make (36).











UNIT 4:

5. Place (1) **C** 3" square right sides together with (1) **E** 3" X 5-1/2" rectangle and sew on diagonal line. Press, then trim excess fabric on reverse side to ½". Repeat on other side of **E** rectangle using (1) **C** 3" square. Square to 3" X 5-1/2", make (36).

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

BLOCK 1:

6. Sew (1) **UNIT 1** to the right side of (1) **G** 5-1/2" square, then sew (1) **E** 3" square to the right of (1) **UNIT 2.** Sew together create **BLOCK 1**. Square to 8", make (36).

BLOCK 2:

7. Sew (1) UNIT 4 to the bottom of (1) UNIT 3 to create BLOCK 2. Square to 5-1/2" X 8", make (36).





Assembly Instructions

(Refer to quilt diagram for proper placement and rotation of blocks)

Quilt Assembly:

8. Sew pieces and/or blocks together into horizontal rows, then sew rows together.

ROWS 1, 3, 4, 6, 7 and 9: B1 – B2 – B1 – B1 – B2 – B1 – B1 – B2 – B1 ROWS 2, 5 and 8: B2 – A 5-1/2" square – B2 – B2 – A 5-1/2" square – B2 – B2 – A 5-1/2" square – B2

Border Assembly:

Border 1:

- 9. SIDE BORDER UNITS: Sew the following together, make (2), then sew to sides of quilt.
 G 3" X 8" strip B 3" X 5-1/2" rectangle G 3" X 15-1/2" strip B 3" X 5-1/2" rectangle G 3" X 15-1/2" strip B 3" X 5-1/2" rectangle G 3" X 8" strip
- 10. <u>TOP/BOTTOM BORDER UNITS</u>: Sew the following together, make (2), then top and bottom of quilt.

G 3" X 10-1/2" strip - B 3" X 5-1/2" rectangle - G 3" X 15-1/2" strip - B 3" X 5-1/2" rectangle - G 3" X 15-1/2" strip - B 3" X 5-1/2" rectangle - G 3" X 10-1/2" strip

Border #2

11. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 65-1/2"), cut (2) **B** 3" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 70-1/2") cut (2) **B** 3" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
