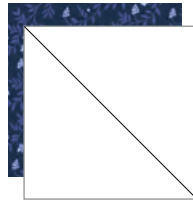
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STAR BLOCKS

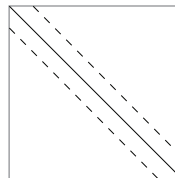
- 1. Half-Square Triangles (HST):** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **J** 4-1/2" square. Place **J** square, right sides together, on (1) **E** 4-1/2" square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) HSTs. Open and press. Make (8).



Draw diagonal line on wrong side of **J**.



Place **J** on **E**, right sides together.

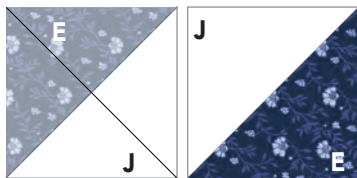


Sew a 1/4" from both sides of solid line. Cut along solid line.

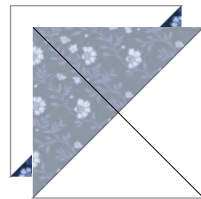


Open and press. Yield (2) HSTs. Make (8) **J/E** units.

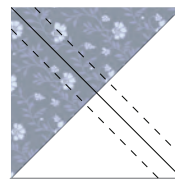
- 2. Quarter-Square Triangles (QST):** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) HST unit, across both fabrics. Place unit, **RST**, on the other HST unit, with contrasting fabrics facing each other. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) QST units. Open and press. Trim units to square up to 3-1/2".



Draw diagonal line on wrong side of **J/E**.



Place HST units, right sides together, with **E** facing opposite sides.



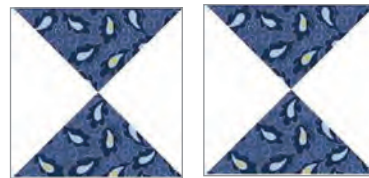
Sew a 1/4" from both sides of solid line. Cut along solid line.

Measures: 3-1/2" square unfinished



Yield (2) QST units. Make (4) **J/E** QSTs.

- Repeat **Steps 1-2** using (4) of each **J** and **H** 4-1/2" squares to make (4) QST units, measuring 3-1/2" square unfinished.



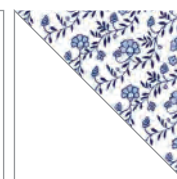
Make (4) **J/H** QSTs.

- Repeat **Step 1** using (4) of each **J** and **H** 4" squares to make (8) HSTs. Square to measure 3-1/2".



Make (8) **J/H** HSTs.

- Repeat **Step 1** using (2) of each **J** and **F** 4" squares to make (4) HSTs. Square to measure 3-1/2".



Make (4) **J/F** HSTs.



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STAR BLOCK ASSEMBLY

6. Noting rotation of units, arrange and sew:

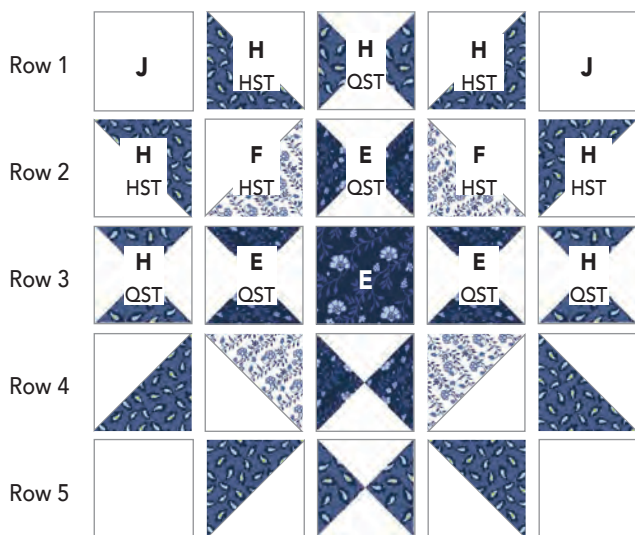
Rows 1, 5: (2) **J** 3-1/2" squares, (2) **H** HSTs and (1) **H** QST to make (2) row units.

Rows 2, 4: (2) **H** HSTs, (2) **F** HSTs and (1) **E** QST to make (2) row units.

Row 3: (2) **H** QSTs, (2) **E** QSTs and (1) **E** 3-1/2" square to make (1) row unit.

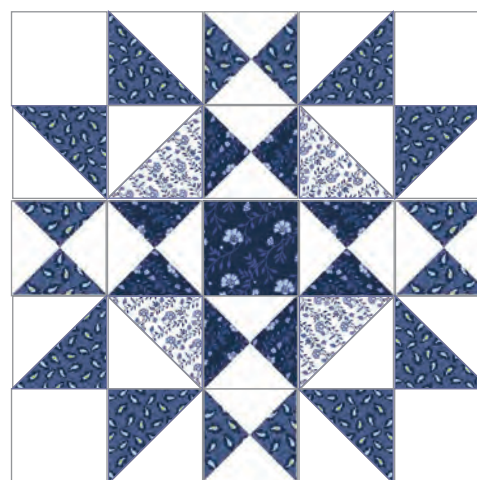
7. Sew together row units made in Step 6 to complete (1) pieced Star Block, measuring 15-1/2" square. Make (4) of **E/F/H**.

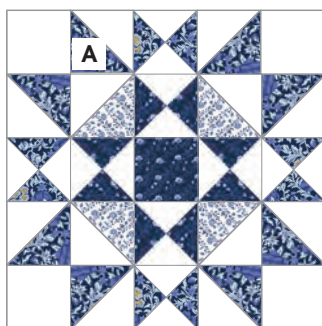

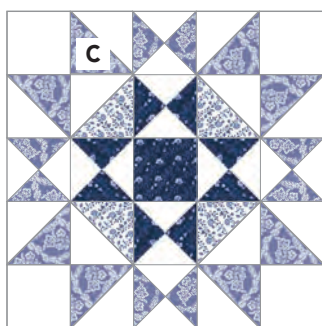

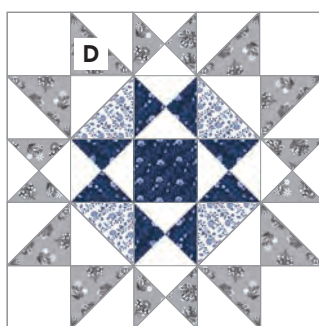
8. Using fabrics **E**, **F**, **J** and one other print, repeat Steps 1-7 to make (2) Star Blocks for each of the following:



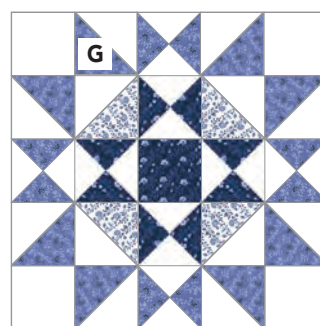

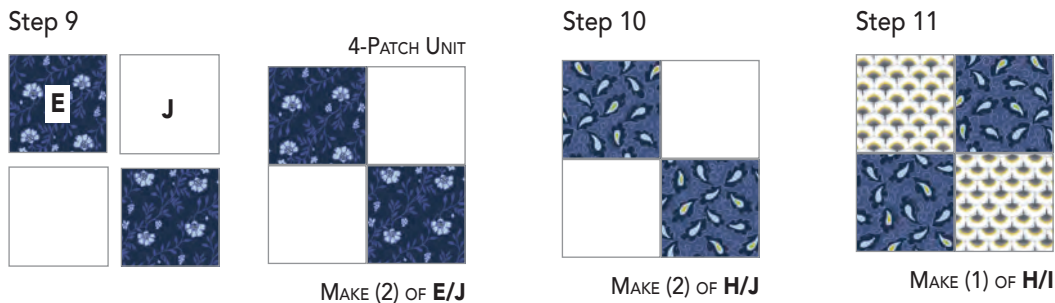


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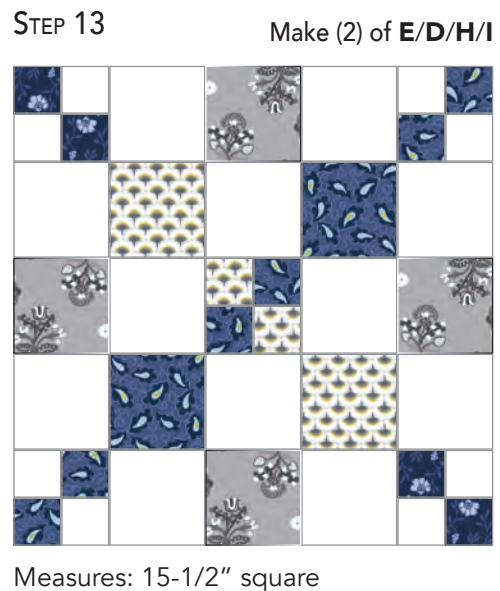
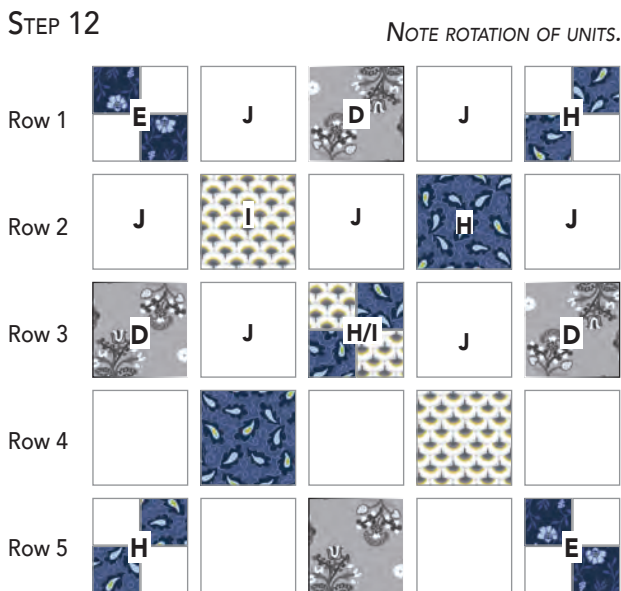
CHAIN BLOCKS

4-PATCH UNITS

- Sew together (1) **E** and **J** 2" squares. Make (2). As shown below, sew both units together to complete (1) 4-Patch Unit. Make (2).
- Repeat Step 9 using (4) each of **H** and **J** 2" squares to make (2) 4-Patch Units.
- Repeat Step 9 using (2) **H** and **I** 2" squares to make (1) 4-Patch Unit.



- Noting placement and orientation of units, arrange and sew together the following rows:
 Rows 1 and 5: (2) **J** and (1) **D** 3-1/2" squares and (1) each **E** and **H** 4-Patch Units. Make (2).
 Rows 2 and 4: (3) **J**, (1) each **H** and **I** 3-1/2" squares. Make (2).
 Row 3: (2) **J** and (2) **D** 3-1/2" squares and (1) **I/H** 4-Patch Unit. Make (1).
- Sew together Rows 1-5 to complete (1) Chain Block, measuring 15-1/2" square unfinished. Make (2).





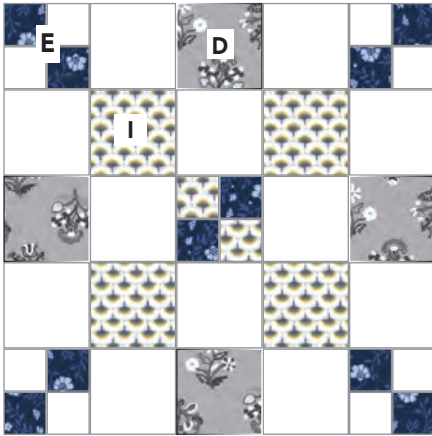
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14. Make the Chain Blocks indicated below, using (8) **J** 2" squares and (12) **J** 3-1/2" squares per block. Following are the colorway combinations:

Make (1) of **E / D / I**

2" squares : (10) **E** (2) **I**

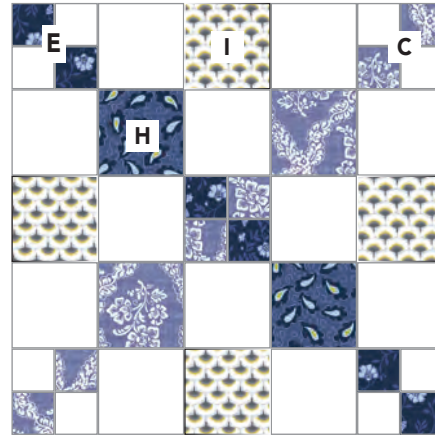
3-1/2" squares: (4) **D** (4) **I**



Make (2) of **E / I / C / H**

2" squares: (12) **C** (12) **E**

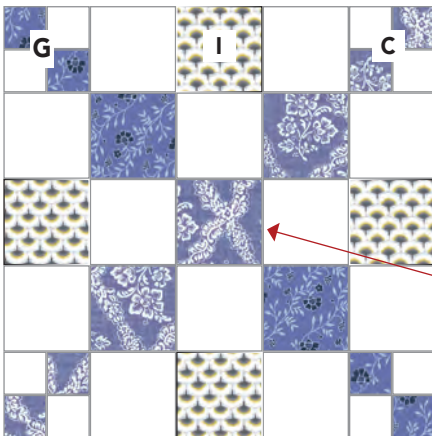
3-1/2" squares: (4) **C** (4) **H** (8) **I**



Make (4) of **G / I / C**

2" squares: (16) **C** (16) **G**

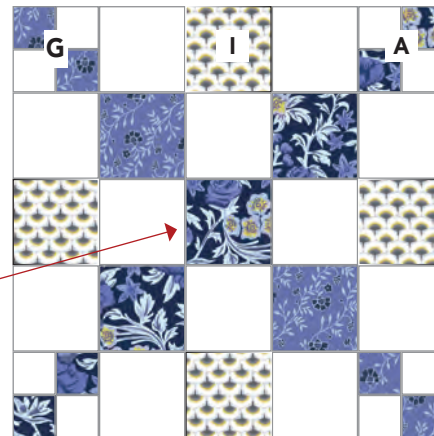
3-1/2" squares: (12) **C** (8) **G** (16) **I**



Make (4) of **G / I / A**

2" squares: (16) **A** (16) **G**

3-1/2" squares: (12) **A** (8) **G** (16) **I**



NOTE: Center unit is not a 4-Patch Unit.

15. Sashing Rows: Arrange and sew together (5) **J** 1-1/2" x 15-1/2" rectangles and (4) **E** 1-1/2" squares to make a pieced sashing row. Make (4) total.



Make (4) sashing rows.



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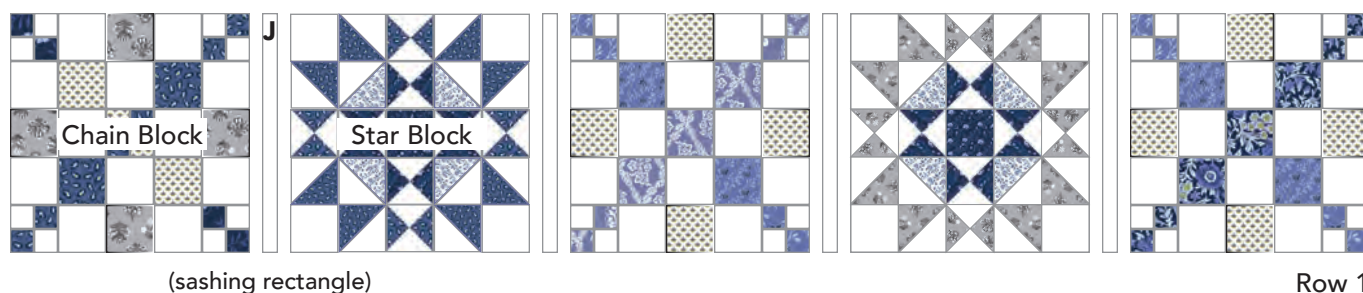
QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

16. Reference quilt image for block placement.

Pieced Rows: Arrange and sew together (5) pieced blocks and (4) **J** 1-1/2" x 15-1/2" sashing rectangles. Make (5). *Row is shown below.*

Rows 1, 3, 5: (3) Chain Blocks, (2) Star Blocks

Row 2, 4: (2) Chain Blocks, (3) Star Blocks



17. Sew together the (5) Pieced Rows and (4) Sashing Rows to complete quilt center.
See Page 8 for quilt assembly diagram.

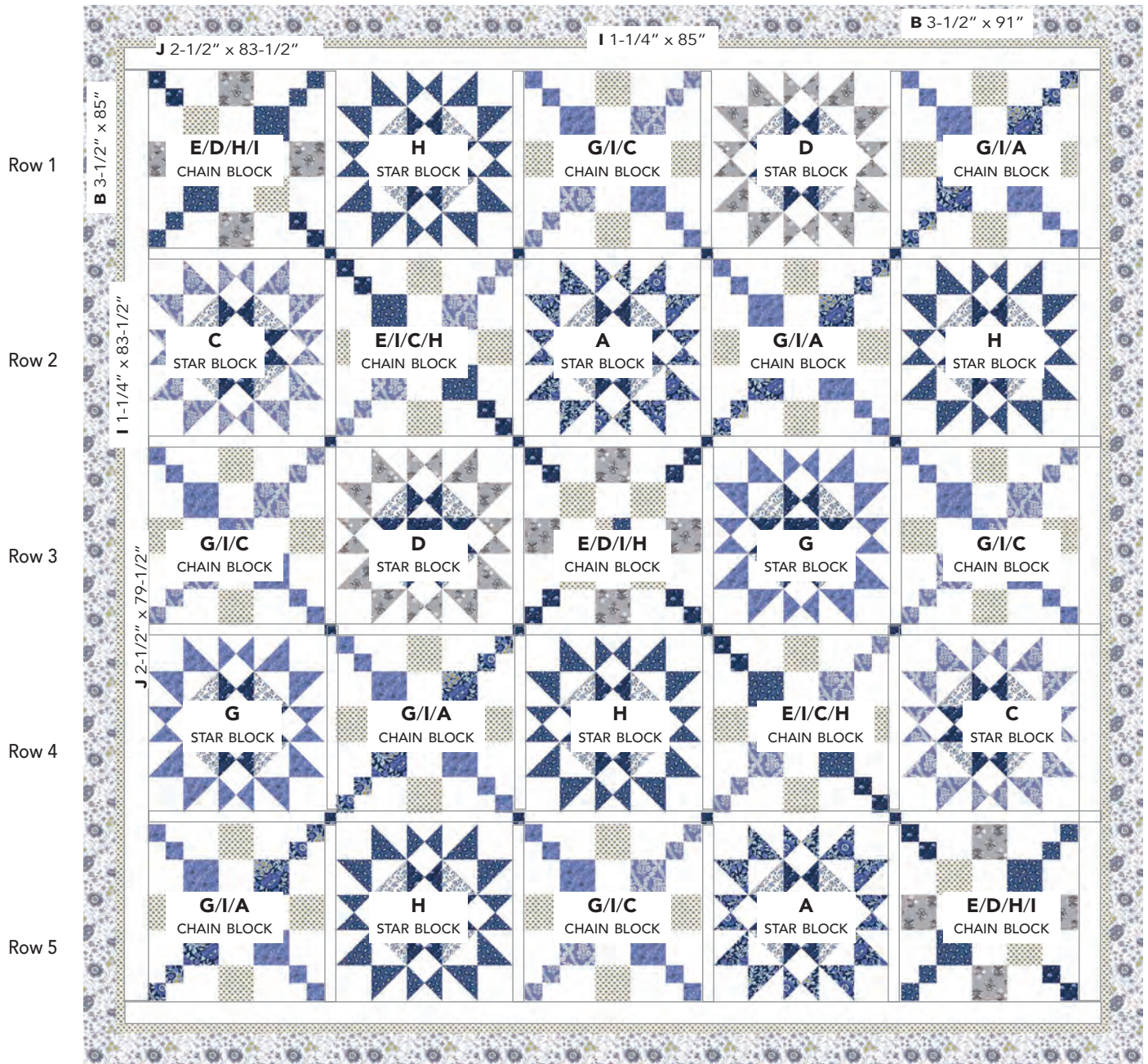
QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

18. Inner Border 1: Sew (2) **J** 2-1/2" x 79-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **J** 2-1/2" x 83-1/2" strips to the top and bottom sides of quilt center.
19. Inner Border 2: Sew (2) **I** 1-1/4" x 83-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **I** 1-1/4" x 85" strips to the top and bottom sides of quilt center.
20. Outer Border: Sew (2) **B** 3-1/2" x 85" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **B** 3-1/2" x 91" strips to the top and bottom sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.

QUILT ASSEMBLY



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **E** 2-1/4" strips.
