

BLOCKS

1. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of (160) **H** 2" squares and (32) **H** 1-1/2" squares using a marking pen. Set aside the 1-1/2" squares.





- **2.** Place (1) **H** 2" square on lower left corner of (1) **A** 3-1/2" square with right sides together. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the fabric 1/4" from the stitching as indicated by the solid line. Press the **H** piece open.
- **3.** Place (1) **H** 2" square on lower right corner of the **A** 3-1/2" square with right sides together. Sew, trim and press in the same manner to make an **A/H** square unit. Make 2.

4. Following steps 2-3, make the following square units **D/H** and **E/H**. Make 1 each.







- **5.** Arrange the **A/H, D/H** and **E/H** square units and the **A, B, C, D, E, G** and **I** 3-1/2" squares in (4) rows of (4) squares and square units each. Sew the squares and square units in each row together.
- **6.** Sew the rows together matching the seams to make star block 1. Block should measure 12-1/2" including seam allowance. Make 10.

7. Following steps 2-6, make star block 2. Note the orientation of the swags on the **B** squares since this block will be rotated 180°. Make 10.

BORDER BLOCKS

- **8.** Place (1) **H** 1-1/2" square on lower left corner of (1) **D** 1-1/2"x 2-1/2" rectangle with right sides together. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the fabric 1/4" from the stitching as indicated by the solid line. Press the **H** piece open.
- **9.** Place (1) **H** 1-1/2" square on lower right corner of the **G** 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangle with right sides together. Sew, trim and press in the same manner to make a Flying Geese unit. Make (4).







- **10.** Arrange (4) **G/H** flying geese units, (4) **G** 1-1/2" squares and (1) **B** 2-1/2" squares in (3) rows. Sew the squares and flying geese units in each row together.
- **11.** Sew the rows together to make (1) border star. Block should measure 4-1/2" square including seam allowance. Make 4.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

- **12.** Following the quilt layout on page 5, arrange (2) star block 1 and (2) star block 2 alternating with (5) \mathbf{H} 2" x 12-1/2" strips. Alternate the star block 1 and the star block 2 and note the orientation of the blocks in each row. Sew the star blocks and strips in each row together to make block rows. Make 5.
- **13.** Sew together (5) I 2" squares alternating with (4) H 2" x 12-1/2" strips to make sashing rows. Make 6.
- **14.** Sew together (6) sashing rows alternating with the (5) block rows matching seams. Note the orientation of the block rows.
- **15.** Sew (1) **G** 1-3/4" \times 69-1/2" border to each side of quilt. Sew (2) **G** 1-3/4" \times 58-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- **16.** Sew (1) **B** 4-1/2" \times 72" border to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) border star block to each end of (2) **B** 4-1/2" \times 58-1/2" borders. Sew top and bottom borders to the quilt.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **G** 2-1/4" strips.
