J		41913-2 Chocolate	3/8	Pieced blocks (2) 3.5" x 42". Subcut (15) 3.5" x 3.5" squares and (12) 2" x 3.5" rectangles.
K		41909-1 Cream	1 1/8	Setting triangles (2) 16-3/4" x 42". Subcut (3) 16-3/4" x 16-3/4" and (2) 10- 1/4" x 10-1/4" squares. Cut 16-3/4" squares diagonally twice to yield (12) side setting triangles (will use only 10). Cut 10-1/4" squares diagonally once to yield (4) corner setting triangles.
L		41912-3 Pink	7/8	Inner border #3 (6) 1-3/4" x 42". Piece strips and subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 54.5" and (2) 1-3/4" x 67" strips. FOR BINDING: Cut 1/2" yd into 2 1/4" bias strips. Piece strips to make a continuous binding strip.

1. CONSTRUCTING PIECED BLOCKS (USING CHOCOLATE FOCAL BLOCK AS EXAMPLE):

Corner units. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong sides of (1) H 2" x 2" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) F 3.5" x 3.5" square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal H corner triangle. Repeat with another (1) H 2" x 2" square at the opposite corner of the same (1) F 3.5" x 3.5" square to complete 1 corner unit.



Repeat to make a total of 4 corner units.

Cross units. Sew together (1) E 2" x 3.5" rectangle and (1) F 2" x 3.5" rectangle to complete 1 cross unit.



Repeat to make a total of 4 cross units.

Sew 2 cross units to the opposite sides of (1) F 3.5" x 3.5" square to make a row.



Sew 2 corner units to the opposite side of 1 cross unit to make a row. Repeat to make a total of 2 rows.



Sew rows together to complete 1 block. Square to 9 1/2".






Repeat to make a total number of blocks in the following colorways.

4 blocks: F 3 blocks: I, J

2 blocks: A, B, C, D

2. QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

Quilt Center.



Pieced diagonal rows starting from top left corner

Row 1: 1 A block, (2) H 2" x 9.5" sashing rectangles, 2 side setting triangles.

Row 2: 1 C block, 1 B block, 1 J block, (4) H 2" x 9.5" sashing rectangles, 2 side setting triangles.

Row 3: 3 F blocks, 1 I block, 1 D block, (6) H $2'' \times 9.5''$ sashing rectangles, 1 side setting triangle to be pieced to the left of the pieced row.

Row 4: 2 J blocks, 1 A block, 1 I block, 1 D block, (6) H 2" x 9.5" sashing rectangles, 1 side setting triangle to be pieced to the right of pieced row.

Row 5: 1 C block, 1 F block, 1 I block, (4) H 2" x 9.5" sashing rectangles, 2 side setting triangles.

Row 6. 1 B block, (2) H 2" x 9.5" sashing rectangles, 2 side setting triangles.

Pieced sashing rows (SR)

SR 1&5: (2) H 2" \times 11.5" sashing rectangles, (1) H 2" \times 9.5" sashing rectangle, (2) G 2" \times 2" sashing squares.


SR 2&4: (2) H 2" x 11.5" sashing rectangles, (3) H 2" x 9.5" sashing rectangles, (4) G 2" x 2" sashing squares.

SR 3: (2) H 2" x 11.5" sashing rectangles, (4) H 2" x 9.5" sashing rectangles, (5) G 2" x 2" sashing squares.

Sew pieced rows and pieced sashing rows together in the following order: Row1 - SR1 - Row2 - SR2 - Row3 - SR3 - Row4 - SR4 -Row 5 - SR5 - Row6. Add (4) H 2" x 12.5" sashing rectangles to the 4 corners before adding 4 corner side setting triangles to complete guilt center.

Some of the sashing pieces might be "sticking out". Trim around quilt center to include 1/4" seam allowance all around. The quilt center should measure approximately 45" x 60" from raw edge to raw edge at this point.





Inner border #1. Sew (2) H $2'' \times 60''$ strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) H $2'' \times 48''$ strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.

Inner border #2. Sew (2) E 2.5" x 63" strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) E 2.5" x 52" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.

Inner border #3. Sew (2) L 1-3/4" \times 67" stripe strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) L 1-3/4" \times 54.5" stripe strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.

Outer border. Sew (2) F 4" \times 69.5" strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew (2) F 4" \times 61.5" strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



3. QUILTING INSTRUCTIONS

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.
