

These blocks are designed to use the Fons and Porter Jumbo Curved Seam Templates to make life simple. There are also patterns on the last page that can be used to cut the shapes out of template plastic as well.

Swatch	SKU	Yardage	Placement	Cutting
	40272M-2	3/4 yd	Garland #3 & 6	Cut 3 strips 7 5/8" x WOF. Cut 14 garland pieces, locking in as shown below.
	40275M-1	2 yds	Background	Cut 7 strips 10" x WOF. Cut 42 background pieces, locking in as shown below.
	40272M-1	3/4 yd	Garland #1 & 4	Cut 3 strips 7 5/8" x WOF. Cut 14 garland pieces, locking in as shown below.
	40273-3	1 1/4 yds	Garland #2 & 5 Binding	Cut 3 strips 7 5/8" x WOF. Cut 14 garland pieces, locking in as shown below. Cut 7 strips 2 1/2" x WOF for binding.
	40274M-4	3 1/8 yds	Backing	Cut off 74" length. Divide remainder half lengthwise. Sew together to create a piece 72" long by 21" wide. Sew to 74" piece for about 74" x 63".




To sew this quilt you will need only the usual cutting and sewing tools, Template plastic or the F&P Jumbo Curved Seam Template, and Batting $60'' \times 70''$





- 1. Sew each garland piece to a background piece.
- 2. Following the picture below, sew each row as shown. Garland #1 starts in the upper right hand corner of the quilt. Rotating the every other block 180° will create the garland.
- 3. Sew 7 rows of 6 blocks each.
- 4. Sew the rows together.
- 5. Create the quilt sandwich of top, batting and backing.
- 6. Quilt as desired.
- 7. Trim the edges of the quilt.
- 8. Join the binding strips with diagonal seams. Finish edges with binding.
- 9. Attach a sleeve or hangers to the back of the quilt.
- 10. Enjoy!
