
(5) 1.5"x 42" strips; recut into (120) 1.5" squares

(6) 3-3/4" x 42" strips

#### 1. MAKING THE BLOCKS:


Note: Refer to letter labels under the swatches on pages 2 & 3 and match them to the strips in the pack as you make the blocks and assemble the quilt top.

Sew a Fabric **C** strip lengthwise to a Fabric **S** strip. Sew a Fabric **J** strip to a Fabric **N** strip. Crosscut each strip set into (15) 2.5" segments. Sew a **C/S** segment to a **J/N** segment to create a four-patch unit. Make a total of 15 four-patch units.




Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all 1.5" white squares. Place square on a corner of a four-patch unit as shown and stitch on the drawn line. Trim ¼" away from the sewn line and press open. Repeat on remaining three corners of the four-patch unit to complete a gold block. Make 15 gold blocks.





In the same manner, sew Fabric I and Fabric K strips together and Fabric O and Fabric O strips together to make strip sets and crosscut into 15 silver four-patches. Add white squares to the corners to make a total of 15 silver blocks.





#### 2. QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY:

Note: Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram as you assemble the quilt center. Assemble all pairs of rows as described before joining the pairs together.

- 1. Rows 1 & 2: Sew 1 Fabric  $\mathbf{U}$  strip lengthwise to a Fabric  $\mathbf{V}$  strip. Cut 1 (4-1/2") segment and 1 (24-1/2") segment. Sew the cut segments, 2 silver blocks and 1 gold block together.
- 2. Rows 3 & 4: Sew a Fabric **X** strip lengthwise to a Fabric **M** strip.
- 3. Rows 5 & 6: Sew a Fabric **G** strip lengthwise to a Fabric **D** strip. Cut 1 (4-1/2") segment and 1 (16-1/2") segment. Sew the cut segments, three silver and two gold blocks together.
- 4. Rows 7 & 8: Sew a Fabric A strip lengthwise to a Fabric H strip.
- 5. Rows 9 & 10: Sew a Fabric **R** strip lengthwise to a Fabric **E** strip. Cut 1 (8-1/2") segment and 1 (16-1/2") segment. Sew the cut segments, two silver and two gold blocks together.
- 6. Rows 11 & 12: Sew a Fabric **T** strip lengthwise to a Fabric **F** strip.
- 7. Rows 13 & 14: Sew a Fabric **M** strip lengthwise to a Fabric **C** strip.
- 8. Rows 15 & 16: Sew a Fabric **L** strip lengthwise to a Fabric **F** strip. Cut 1 (16-1/2") segment. Sew the cut segment, three silver and three gold blocks together.
- 9. Rows 17 & 18: Sew a Fabric **P** strip lengthwise to a Fabric **X** strip.
- 10. Rows 19 & 20: Sew a Fabric **E** strip lengthwise to a Fabric **R** strip. Cut 1 (24-1/2") segment. Sew the cut segment, two silver and two gold blocks together.
- 11. Rows 21 & 22: Sew a Fabric **H** strip lengthwise to a Fabric **T** strip.
- 12. Rows 23 & 24: Sew a Fabric **U** strip lengthwise to a Fabric **V** strip. Cut 1 (4-1/2") segment and 1 (24-1/2") segment. Sew the cut segments, one silver and two gold blocks together.
- 13: Rows 25 & 26: Sew a Fabric **W** strip lengthwise to a Fabric **A** strip.
- 14: Rows 27 & 28: Sew a Fabric **G** strip lengthwise to a Fabric **D** strip. Cut 1 (8-1/2") segment and 1 (12-1/2") segment. Sew the cut segments, two silver and three gold blocks together.



- 15. Sew the pairs of rows together starting in the middle (rows 13/14 & 15/16) and work out in both directions. As you add rows, alternate the end from which you begin sewing the strips to help keep your quilt top straight. If needed, trim quilt sides to square up after quilt center is assembled.
- 16. Sew the 6 (3-3/4"  $\times$  42") white strips short ends together into a long strip. Cut 2 (56-1/2") lengths and 2 (47") lengths. Sew the longer strips to the sides of the quilt top and the shorter strips to the top and bottom.



#### 3. FINISHING:

- 1. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form a quilt sandwich. Baste the sandwich and quilt as desired.
- 2. Use the 6 (2  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 42") Fabric **P** strips to bind the quilt.
