	B	40828-2 Cream	1-1/3 YD	11	4-1/4"	(52) 4-1/4" X 8" rectangles
	C	40829-3 Lavender	3/4 YD	6	4-1/4"	(52) 4-1/4" squares
	D	40830-4 Teal	2 YD	4 6	4-5/8" 4-1/4"	(24) 4-5/8" squares, crosscut once to create (48) HST (26) 4-1/4" X 8" rectangles
	E	40831-1 Blue	2-1/2 YD	20	4-1/4"	(4) 4-1/4" X 19-1/4" rectangles (8) 4-1/4" X 15-1/2" rectangles (42) 4-1/4" X 8" rectangles
	F	40832-2 Cream	3-1/2 YD	14 20	4-1/4" 3-1/8"	(8) 4-1/4" X 8" rectangles (104) 4-1/4" squares (48) 3-1/8" X 11-7/8" strips
	G	40832-3 Lavender	2 YD	6 9 10	4-1/4" 2-1/2" 2-1/4"	(52) 4-1/4" squares BORDER * BINDING

WOF – Width of Fabric

*= Will have to be pieced, sew together via short end then go to assembly instructions.

General Instructions:

- A. All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- B. Read through all instructions before beginning your project.

Piecing Instructions: (Refer to block images below for proper fabric placement)

BLOCK 1:

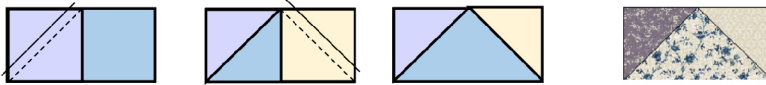
1. Draw diagonal line on the wrong side of all C, F, and G 4-1/4" squares.

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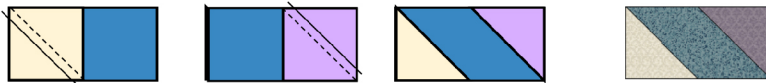
B UNIT:

2. Place (1) **C** 4-1/4" square right sides together with (1) **B** 4-1/4" X 8" rectangle and sew on diagonal line. Press, then trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4". Repeat on other side of **B** rectangle using (1) **F** 4-1/4" square. Square to 4-1/4" X 8", make (52).



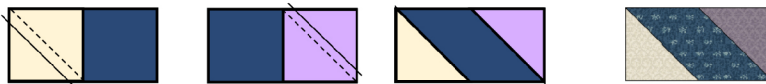
D UNIT:

3. Place (1) **F** 4-1/4" square right sides together with (1) **D** 4-1/4" X 8" rectangle and sew on diagonal line. Press, then trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4". Repeat on other side of **D** rectangle using (1) **G** 4-1/4" square. Square to 4-1/4" X 8", make (26).



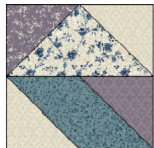
E UNIT:

4. Place (1) **F** 4-1/4" square right sides together with (1) **E** 4-1/4" X 8" rectangle and sew on diagonal line. Press, then trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4". Repeat on other side of **E** rectangle using (1) **G** 4-1/4" square. Square to 4-1/4" X 8", make (26).

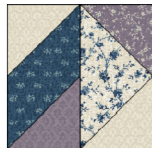


5. Sew (1) **B UNIT** to (1) **D UNIT** to create **BD BLOCK**. Square to 8", make (26).
6. Sew (1) **B UNIT** to (1) **E UNIT** to create **BE BLOCK**. Square to 8", make (26).

BE BLOCK (26)

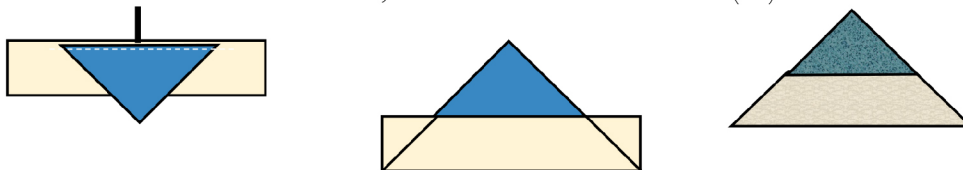


7. Sew (2) **BD BLOCKS** and (2) **BE BLOCKS** together to create **BLOCK 1**, make (13), square to 15-1/2".

BLOCK 2:

DF UNIT:

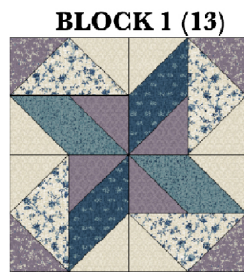
8. Find center of (1) **D** 4-5/8" HST and (1) **F** 3-1/8" X 11-7/8" strip. Pin together and sew. Press with seam allowance towards the **D** fabric, then trim as shown. Make (48).

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9. Sew (1) **DF UNIT** to each side of (1) **A** 11-1/8" square. Square to 15-1/2", make (12).



Assembly Instructions

(Refer to cover image for proper placement and rotation of blocks)

Quilt Assembly:

10. Sew blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.

Border Assembly:

11. **Border 1 Block:** Draw diagonal line on back of (16) E 4-1/4" X 8" rectangles. Place (1) E rectangle right sides together with (1) F 4-1/4" X 8" rectangle and sew on diagonal line. Press, then trim excess fabric on reverse side to 1/4". Repeat on other side of F rectangles using another E rectangle. Square to 4-1/4" X 15-1/2", make (8).



12. **Border 1 Side Units:** Sew together (2) Border 1 Blocks and (3) E 4-1/4" X 15-1/2" rectangles to create Side Unit. Make (2), then sew to sides of quilt.



13. **Border 1 Top/Bottom Units:** Sew (1) Border 1 Block to each side of (1) E 4-1/4" X 15-1/2" rectangle, then sew (1) E 4-1/4" X 19-1/4" rectangle to ends to create Top/Bottom Unit. Make (2), then sew to top and bottom of quilt.



14. **Border 2:** Measure sides of quilt (ours is 83-1/2"), cut (2) **G** 2-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 87-1/2") cut (2) **G** 2-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
