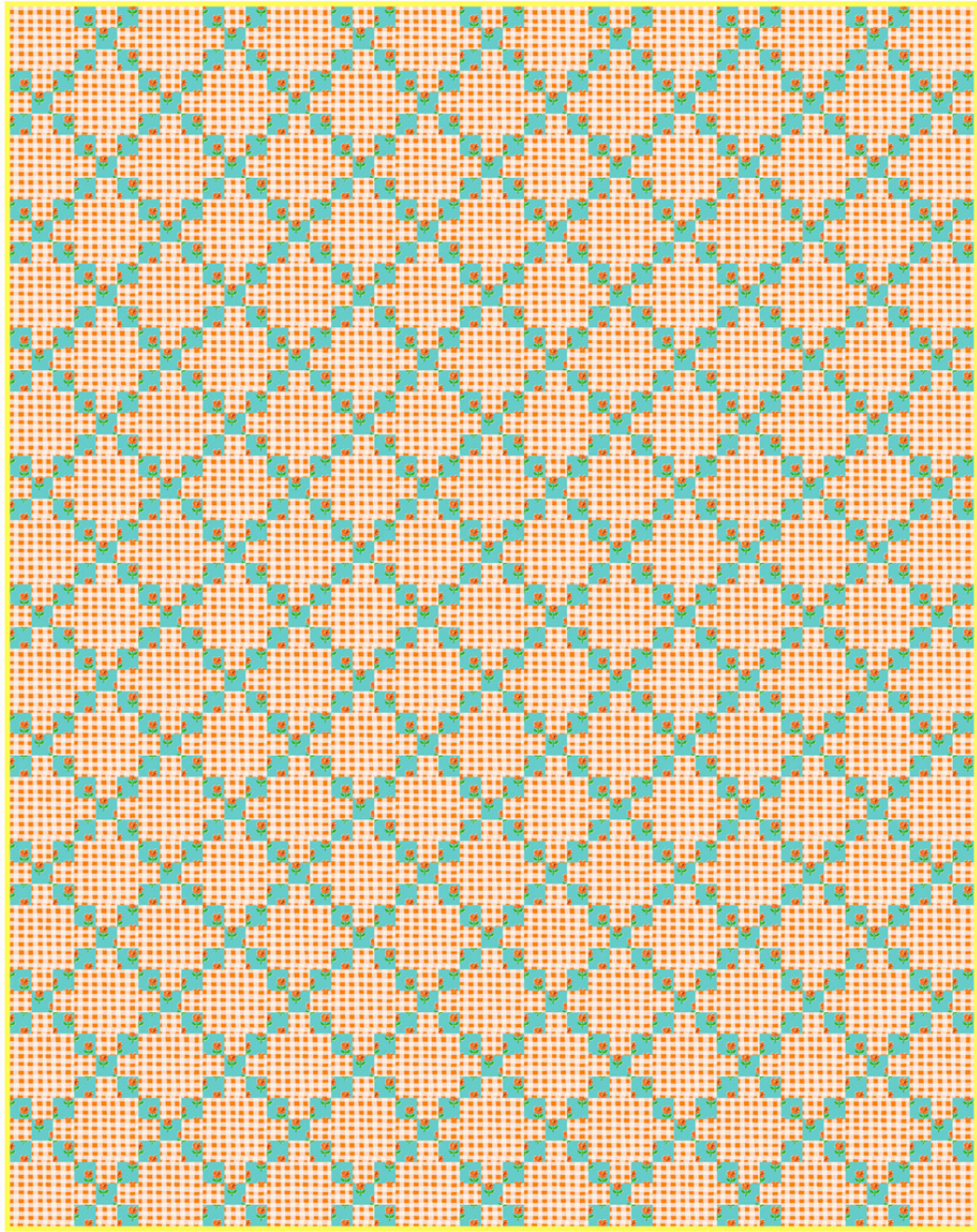

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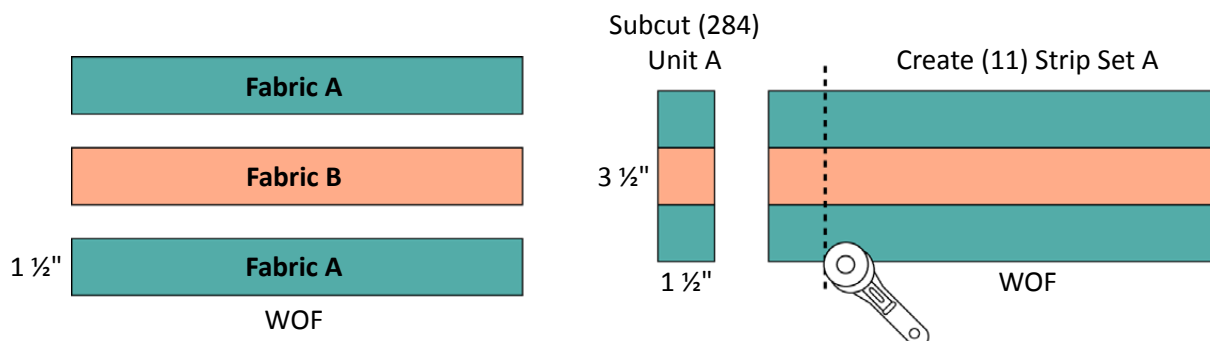
WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC

KEY	FABRIC	SKU	YD	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A		COUNTRY MOUSE 53473-4 Teal	1 ¼	(28) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Leave WOF strips whole for Strip Set Assembly.
B		COUNTRY MOUSE 53476-7 Tangerine	2 ⅜	(23) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Leave WOF strips whole for Strip Set Assembly. (12) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (143) 3 ½" squares for Quilt Assembly.
C		RUBY AND BEE 51583-29 Lemonade BINDING	½	(6) 2 ¼" x WOF strips for binding.
		Backing	3 ⅝	Batting 53" x 65"

STRIP SET ASSEMBLY:

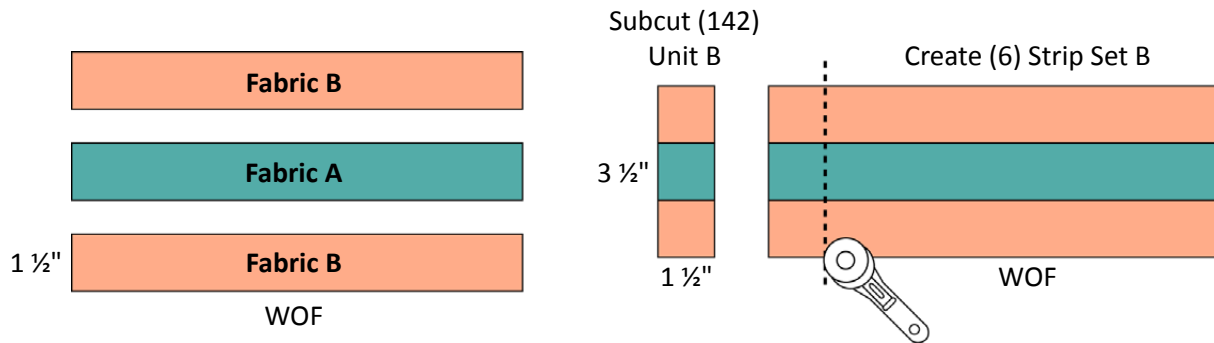
1. Create Strip Set A. Sew (1) 1 ½" x WOF **Fabric A** strip to either side of (1) 1 ½" x WOF **Fabric B** strip lengthwise. Press toward **Fabric A**. Once complete, Strip Set A should measure 3 ½" x WOF unfinished.
2. Repeat to create (11) Strip Set A.
3. From Strip Set A, subcut (284) 1 ½" x 3 ½" units. Label as Unit A.





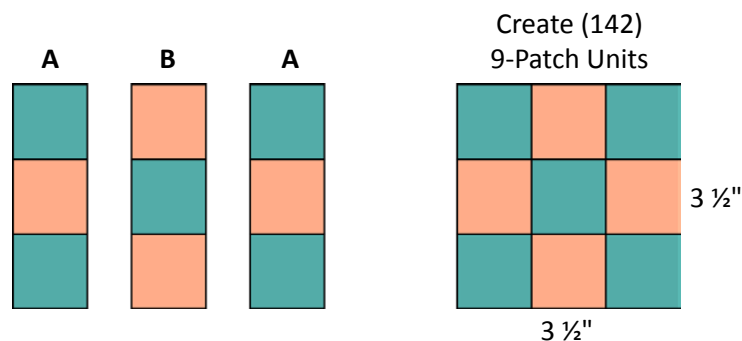
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4. Create Strip Set B. Sew (1) 1 ½" x WOF **Fabric B** strip to either side of (1) 1 ½" x WOF **Fabric A** strip lengthwise. Press toward **Fabric A**. Once complete, Strip Set B should measure 3 ½" x WOF unfinished.
5. Repeat to create (6) Strip Set B.
6. From Strip Set B, subcut (142) 1 ½" x 3 ½" units. Label as Unit B.



9-PATCH UNIT ASSEMBLY:

7. Sew (1) Unit A to either side of (1) Unit B, using either your fingers or pins to align and nestle seams. Press toward Unit A. Once complete, the 9-Patch Unit should measure 3 ½" x 3 ½" unfinished.
8. Repeat to create (142) 9-Patch Units.

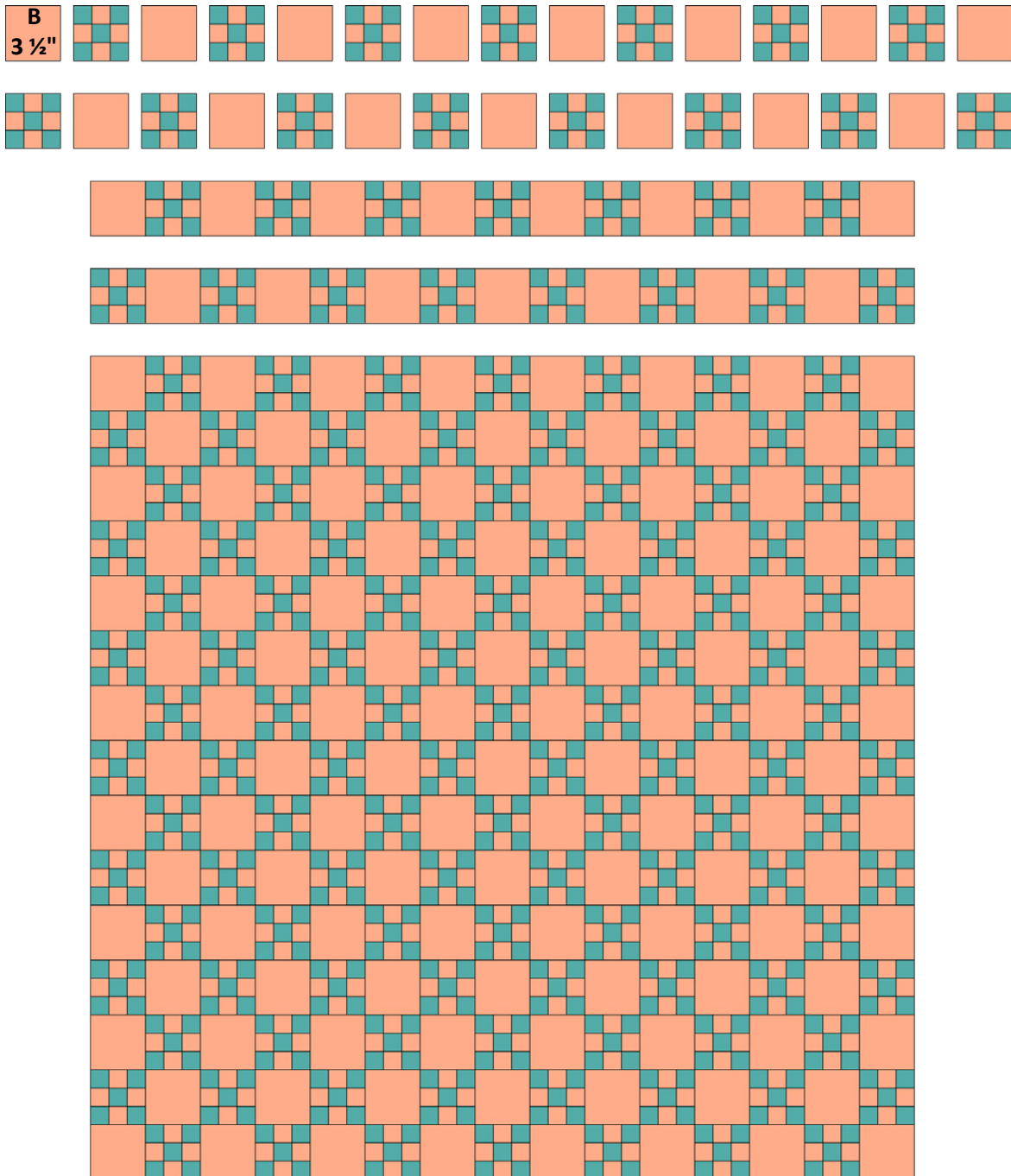


QUILT ASSEMBLY:

9. Arrange 9-Patch Units and 3 ½" **Fabric B** squares in a 15 x 19 grid, alternating between units and squares as shown on Page 3. **Fabric A** should form a continuous chain throughout the quilt top.
10. Sew the quilt top together in horizontal rows first, pressing seams toward the **Fabric B** squares.
11. Sew horizontal rows together, using pins to align and nestle seams. Press seams toward the bottom of the quilt top. Once complete, the quilt top should measure 45 ½" x 57 ½" unfinished.



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FINISHING THE QUILT:

12. Sandwich the quilt top with batting and backing. Baste quilt layers together using your preferred method.
13. Quilt as desired.
14. Bind quilt using (6) 2 1/4" x WOF **Fabric C** strips.
