

MAKING THE BLOCKS

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) **C** 2-1/2" squares. Place a marked **C** square right sides together on (1) **E** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" piece. Stitch on the drawn line, trim seam allowance to 1/4", and press open. Repeat on the opposite end to make a **C-E** unit. Make a total of (8) **C-E** units.




2. Sew C-E units to opposite sides of (1) C 4-1/2" square.



3. Sew C 2-1/2" squares to opposite ends of (1) C-E unit. Make (2).



4. Sew the units from step 3 to the top and bottom of the unit from step 2 to complete (1) 8-1/2" square star block. Make a total of (6) **C** star blocks and (4) **D** star blocks.




Make 6 C star blocks

ASSEMBLING THE QUILT

- **5.** Sew (3) **C** star blocks alternating with (2) **B** star blocks into a horizontal row. Make (2) star block rows
- **6.** Sew **B** 4-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of each star block row.



- **7.** Sew the pieced star block rows from step 6 to the top and bottom of the trimmed panel piece.
- **8.** Sew **H** 5-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of the unit from step 7 to complete the quilt center.
- **9.** Sew **F** 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew **F** 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" strips to the top and bottom.
- **10.** Sew **C** 4-1/2" \times 60-1/2" strips to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew **C** 4-1/2" \times 52-1/2" strips to the top and bottom.

FINISHING

- **11.** With the backing laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form the quilt sandwich. Baste the sandwich and quilt as desired.
- **12.** Bind using the Fabric **G** strips to finish the quilt.
