

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Pencil Box MATERIALS REQUIRED Page 2 1/3 yard each of: 40655-4 Coral 40653-2 Sky Blue 40654-1 Lime 40655-5 Melon 40651-1 Lime 3/4 yard: 1 2/3 yards: 1/4 yard: 2 yards: 40652-4 Coral 35362B-2 31835 40654-3 White 5 yards (backing): 2/3 yard (binding): 40652-3 White 40654-2 Sky Blue

OTHER SUPPLIES

- -1 yard fusible fabric adhesive for appliqué (Heat and Bond Lite works well.)
- -5 copies of pattern page 5. Make sure that when the copies are made (or printed) that they are printed with no scaling or fit to page options checked. Double check the 1" box to make sure that it's truly 1".

STEP 1: CUTTING

From each of the (5) 1/3 yard fabric pieces cut (1) 6 1/2" x 39 1/2" rectangle.

From the red glasses fabric (40652-4 Coral) cut:

- (3) 3" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Piece and sub-cut to make (2) 3" x 50 1/2" strips
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Piece and sub-cut to make (2) 2" x 50 1/2" strips.

From the white solid fabric cut (3) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece and sub-cut to make (2) 5 1/2" x 50 1/2" strips.

From the white arrow fabric (40654-3 White) cut:

(8) 5" x WOF strips. Piece and sub-cut to make (6) 5" x 50 1/2" strips.

(5) 6 1/2" x 5 3/4" rectangles



STEP 2: APPLIQUÉ SECTIONS

TEXT APPLIQUÉ

Page 3

Print out and tape together pattern pages 7-10, 11-14, and 15-18 for the text. Match up along dashed lines making sure they coordinate. Trace each letter onto the back of the fusible fabric adhesive, cut loosely around each letter, then iron onto the back of the remaining white solid fabric. Cut out each shape using sharp fabric scissors. Peel off the paper backing. Using the layout diagram below and the 6 1/2" x 39 1/2" rectangles that were cut previously, iron onto the fabric.



Use the sewing machine to stitch an appliqué or tight zig-zag stitch to secure the text. Set aside.

GLASSES APPLIQUÉ

Trace 14 glasses shapes (found on page 6) onto the paper side of the fusible fabric adhesive. Cut out loosely. Iron onto the back of the fabric and then cut out each shape. Peel off the paper backing. You'll have 14 total when cut: (6) cut from the 40655-5 Melon fabric, (2) from the 40651-1 Lime fabric, (2) from the 40654-1 Lime fabric, and (4) from the 40653-2 Sky Blue fabric.

Using the (2) 5 1/2" x 50 1/2" white fabric strips, layout 7 glasses in a row, centered horizontally on each white fabric strip. Iron onto the fabric. Use the sewing machine to stitch an appliqué or tight zig-zag stitch to secure the glasses. Set aside.

STEP 3: PAPER PIECE PENCIL POINTS

Using the pattern piece on page 5, paper piece (5) pencil points using the remaining solid white, gray, and white arrow fabric (40654-3 White).



After pencil points are completed, add (1) 6 1/2" x 5 3/4" white arrow fabric rectangle to each block, along the pencil point edge.



STEP 4: COMPLETE PENCIL BLOCKS

Use the cover illustration to determine which side of each quote/pencil strip the point will get pieced to. (You will have 3 pencil points to the right, and 2 to the left of the quote block.)

Piece together.

STEP 5: FINISH QUILT TOP

Use the layout diagram found on the following page to lay out and piece each strip in place. To make things easier, piece it in sections.


STEP 6: FINISH QUILT

Once you've completed the quilt top, make the backing with the 40652-3 White fabric. Determine how you'd like to quilt it and quilt away. When the quilting is finished, bind it with 40654-2 Sky Blue fabric and enjoy!




Stitch directly on the dashed lines. The solid line on the outside is the 1/4" seam allowances so trim the block down to the solid line, then tear away the paper.




Make sure this box is measuring 1" x 1"





