















# Disco Fever

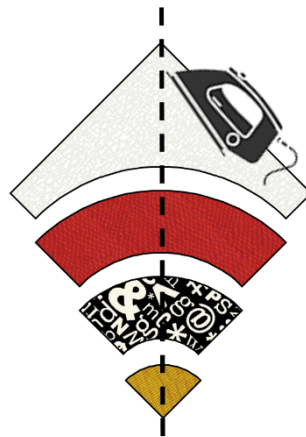

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

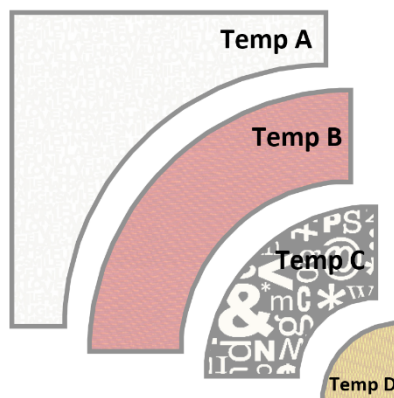
*(Blocks A-D are assembled in multiple colorways for extra scrappiness and randomness within the quilt top. General curved piecing instructions are given and shown using Block A Colorway 1. Then written instructions and diagrams will indicate accurate fabric and template pairing for each block type and colorway. See the guide listed on the Template pages for reference on template placement for Blocks A-D.)*

1. Begin preparing for curved piecing by folding all curved Templates A-L in half as shown. Use an iron to press a crease marking the exact center of each template. This will assist you in lining up templates properly while piecing.



2. Lay out the following templates in order from largest to smallest using the diagrams for reference.

- a. Template A - **Fabric K**
- b. Template B - **Fabric A**
- c. Template C - **Fabric L**
- d. Template D - **Fabric B**



3. Begin piecing by placing Templates C and D right sides together. It will appear as if the template curves are running opposite directions at this time.

4. Align the pressed center creases and pin in place. Then align and pin both ends of the templates. Please note that the largest template will appear bunched up at this time but will become smooth once sewn.

5. Begin slowly sewing templates together using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam and a slightly smaller stitch length for more control. You may opt to sew with the largest template on top so that you can smooth the largest template as you sew.

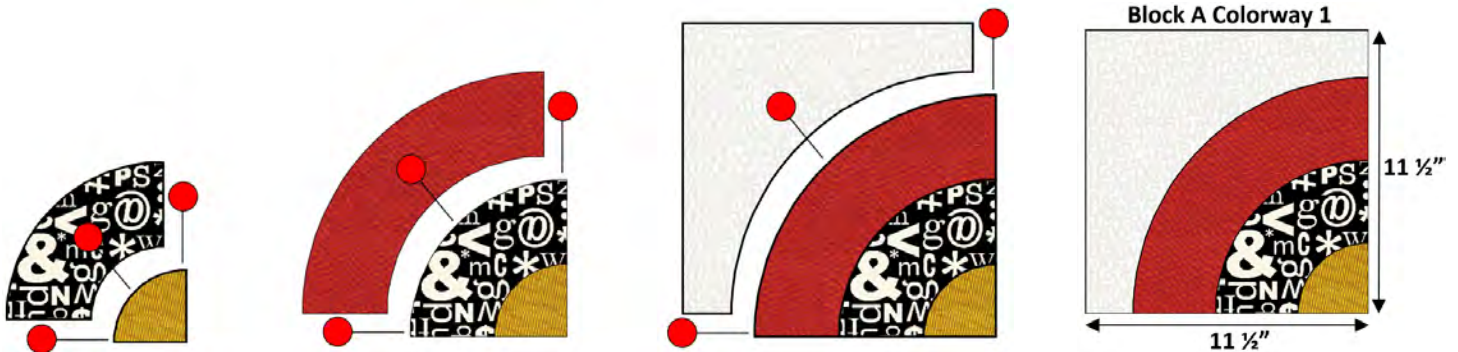

6. Use fingers to smooth the templates and keep the edges aligned for a secure ¼" seam. Backstitch at the beginning and end of the seam.

7. Once complete, press the seam to the largest template.

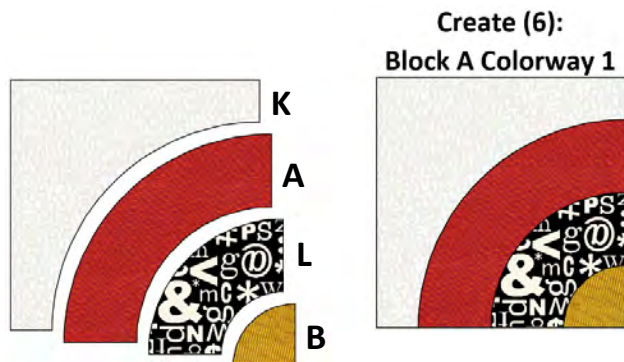
8. Repeat curved piecing techniques to attach Templates A and B. Trim Block A Colorway 1 to measure 11 ½" x 11 ½" unfinished. Press.



9. Using the curved piecing techniques described in the above steps, create Block A Colorway 1, Block B Colorways 1 & 2, Block C Colorways 1 & 2 and Block D Colorway 1. The guide below lists accurate fabric and template pairing and quantity of each block to create. **Trim all blocks to measure 11 ½" x 11 ½" unfinished.**

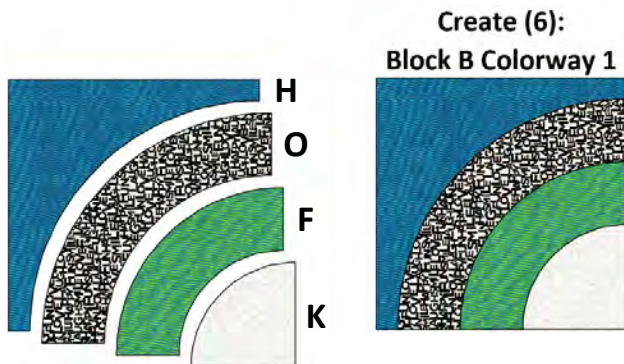
**a. Create (6) Block A Colorway 1:**

1. Template A – Fabric K
2. Template B – Fabric A
3. Template C – Fabric L
4. Template D – Fabric B



**b. Create (6) Block B Colorway 1:**

1. Template E – Fabric H
2. Template F – Fabric O
3. Template G – Fabric F
4. Template H – Fabric K

### c. Create (6) Block B Colorway 2:

1. Template E – Fabric E
2. Template F – Fabric P
3. Template G – Fabric G
4. Template H – Fabric K

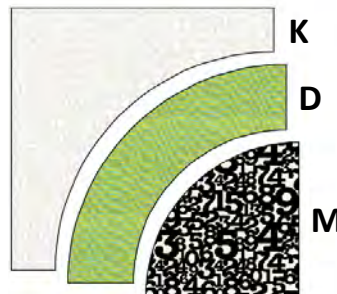

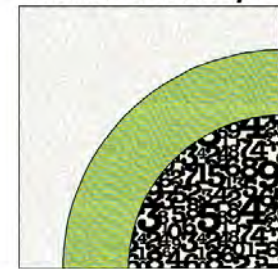

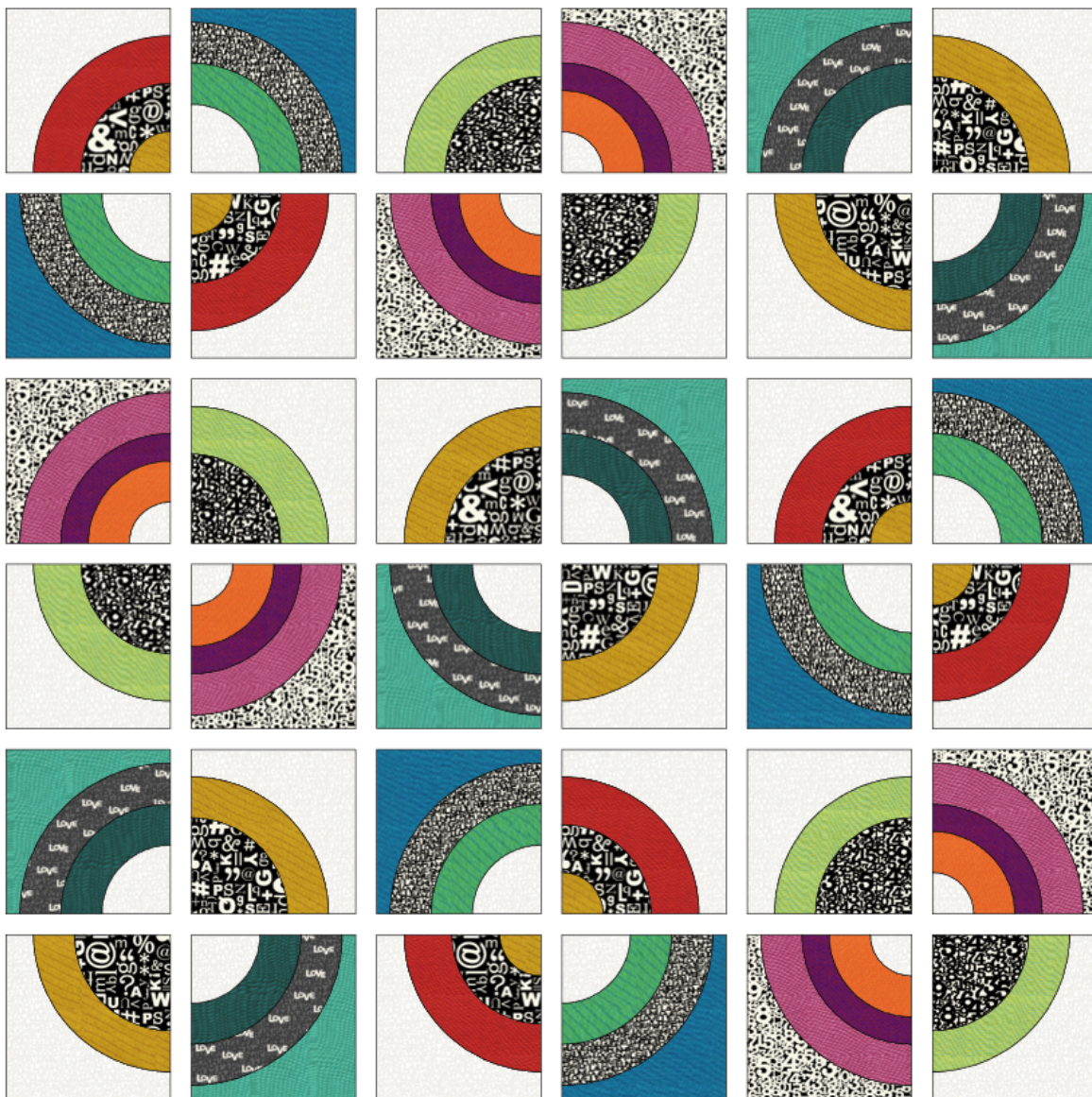
10. There should be a total of (36) blocks all measuring 11 1/2" x 11 1/2" unfinished.

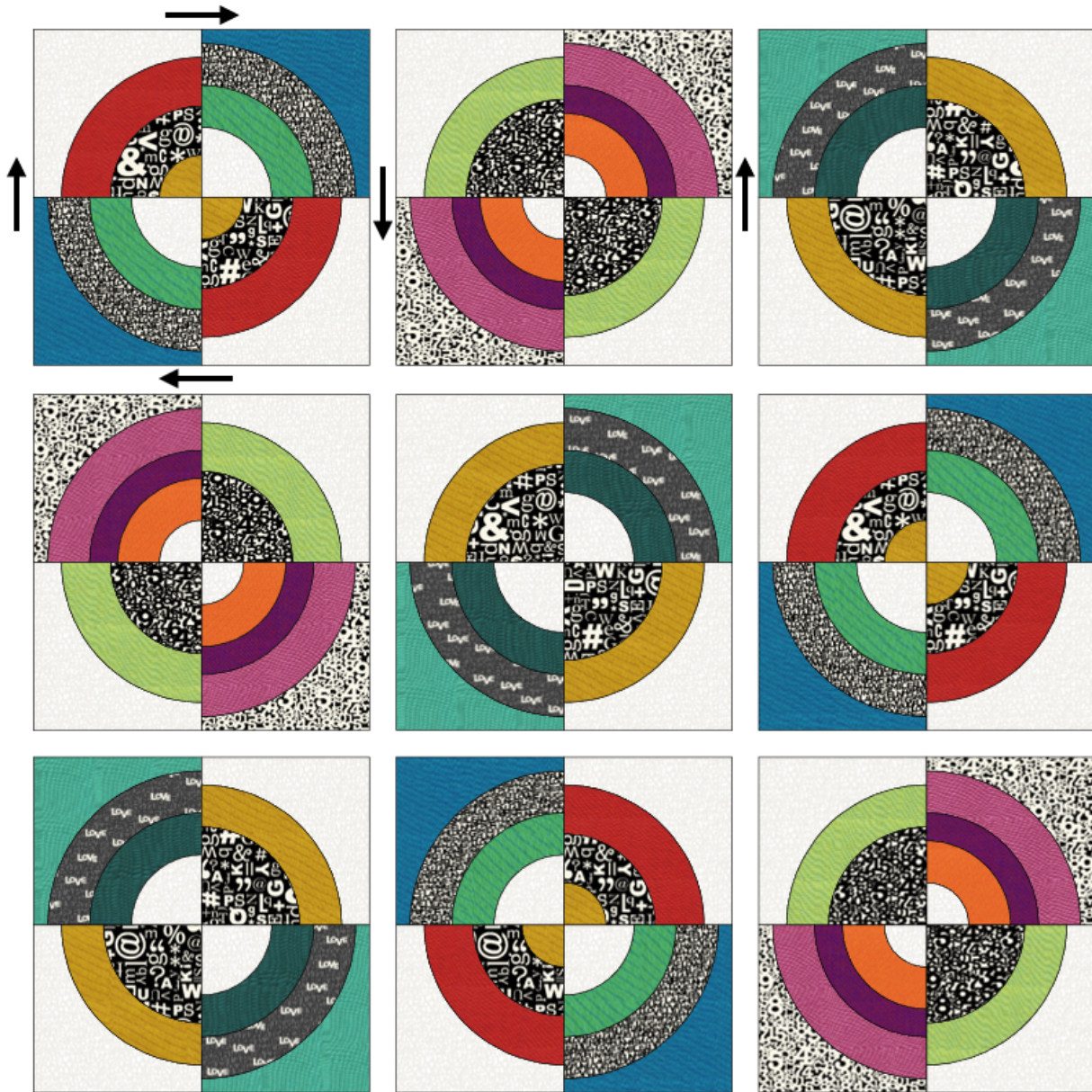
## QUILT ASSEMBLY:

11. Place Blocks A-D in a 6 x 6 grid as shown. The quilt will be assembled in 4 Block units. Follow diagrams to ensure that all blocks are turned accurately throughout the quilt top as shown. Please note that each 4 Block unit will have a circular appearance.
12. Begin sewing the quilt together in (9) sections of (4) blocks each. Arrows shown on the upper left section in the second diagram below indicate pressing. Press as shown consistently for each section and row.

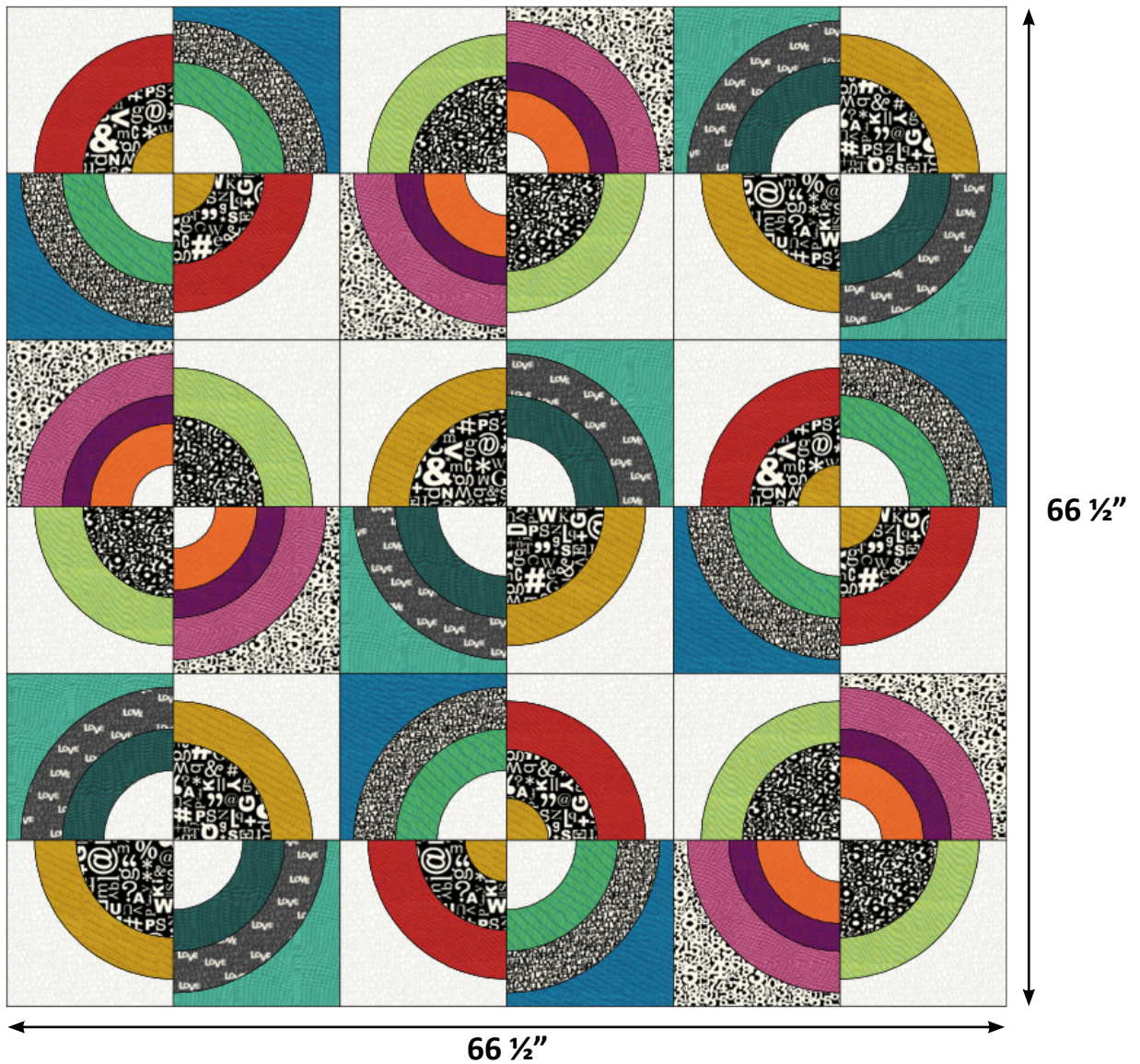


**13.** Sew the sections together to complete the quilt top. The quilt top should measure 66 ½" x 66 ½" unfinished.

## FINISHING THE QUILT:

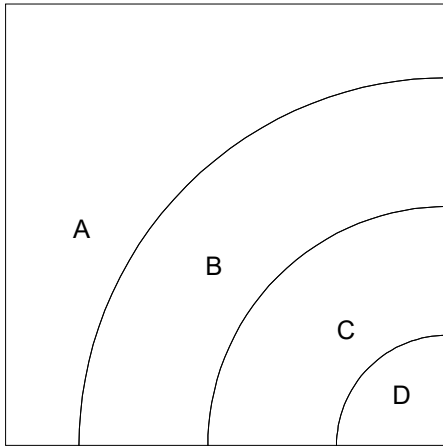
14. Sandwich quilt with batting and backing. Baste quilt layers together using your preferred method.
15. Quilt as desired.
16. Bind quilt using (7) Fabric L 2 1/4" strips.



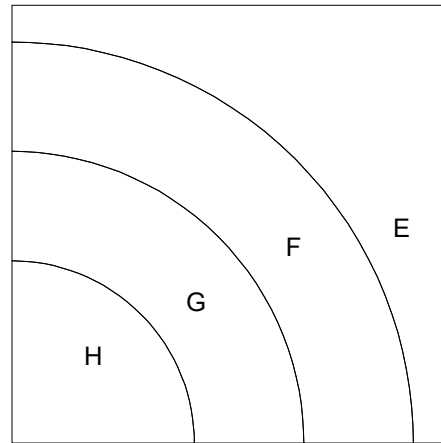
