

#### **STRIP BLOCK ASSEMBLY**


**1.** Sew the short end of (1) **E** 1-3/4" x 3-1/2" strip to the right short end of (1) **B** 1-3/4" x 9-1/2" strip. With **E** strip to the right, sew this pieced strip to the bottom, lengthwise side of (1) **D** 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strip to make Section 1. Square up to 12-1/2" x 2-3/4". Refer to the diagram.



**2.** Sew (1) **G** 1-3/4" x 6-1/2" strip to the right short end of (1) **H** 1-3/4" x 6-1/2" strip. Sew to the top lengthwise side of (1) **A** 1-3/4" x 12-1/2" strip to make Section 2. Square up to 12-1/2" x 3".



**3.** Sew the short end of (1) **F** 1-3/4" x 9-1/2" strip to the left end of (1) **C** 1-3/4" x 3-1/2" strip. Repeat placing the fabrics in the opposite positions for the next strip and sew to the bottom of the first strip as shown to make Section 3. Square up to 12-1/2" x 3".






**4.** Sew (1) **H** 1-3/4"  $\times$  6-1/2" strip to the right short end of (1) **G** 1-3/4"  $\times$  6-1/2" strip. Sew to the bottom lengthwise side of (1) **A** 1-3/4"  $\times$  12-1/2" strip to make Section 4. Square up to 12-1/2"  $\times$  3".




**5.** Sew (1) **B** 1-3/4" x 3-1/2" strip to the right end of (1) **E** 1-3/4" x 9-1/2" strip. Sew to the top of (1) **D** 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strip to complete Section 5. Square up to 12-1/2" x 2-3/4".



**6.** Sew Sections 1 to 5 together from top to bottom to complete the block. Square up to 12-1/2". Make 25.






FINISHED STRIP BLOCK: 12" SQUARE




#### **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

- 7. The quilt center is set on point, so it will be sewn together in diagonal rows using side setting and corner setting triangles C. Following diagrams for placement and rotation of blocks, sew each row in the order stated from left to right. Keep track of the direction of the left side of the block in each row as shown below.
- **8. Row 1:** Sew (1) **C** Setting Triangle **(ST)** to the left and right side of a block. Sew the long side of (1) **C** Corner Setting Triangle **(CST)** to the top to complete Row 1.




9. Row 2: Side ST, Strip Block, rotated Strip Block, Strip Block, ST.






10. Row 3: ST, Strip Block, rotated Strip Block, Strip Block, rotated Strip Block, ST.



**11. Row 4:** CST, Strip Block, rotated Strip Block, Strip Block, rotated Strip Block, Strip Block, rotated Strip Block, CST.




**12. Row 5:** Repeat Step 10, change block rotation.






**13. Row 6:** Repeat Step 9, change block rotation.




**14. Row 7:** Repeat Step 8.





**15.** Sew Rows 1 to 7 together along the diagonal edges. Trim edges 1/4" past block points.



**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **A** 2-1/2" strips.
