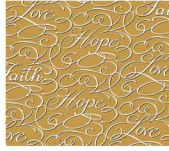

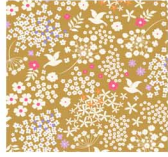

## Fabric Requirements:

- Fussy cut scraps of "Faith" "Hope" and "Love" (2.5" x 3" each) (Use this fabric for your backing and you will have enough from leftovers from that!)
- Small neutral scraps for Doves (a 9"x3" rectangle is enough!)
- Gold solid: fat quarter
- 4 patterned fabrics - 4 fat quarters (if you are using a non-directional fabric, you can use a fat eighth!)
- backing: fat quarter
- binding: fat quarter
- a 9"x3" fusible web for doves

## Cutting Instructions:

- **Main strips:** cut 1 - 9.5"x3" each from 4 fat quarters
- **Words:** fussy cut 4 - 2.5"x3" from text fabric
- **Bottom strips:** cut 1 - 1.5"x3" each from 4 same fat quarters as main strips
- **Middle sashing:** cut 3 - 1"x12.5" from gold solid fabric
- **Side borders:** cut 2 - 2"x12.5" from gold solid fabric
- **Bottom border:** cut 1 = 2.5"x14.5" from gold solid fabric
- **Top border:** cut 1 - 5"x14.5" from gold solid fabric

Print out your traceable dove template (page 3). Using a window or light table, trace three doves onto the paper side of your fusible web. Adhere fusible web to the wrong side of your neutral fabric. Cut your doves out and set aside!

## Sewing:

1. Sew the short side of your main strips to your word blocks, then sew your bottom strips under your words.
2. Starting with your side borders, sew in this order: 1 side border, faith strip column, 1 middle sashing, hope strip column, 1 middle sashing, love strip column, 1 middle sashing, last strip column, 1 side border.
3. Sew your top border on then your bottom border.
4. Adhere your doves where you want them and either by hand or machine, blanket stitch around each of them.
5. Make your quilt sandwich (top, batting, backing) and quilt!! You can quilt wings inside your doves. Bind, and you are done!!
