Fabric Requirements:

- Silver Solid Fabric: 3/4 yd (1/2 would do it, but it'll be close... grab some for extra just for fun!)
- 6 different patterned fabrics: 1/4 yd (WOF)
- Backing: 1 yd
- Binding: 1/3yd

Cutting Instructions:

Silver Solid:

Cut (WOF) 6 - 2.5" strips + 2 - 2.5" squares Subcut:

34 - 2.5" squares

8 - 4.5"x2.5" strips

 $3 - 6.5" \times 2.5"$ strips

5 - 10.5"x2.5" strips

2 - 12.5"x2.5" strips

1 - 24.5"x2.5" strips

Patterned fabric #1:

Cut 2 – 2.5" strips (WOF) Subcut:

15 - 2.5" squares

5 - 6.5"x2.5" strips

Patterned fabric #2:

Cut 2 - 2.5" strips (WOF) Subcut: 15 - 2.5" squares

5 - 6.5"x2.5"

Patterned fabric #3:

Cut 2 - 2.5" strips (WOF) Subcut:

9 - 2.5" squares

3 - 6.5"x2.5" strips

Patterned fabric #4:

Cut 2 – 2.5" strips (WOF)

Subcut:

9 - 2.5" squares

3 - 6.5"x2.5" strips

Patterned fabric #5:

Cut 2 – 2.5" strips (WOF)

Subcut:

12 - 2.5" squares

4 - 6.5"x2.5" strips



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
Cutting Instructions cont.

Patterned fabric #6:

Cut 2 - 2.5" strips (WOF) *Subcut:*12 - 2.5" squares
4 - 6.5"x2.5" strips

Let's sew!!!
(Use a 1/4" seam allowance in all sewing!)


Here is a key for how to put together your rows of strips and squares:



When you sew, you are going to sew your strips and squares together to create rows. Then you will sew your rows together. Follow the graphic below to set your squares and strips up on your design board (or on your ironing board or floor row by row!) and sew!



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Notes:

When you get to row 5 (counting from the top), assemble each of the next 5 rows without the side strips, sew the rows together, and then sew the two 10.5"x2.5" strips on the sides of the rows. THEN attach rows 5-9 to row 4. Continue sewing each row onto the top section until you have a complete quilt top!!

Add your backing and batting and quilt!! I quilted inside each cross 1/4". Then I quilted all around the silver solid fabric using a small meandering stitch. Quilt it as you'd like! Bind and VOILA!!! A sweet faith cross quilt!
