#### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

This pattern requires knowledge of paper piecing. For a paper piecing tutorial visit staceyinstitches.wordpress.com.

- 1. Print (34) copies of the foundation sheet, making sure to print at Actual Size. Use the test square to check the accuracy. Cut the templates out from the paper. Discard (2) foundation templates to have (100) total.
- 2. Using the preferred method of paper piecing, the  $\bf A$  2" x 5" rectangles,  $\bf D$  1 1/2"x 5" rectangles, and (72) of the  $\bf G$  2 3/4"x 4 1/2" rectangles , make (36) Foundation Units, matching the sizes listed on the foundations as the guide. Trim the blocks around the outside solid line, remove the paper, and set aside as Unit A.
- 3. Repeat the above step using the **B** 2" x 5" rectangles, **H** 1 1/2"x 5" rectangles, and the remaining (128) **G** 2 3/4"x 4 1/2" rectangles to make (64) Unit Bs.






4. Sew the **C** HST to the **F** HST along the diagonal. Press towards the Fabric F, trim and square to 2 1/2", and set aside as Unit C. Repeat to make (112) Unit C pieces.






5. Sew a **A** 6 1/2" square, (4) Unit A pieces, and (4) Unit C pieces together as shown, pressing in the direction of the arrows, to make Block A. Repeat to make (9) of Block A. Trim and square the blocks to 10 1/2".






6. Repeat the above step using the  $\bf B$  6 1/2" squares, Unit B pieces, and (64) Unit C pieces, pressing in the direction of the arrows, to make (16) of Block B.




7. Sew the remaining Unit C pieces to one end of each **G** 2 1/2"x 8 7/8" rectangles as shown. Press towards Unit C, and then sew a **G** 8 7/8" QST to each. Press towards the HST piece, then trim the extra off as shown, to make (12) of Block C.



8. Referring to the layout diagram for block placement and orientation, sew the A Blocks, B Blocks, C Blocks, and **G** 8" HST together into diagonal rows, matching seam allowances carefully, pressing the even rows to the right and the odd rows to the left. Sew the diagonal rows together into the quilt top, matching seam allowances carefully, pressing all of the seams towards the bottom of the quilt top.




- 9. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired.
- 10. Join the **E** 2 1/4" wide strips on the diagonal to make a continuous bias binding. Sew the binding around the quilt top. Turn the binding to the back and secure in place by hand or machine. Label and enjoy!
