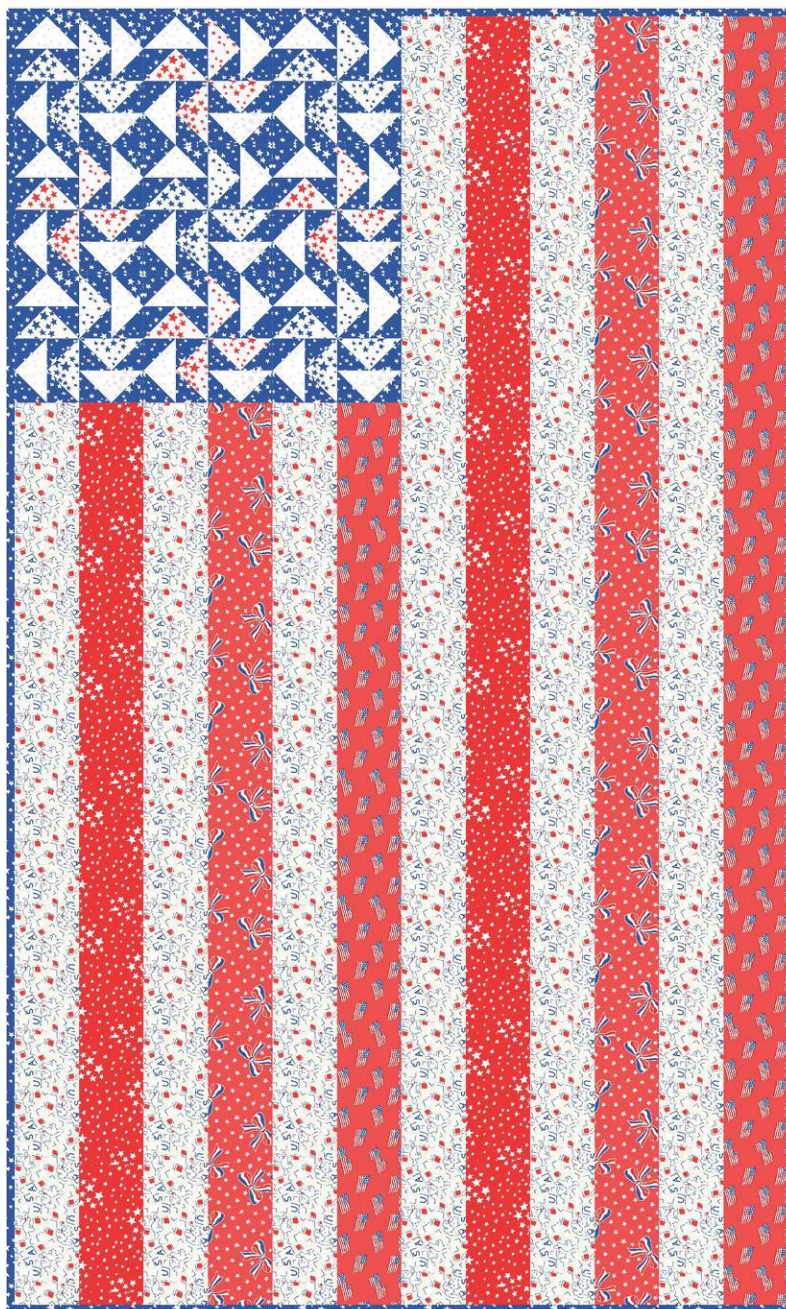

Flag Table Runner

A		42348-3 Blue	2/3	Pieced Blocks Widthwise, 6 (1 1/2" x WOF) strips. Subcut 144 (1 1/2" x 1 1/2") squares. Binding Widthwise, 4 (2-1/4" x WOF) strips
B		42348-1 Red	1/4	Runner Strips Widthwise, 2 (2 1/2" x WOF) strips. Subcut 1 (2 1/2" x 28 1/2") and 1 (2 1/2" x 40 1/2") strip.
C		42343-1 Red	1/4	Runner Strips Widthwise, 2 (2 1/2" x WOF) strips. Subcut 1 (2 1/2" x 28 1/2") and 1 (2 1/2" x 40 1/2") strip.
D		42346-1 Red	1/4	Runner Strips Widthwise, 2 (2 1/2" x WOF) strips. Subcut 1 (2 1/2" x 28 1/2") and 1 (2 1/2" x 40 1/2") strip.
E		42348-6 White	1/4	Pieced Blocks Widthwise, 2 (2 1/2" x WOF) strips. Subcut 36 (1 1/2" x 2 1/2") rectangles.
F		42347-2 White	5/8	Runner Strips Widthwise, 6 (2 1/2" x WOF) strips. Subcut 3 (2 1/2" x 28 1/2") and 3 (2 1/2" x 40 1/2") strips.
G		42348-5 White Blue	1/8	Pieced Blocks Widthwise, 1 (2 1/2" x WOF) strip. Subcut 20 (1 1/2" x 2 1/2") rectangles.
H		42348-4 White Red	1/8	Pieced Blocks Widthwise, 1 (2 1/2" x WOF) strip. Subcut 16 (1 1/2" x 2 1/2") rectangles.

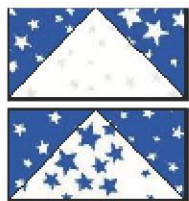
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Constructing Pieced Blocks.

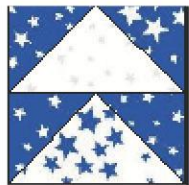
1. Flying geese unit. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 1 (1 1/2" x 1 1/2") A square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of 1 (1 1/2" x 2 1/2") E rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal A corner triangle. Repeat with another (1 1/2" x 1 1/2") A square on the same (1 1/2" x 2 1/2") E rectangle to complete 1 flying geese unit.



Repeat to make a total of 4 E/A and 4 G/A flying geese units.

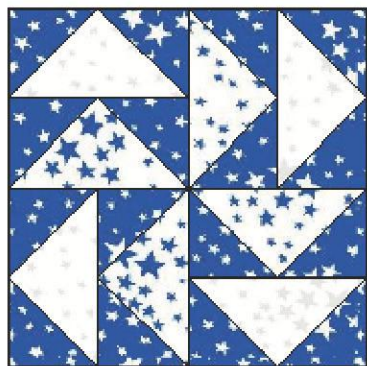


2. Sew 1 E/A and 1 G/A flying geese units together to make a quarter block unit. Square to 2 1/2".



Repeat to make 4 quarter block units.

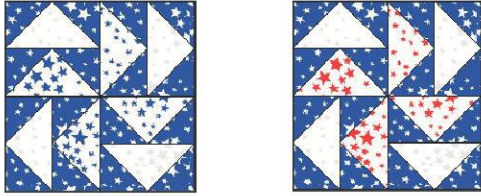
3. Arrange and sew 4 quarter units to complete 1 G block, as shown. Make 5 (4-1/2") square unfinished G blocks. Square to 4 1/2".





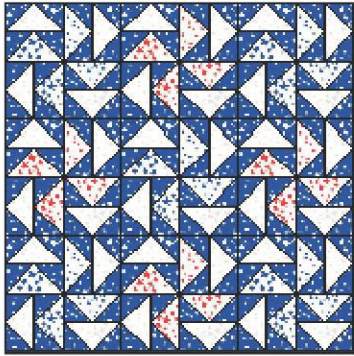
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4. Repeat steps 1-3 using (1-1/2" x 2-1/2") H rectangles in place of the G rectangles to make a total of 4 H blocks.

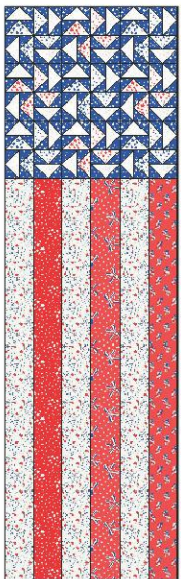


Quilt Assembly:

1. Sew 9 pieced blocks into 3 rows of 3 blocks each. Join the blocks into rows and join the rows to make a 9-patch unit. Square to 12 1/2".



2. Arrange and sew together 3 (2 1/2" x 28 1/2") F strips, 1 (2 1/2" x 28 1/2") C strip, 1 (2 1/2" x 28 1/2") D strip and 1 (2 1/2" x 28 1/2") C strip, and add to the bottom of the pieced block assembly made in step 1. This unit should measure 12 1/2" x 40 1/2".

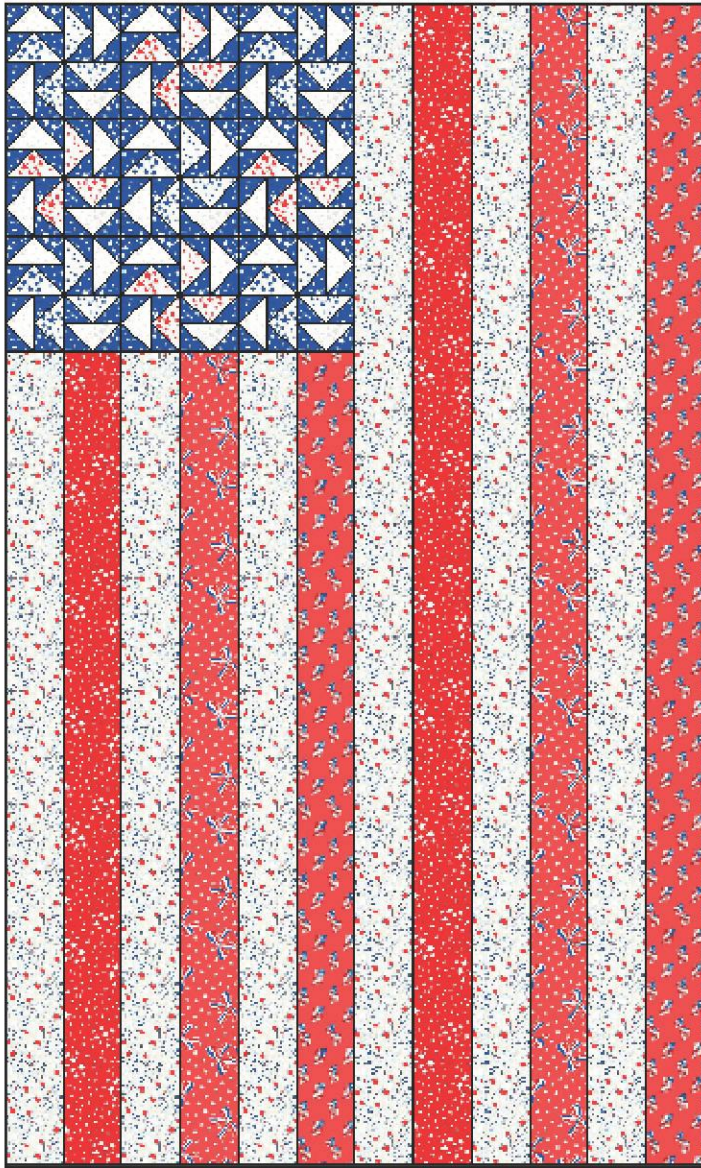

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3. Add to the right of the sewn assembly, made in step 2, 6 (2 1/2" x 40 1/2") strips in the order: F, B, F, D, F, C to complete runner top. Square to 24 1/2" x 40 1/2".

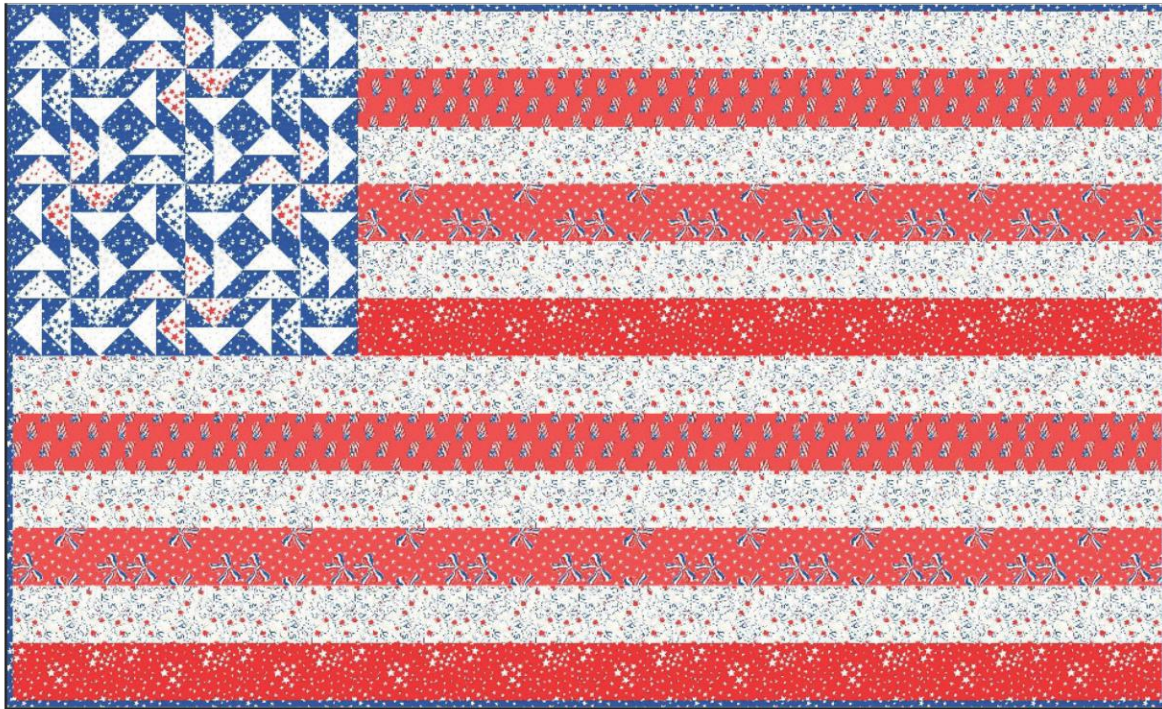

Note: The above runner orientation is for a vertical display. Please refer to the following diagram for orientation if a horizontal display is desired.



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Finishing

Layer runner top, batting and backing together. Baste and quilt as desired. Attach binding to complete runner.
