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






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Constructing pieced basket blocks

1. Basket. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2" x 2" **H** square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 4 1/2" x 11 1/2" <fabric 1> rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **H** corner triangle. Repeat with another 2" x 2" **H** square along the same opposite and long side of the same 4 1/2" x 11 1/2" <fabric 1> rectangle



Add (1) 1" x 11 1/2" **H** rectangle, followed by (1) 1 1/2" x 11 1/2" <fabric 1> rectangle to the top of previously sewn unit. Should measure 6" x 11 1/2" raw edge to raw edge.



2. Basket handle. Sew together (1) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" **H** square and (1) 1 1/2" x 5" <fabric 1> rectangle. Should measure 1 1/2" x 6" raw edge to raw edge. Set aside.



3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 2" x 2" **H** square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 2" x 2" **K** square. Sew 1/4" away from, on right and left sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield (2) HST units. Align diagonal seams of HST units against 45 degree line of quilting ruler, trim HST units to measure 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" raw edge to raw edge.



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3a. Flower subunit A.

Arrange and sew the following pieces to make the following rows.

Row 1: (2) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" **H** rectangle, (1) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" **H** square, and (1) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" <fabric 2> square.

Row 2: (2) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" **H** squares, and (2) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" <fabric 2> squares.

Row 3: (1) **H/K** HST unit, (2) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" **H** squares, and (1) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" <fabric 2> squares.

Sew Rows together, followed by (1) 3" x 4 1/2" **H** rectangle on top of pieced rows, followed by (2) 1" x 6" **H** rectangles to the left and right sides. Should measure 5 1/2" x 6" raw edge to raw edge.



3b. Flower subunit B.

Arrange and sew the following peices to make the following rows.

Row 1: (1) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" **H** rectangle, (1) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" <fabric 2> square, and (1) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" **H** square.

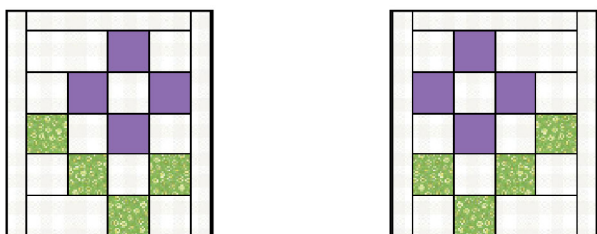
Row 2: (2) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" **H** squares and (2) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" <fabric 2> squares.

Row 3: (1) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" **K** square, (2) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" **H** squares and (1) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" <fabric 2> square.

Row 4: (2) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" **H** squares and (2) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" **K** squares.

Row 5: (1) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" **H** rectangle, (1) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" **K** square, and (1) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" **H** square.

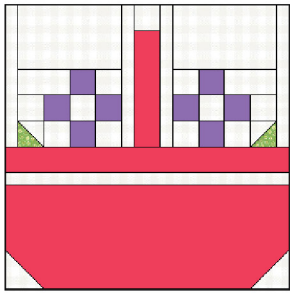
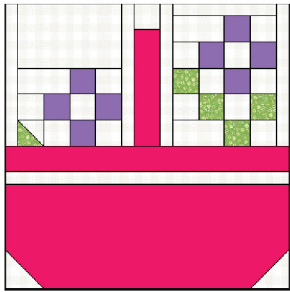
Sew Rows together, followed by (1) 1" x 4 1/2" **H** rectangle on top of pieced rows, followed by (2) 1" x 6" **H** rectangles to the left and right sides. Should measure 5 1/2" x 6" raw edge to raw edge.





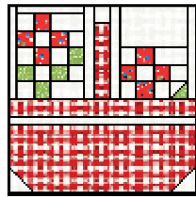
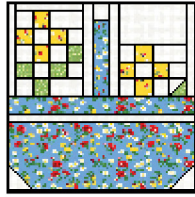
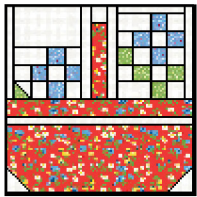
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4. Basket block assembly. Refer to quilt assembly diagrams for fabric placement guide, make basket and flower units, noting orientations of flower subunits. Sew appropriate flower subunits to the opposite long sides of basket handles, before adding the sewn unit to the top of the basket subunit to make a basket block.

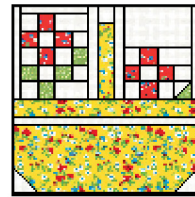
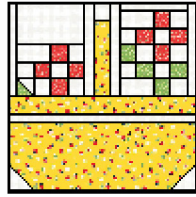
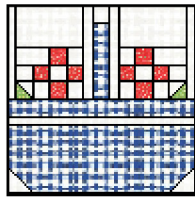
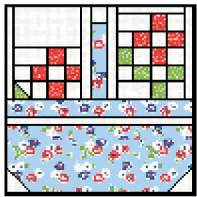

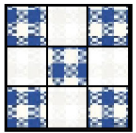




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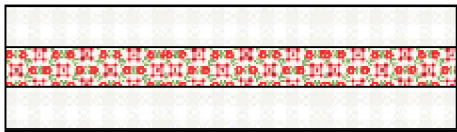
Constructing 9-patch cornerstones

1. Sew together (2) 1 1/2" x WOF **G** and (1) 1 1/2" x WOF **H** strips along the long sides. Cut pieced rows at 1 1/2" intervals (subunit 1).
2. Sew together (2) 1 1/2" x WOF **H** and (1) 1 1/2" x WOF **G** strips along the long sides. Cut pieced rows at 1 1/2" intervals (subunit 2).
3. Arrange and sew together (2) subunit 1 and (1) subunit 2 to make a 9-patch cornerstone. Repeat to make a total of (30) cornerstone units.



Constructing pieced sashing blocks

1. Sew (2) 1 1/2" x 11 1/2" **H** rectangles to the opposite long sides of (1) 1 1/2" x 11 1/2" **O** rectangles to make (1) pieced sashing blocks. Repeat to make (49) pieced sashing block.



Quilt Center Assembly

1. Pieced rows. Arrange and sew together (4) pieced blocks and (5) pieced sashing blocks to make a pieced row.

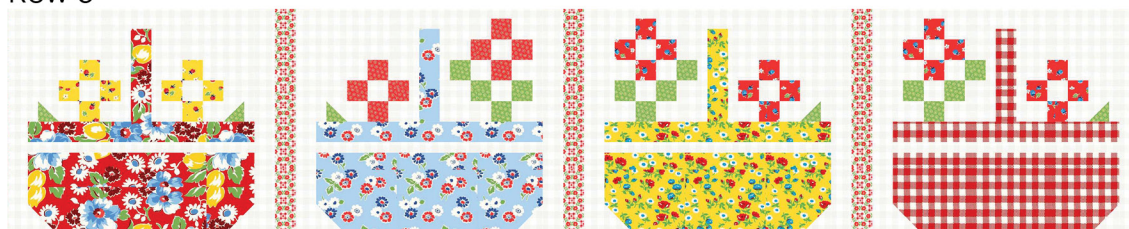

2. Pieced sashing row. Arrange and sew together (5) cornerstones and (4) pieced sashing blocks to make a pieced sashing row. Repeat to make (6) rows.



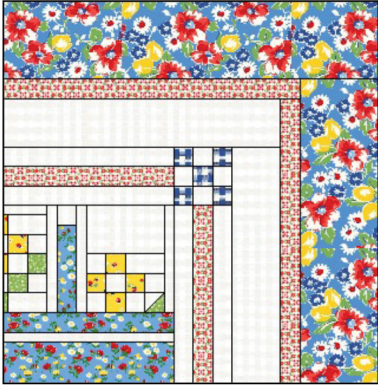
3. Sew pieced rows and pieced sashing rows together to complete quilt center. See quilt assembly diagram on page 9.

Quilt Top Assembly

1. Inner border #1. Sew (2) 3" x 73 1/2" **H** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 3" x 64 1/2" **H** strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
2. Inner border #2. Sew (2) 1 1/2" x 78 1/2" **O** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 1 1/2" x 66 1/2" **O** strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
3. Outer border. Sew (2) 4 1/2" x 80 1/2" **B** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 4 1/2" x 74 1/2" **B** strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete the quilt top.



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Quilting Instructions

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.
