

Note: You may want to cut them slightly larger if doing hand applique to absorb shrinkage. They will be cut down to 12 ½" when the applique process is finished.
В		43387-2	1/8	Applique Blocks: (2) 1" x 42" strips, cut (16) 1" x 4 ½" stems.

Star Block: (2) 2 7/8" x 42" strips; cut into (16) 2 7/8" squares, cut once on diagonal. Side Block: (7) 2 ½" x 42" strips; cut into (12) 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles, (24) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles, and (36) 2 ½" squares. Appliqué Blocks: (8) Large leaf templates + (2) Small flower templates.

G		43387-4	7/8	Binding: (7) 2 ½" x 42" binding strips. Border 2: (6) 1 ½" x 42" strips. Sew end to end and cut into (2) 1 ½" x 50 ½" strips and (2) 1 ½" x 54 ½" strips. Applique Blocks: (16) Small Leaf Templates.

Block Assembly Star Block:

1. Sew a **C** and **I** 2 7/8" triangle together to make a Half Square Triangle (HST). Square up to



2. Sew an I 2 1/2" square to the left side of the HST to make Unit 1. Make 4.






3. Sew an **M** 2 1/2" square to the right side of a HST to make Unit 2. Make 4.



- 4. Sew Unit 1 to the top of Unit 2 to make a block corner. Make 4. Set aside.
- 5. Sew the short side of a Fabric $\bf H$ and $\bf D$ 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " triangle to opposite sides of a Fabric $\bf M$ 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " square as shown in Step 5 diagram.
- 6. Sew the long side of a Fabric **H** 2 7/8" triangle to the upper right of the unit in Step 5, and a Fabric **F** 2 7/8" triangle to the bottom left of the unit to make a center unit.. See Step 6 diagram. Unit should measure $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $4 \frac{1}{2}$ ". Make 4.
- 7. Sew a block corner to both sides of a center unit to make Row 1 of the block. Make 2.

8. Sew w center units to opposite sides of a Fabric **F** 2 ½" square to make Row 2.

9. Sew Row 2 to the bottom of Row 1. Rotate the remaining Row 1 and sew to the bottom of the block to complete. Square up to $10 \, \frac{1}{2}$ ". Make 4.

Side Block:

10. Sew a Fabric **N** 2 ½" square to both ends of a Fabric **C** 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle to make Row 1. Square up to 2 ½" x 10 ½".



11. Sew a Fabric **N** 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square to both sides of a Fabric **C** 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square as shown below. Square up to 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



12. Sew a Fabric \mathbb{C} 2 ½" square to both sides of a Fabric \mathbb{N} 2 ½" square as shown below. Square up to 2 ½" x 6 ½". Sew to the bottom of the unit in Step 11.







13. Sew a Fabric \mathbb{C} 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangle to both sides of the unit in Step 12 to make Row 2. Square up to 10 ½" x 4 ½".



14. Sew Row 2 to the bottom of Row 1. Sew a Fabric **K** 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the bottom of the block to complete. Square up to 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Make 12.

Applique Blocks:

- 15. Fold the Fabric **A** and **I** 12 ½" squares in half diagonally twice and press lightly to mark centering lines. Using your favorite method of applique, prepare your pieces for the flowers, circles and leaves.
- 16. Fold the Fabric **B** 1" \times 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " stem pieces in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, and sew a 1/8" seam. Slide a $\frac{1}{4}$ " bias bar or shift the seam to the back and press the stems flat.
- 17. Working from back to front, and using the pressed background squares, pin or glue the prepared appliques pieces into position and stitch them down using your favorite method. I use a monofilament thread in my sewing machine on the top thread only, and stitch a tiny zig zag along the edge of each piece. Lay the stems pointing to the corners out from the center flower. Layer the flower, add the circles to the Fabric I background blocks and the stars to the Fabric A background blocks. Square up the blocks to 12 ½" x 12 ½".

Quilt Assembly

18. Sew an applique block with stars to the left long side of a Fabric \mathbf{H} 2 ½" x 12 ½" rectangle. Sew an applique block with circles to the right side. Make 2.




19. Sew a Fabric **H** 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the bottom of the row in Step 18. Rotate the second block row and sew to the bottom of the Fabric **H** strip. The quilt center should now measure 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



20. Sew a Fabric **H** 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to both sides of the quilt center. Sew a Fabric **H** 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center.

21. Sew (3) Side Blocks together in a row as shown. Make 4. Sew the checkerboard side of a row to both sides of the quilt.



22. Sew a Star Block to both ends of the remaining 2 rows of Side Blocks. Make 2.








- 23. Sew a row in Step 22 to the top of the quilt. Rotate and sew the remaining row from Step 22 to the bottom of the quilt.
- 24. Sew the (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric **G** strips to the sides of the quilt. Sew the (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric **G** strips to the top and bottom of quilt.
- 25. Sew the (2) 3" x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric **J** strips to the sides of quilt center. Sew the (2) 3" x 59 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric **J** strips to the top and bottom of quilt.

Finishing

- 26. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste the layers together and quilt as desired.
- 27. Use the (7) Fabric G 2-1/2" x WOF strips short ends together and use to bind the quilt.







Note: Trace and cut out on the darker solid lines for fusible appliqué. Use the lighter outer lines for needle turn appliqué.
