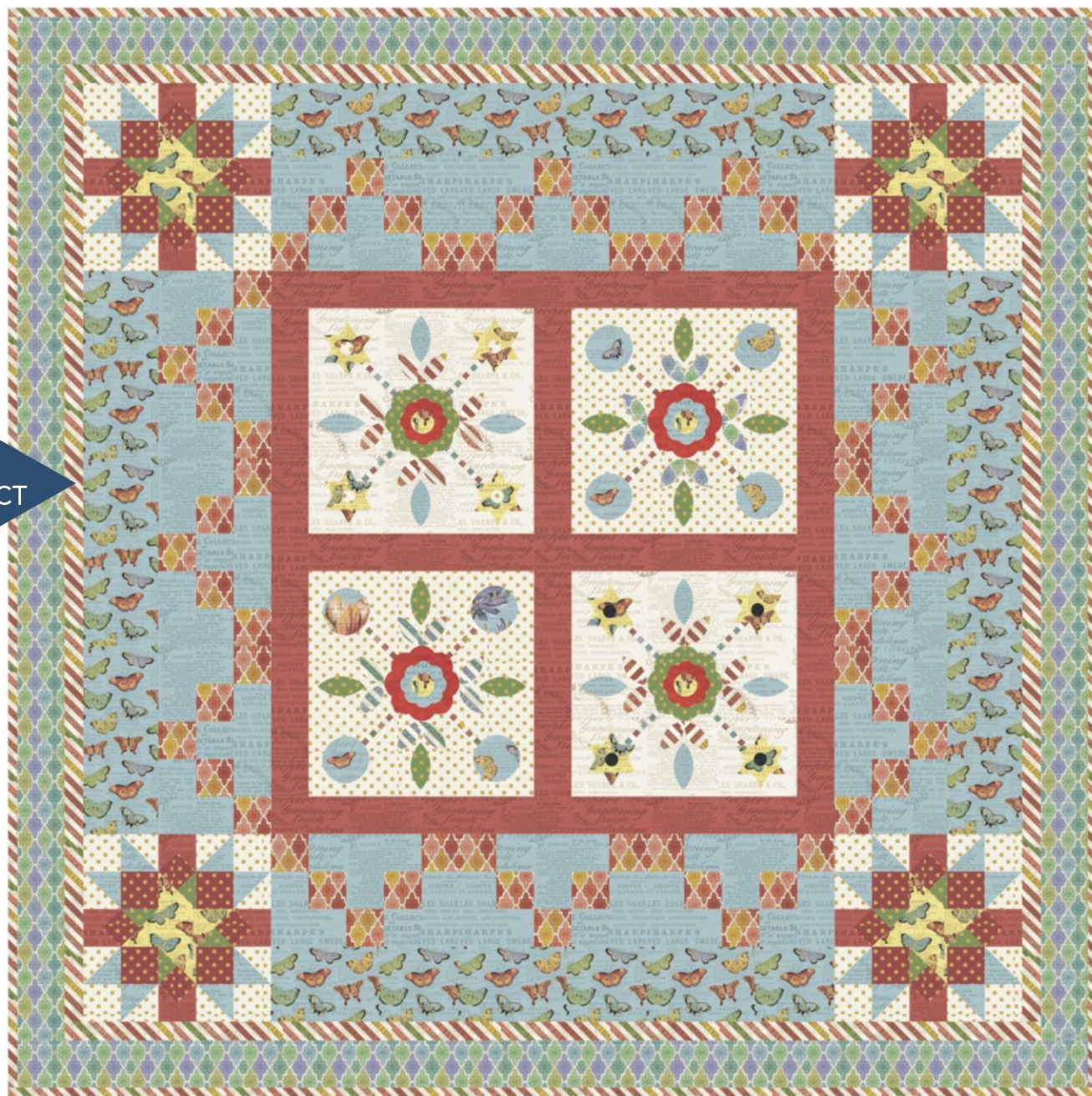

KEY	FABRIC	SKU	YD	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A		43388-1	1/2	<u>Applique Blocks:</u> (1) 12 1/2" x 42" strip; cut into (2) 12 1/2" squares. <i>Note: You may want to cut them slightly larger if doing hand applique to absorb shrinkage. They will be cut down to 12 1/2" when the applique process is finished.</i>
B		43387-2	1/8	<u>Applique Blocks:</u> (2) 1" x 42" strips, cut (16) 1" x 4 1/2" stems.
C		43388-2	7/8	<i>Note: Fabric cutting does not take directionality in account. You may need to adjust fabric amount and cutting if you prefer all Fabric C pieces to face right side up.</i> <u>Star Block:</u> (2) 2 7/8" x 42" strips; cut into (16) 2 7/8" squares, cut once on diagonal. <u>Side Block:</u> (7) 2 1/2" x 42" strips; cut into (12) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles, (24) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles, and (36) 2 1/2" squares. <u>Applique Blocks:</u> (8) Large leaf templates + (2) Small flower templates.
D		43389M-5	1/4	<u>Applique Blocks:</u> (2) Large Flower Templates, (8) Large Leaf Templates. <u>Star Block:</u> (1) 3 1/4" x 42" strip; cut into (4) 3 1/4" squares, cut twice on diagonal.
E		37098-52 *Palette	1/4	<u>Applique Blocks:</u> (2) Large Flower Templates, (2) Medium Flower Templates and (8) Small Circle Templates.
F		43385M-3	3/8	<u>Star Block:</u> (1) 2 7/8" x 42" strip; cut into (8) 2 7/8" squares, cut once on diagonal, and (4) 2 1/2" squares. <u>Applique Blocks:</u> (8) Star Templates and (4) Medium circle templates.
G		43387-4	7/8	<u>Binding:</u> (7) 2 1/2" x 42" binding strips. <u>Border 2:</u> (6) 1 1/2" x 42" strips. Sew end to end and cut into (2) 1 1/2" x 50 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips. <u>Applique Blocks:</u> (16) Small Leaf Templates.
H		43388-4	5/8	<u>Star Block:</u> (1) 3 1/4" x 42" strip; cut into (4) 3 1/4" squares, cut twice on diagonal. (1) 2 7/8" x 42" strips; cut into (8) 2 7/8" squares, cut once on diagonal. <u>Sashing and Sashing Border:</u> (4) 2 1/2" x 42" strips; cut into (3) 2 1/2" x 26 1/2" strips, (2) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips, and (2) 2 1/2" x 30 1/2" strips.



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I		43389M-1	2/3	<u>Applique Blocks:</u> (1) 12 1/2" x 42" strip; cut into (2) 12 1/2" squares. <u>Star Block:</u> (2) 2 7/8" x 42" strips; cut into (16) 2 7/8" squares, cut once on diagonal. (1) 2 1/2" x 42" strip; cut into (16) 2 1/2" squares.
J		43386-2	3/4	<u>Applique Blocks:</u> (16) Small Leaf Templates. <u>Outer Border:</u> (6) 3" x 42" strips. Sew end to end and cut into (2) 3" x 54 1/2" strips and (2) 3" x 59 1/2" strips.
K		43385M-2	1/2	<u>Side Blocks:</u> (3) 4 1/2" x 42" strips; cut into (12) 4 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles.
L		43384M-2	1/4	<u>Applique Blocks:</u> Fussy cut (8) Large Circle Templates with a butterfly in the center.
M		43389M-4	1/4	<u>Star Block:</u> (1) 2 1/2" x 42" strip; cut into (16) 2 1/2" squares. (1) 1 7/8" x 42" strip; cut into (16) 1 7/8" squares.
N		43386-4	3/8	<u>Side Blocks:</u> (4) 2 1/2" x 42" strip; cut into (60) 2 1/2" squares.

Block Assembly

Star Block:

1. Sew a **C** and **I** 2 7/8" triangle together to make a Half Square Triangle (HST). Square up to 2 1/2". Make 8.



2. Sew an **I** 2 1/2" square to the left side of the HST to make Unit 1. Make 4.





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3. Sew an **M** 2 1/2" square to the right side of a HST to make Unit 2. Make 4.



4. Sew Unit 1 to the top of Unit 2 to make a block corner. Make 4. Set aside.

5. Sew the short side of a Fabric **H** and **D** 3 1/4" triangle to opposite sides of a Fabric **M** 1 7/8" square as shown in Step 5 diagram.

6. Sew the long side of a Fabric **H** 2 7/8" triangle to the upper right of the unit in Step 5, and a Fabric **F** 2 7/8" triangle to the bottom left of the unit to make a center unit.. See Step 6 diagram. Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 4 1/2". Make 4.

7. Sew a block corner to both sides of a center unit to make Row 1 of the block. Make 2.

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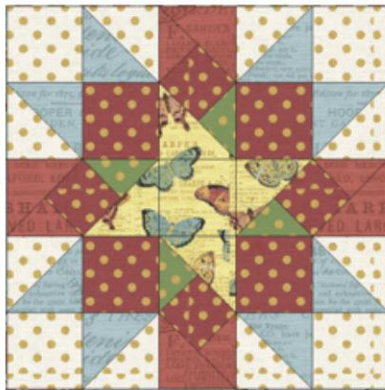
8. Sew w center units to opposite sides of a Fabric **F** 2 ½" square to make Row 2.

9. Sew Row 2 to the bottom of Row 1. Rotate the remaining Row 1 and sew to the bottom of the block to complete. Square up to 10 ½". Make 4.

Side Block:

10. Sew a Fabric **N** 2 ½" square to both ends of a Fabric **C** 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle to make Row 1. Square up to 2 ½" x 10 ½".



11. Sew a Fabric **N** 2 ½" square to both sides of a Fabric **C** 2 ½" square as shown below. Square up to 2 ½" x 6 ½".



12. Sew a Fabric **C** 2 ½" square to both sides of a Fabric **N** 2 ½" square as shown below. Square up to 2 ½" x 6 ½". Sew to the bottom of the unit in Step 11.





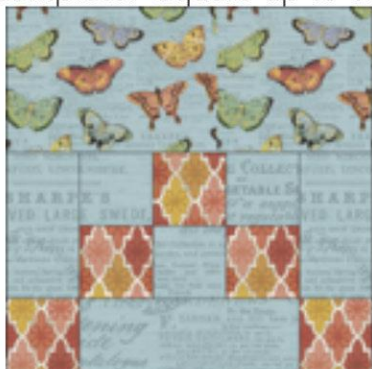
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13. Sew a Fabric **C** 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangle to both sides of the unit in Step 12 to make Row 2. Square up to 10 ½" x 4 ½".



14. Sew Row 2 to the bottom of Row 1. Sew a Fabric **K** 10 ½" x 4 ½" rectangle to the bottom of the block to complete. Square up to 10 ½". Make 12.

Applique Blocks:

15. Fold the Fabric **A** and **I** 12 ½" squares in half diagonally twice and press lightly to mark centering lines. Using your favorite method of applique, prepare your pieces for the flowers, circles and leaves.

16. Fold the Fabric **B** 1" x 4 ½" stem pieces in half lengthwise, wrong sides together, and sew a 1/8" seam. Slide a ¼" bias bar or shift the seam to the back and press the stems flat.

17. Working from back to front, and using the pressed background squares, pin or glue the prepared appliques pieces into position and stitch them down using your favorite method. I use a monofilament thread in my sewing machine on the top thread only, and stitch a tiny zig zag along the edge of each piece. Lay the stems pointing to the corners out from the center flower. Layer the flower, add the circles to the Fabric **I** background blocks and the stars to the Fabric **A** background blocks. Square up the blocks to 12 ½" x 12 ½".

Quilt Assembly

18. Sew an applique block with stars to the left long side of a Fabric **H** 2 ½" x 12 ½" rectangle. Sew an applique block with circles to the right side. Make 2.

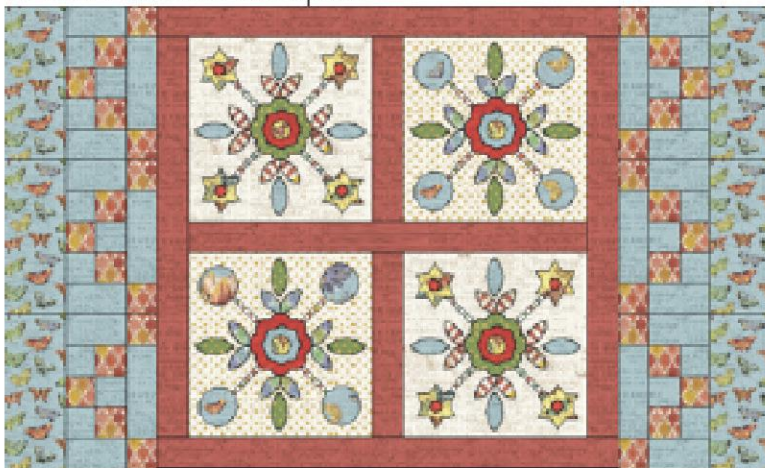
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19. Sew a Fabric **H** 2 ½" x 26 ½" strip to the bottom of the row in Step 18. Rotate the second block row and sew to the bottom of the Fabric **H** strip. The quilt center should now measure 26 ½" x 26 ½".

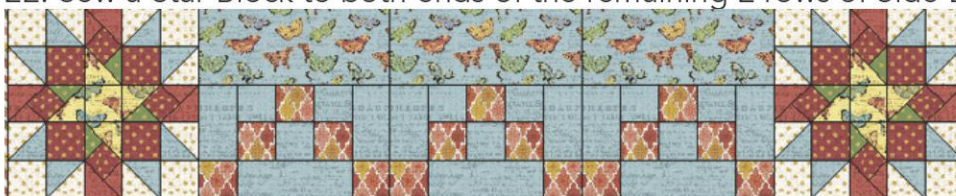


20. Sew a Fabric **H** 2 ½" x 26 ½" strip to both sides of the quilt center. Sew a Fabric **H** 2 ½" x 30 ½" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center.

21. Sew (3) Side Blocks together in a row as shown. Make 4. Sew the checkerboard side of a row to both sides of the quilt.



22. Sew a Star Block to both ends of the remaining 2 rows of Side Blocks. Make 2.



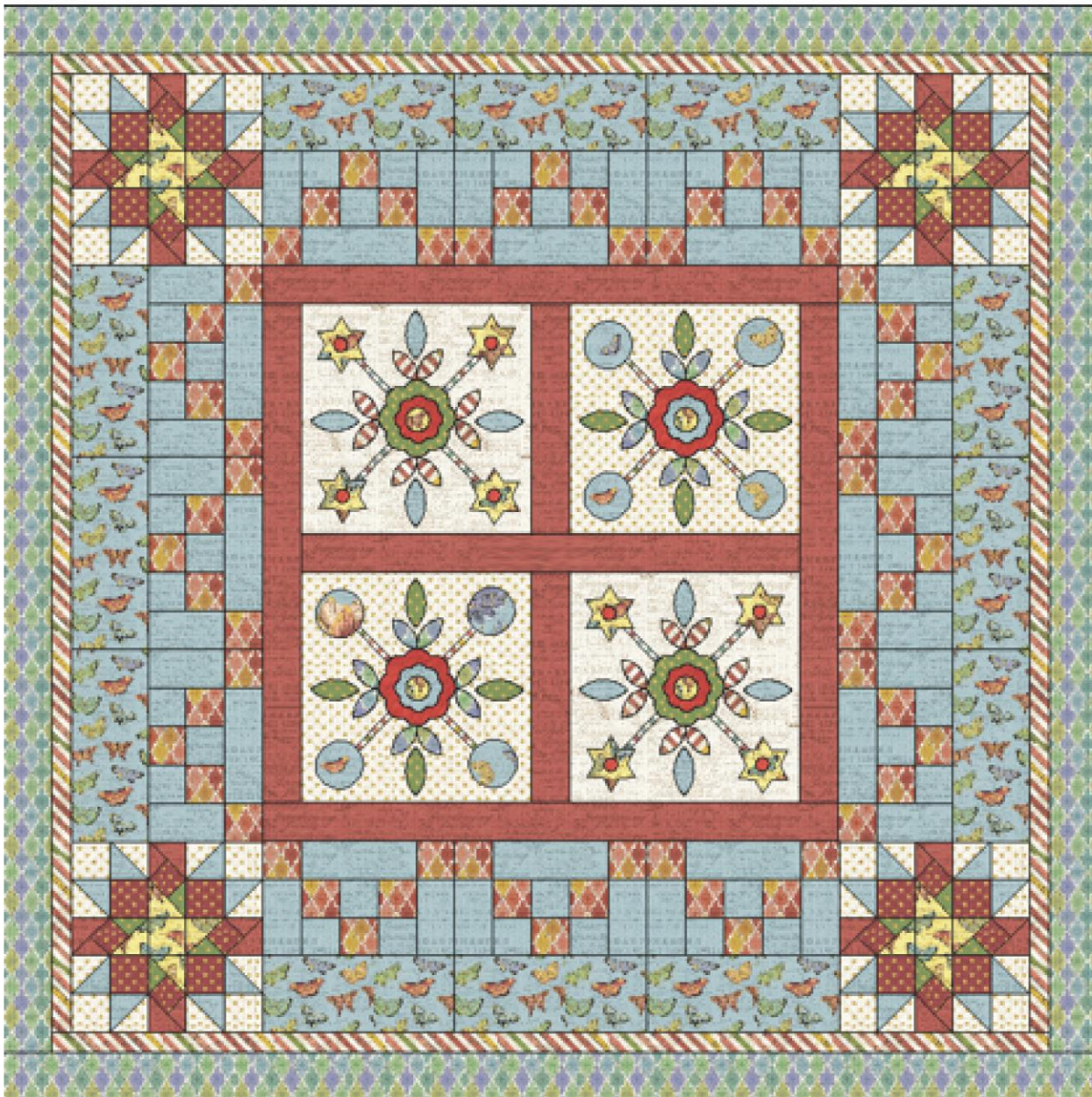


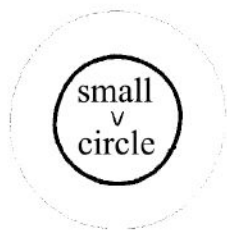
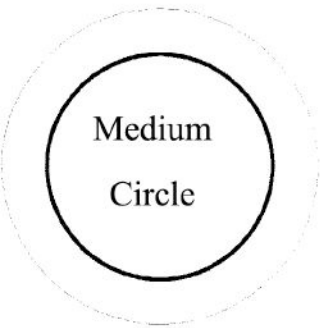
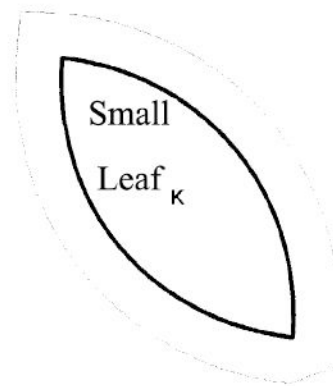
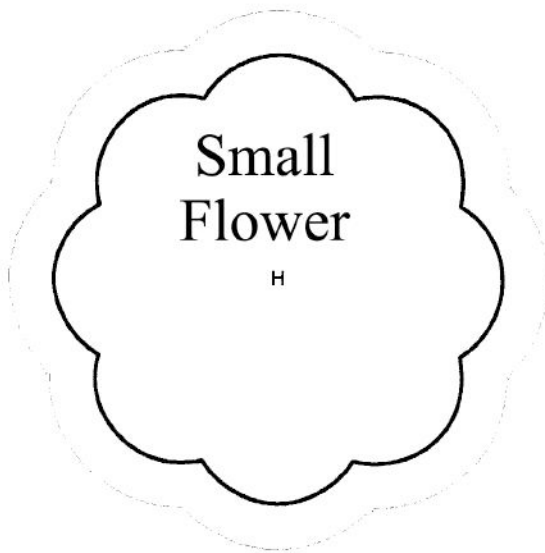
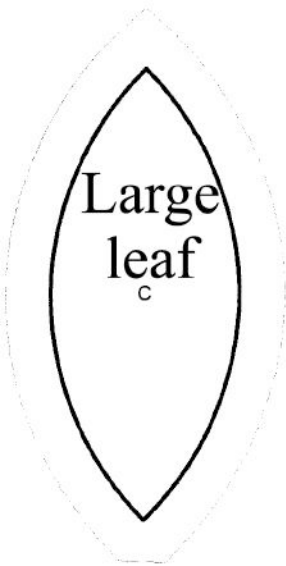
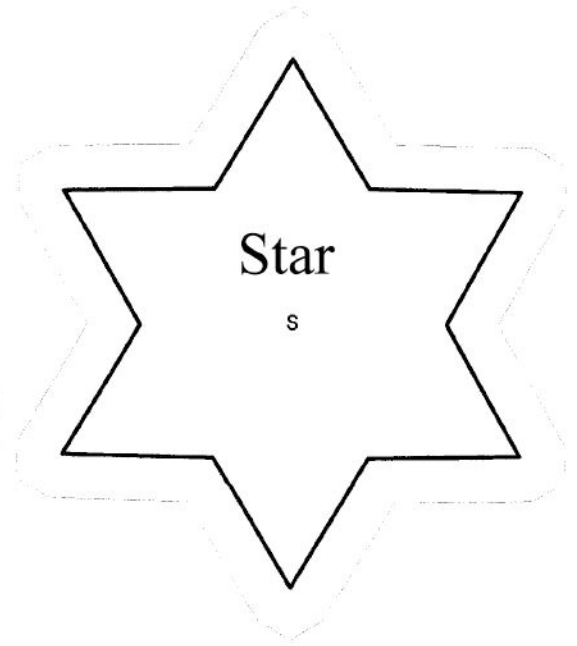
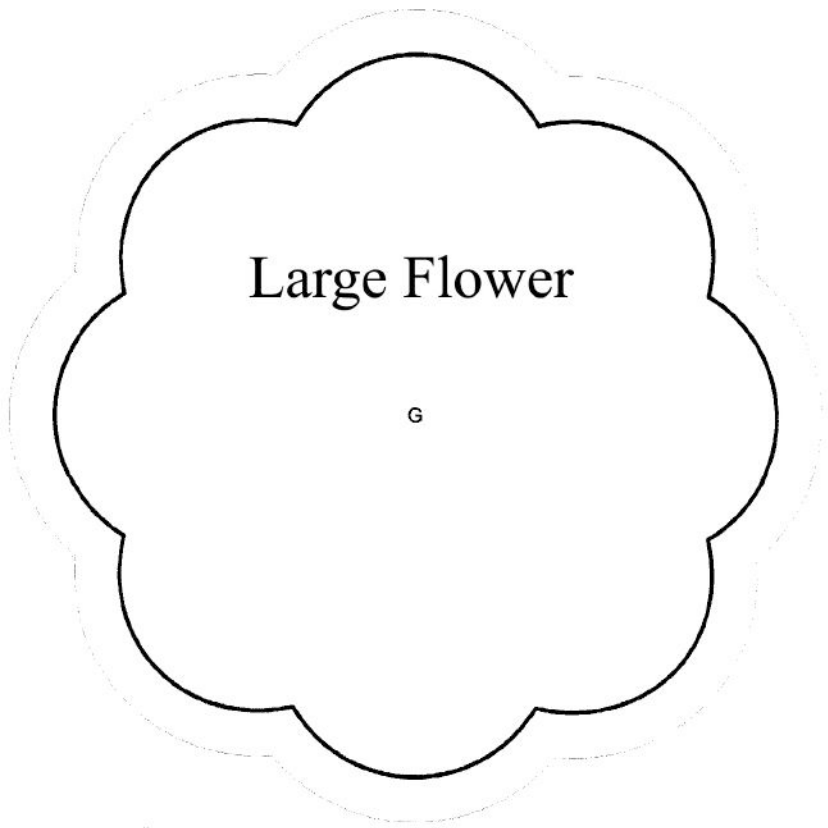
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23. Sew a row in Step 22 to the top of the quilt. Rotate and sew the remaining row from Step 22 to the bottom of the quilt.
24. Sew the (2) 2 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric **G** strips to the sides of the quilt. Sew the (2) 2 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric **G** strips to the top and bottom of quilt.
25. Sew the (2) 3" x 54 ½" Fabric **J** strips to the sides of quilt center. Sew the (2) 3" x 59 ½" Fabric **J** strips to the top and bottom of quilt.

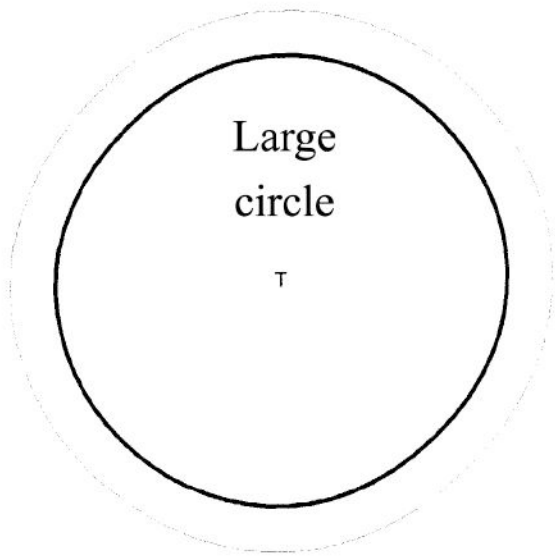
Finishing

26. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste the layers together and quilt as desired.
27. Use the (7) Fabric **G** 2-1/2" x WOF strips short ends together and use to bind the quilt.





Note: Trace and cut out on the darker solid lines for fusible appliqué. Use the lighter outer lines for needle turn appliqué.



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
