

Α		32034-18 White	1-2/3	Sashing pieces: (8) 1.5" x 42". Subcut (8) 1.5" x 16.5" and (2) 1.5" x 19.5" from 5 strips. Piece remaining 3 strips and subcut (2) 1.5" x 53.5" strips. Inner border #1: (5) 1.5" x 42". Piece strips and subcut (2) 1.5" x 48.5" and (2) 1.5" x 50.5" strips. Pieced blocks: (1) 2.5" x 42". Subcut (5) 2.5" x 2.5" squares. (5) 2-7/8" x 42". Subcut (60) 2-7/8" x 2-7/8" squares. (1) 4-7/8" x 42". Subcut (3) 4-7/8" x 4-7/8" squares. Cut squares diagonally once to yield 6 half-square-triangles. Will only use 5. (1) 6-7/8" x 42". Subcut (5) 6-7/8" x 6-7/8" squares. Cut squares diagonally once to yield 10 half-square-triangles. Use remainder fabric, cut (5) pieces each for D, F, H, J using provided templates.
В		41927-2 Charcoal	1/4	Pieced blocks: (2) 2-7/8" x 42". Subcut (25) 2-7/8" x 2-7/8" squares. Reserve 20 for constructing HST units. Cut remaining squares diagonally once to yield 10 half-square-triangles.
С		41928-1 Dove Grey	1/4	Pieced blocks: (2) 2-7/8" x 42". Subcut (25) 2-7/8" x 2-7/8" squares. Reserve 20 for constructing HST units. Cut remaining squares diagonally once to yield 10 half-square-triangles.
D		41932-1 Dove Grey	1/4	Pieced blocks: (1) 6-7/8" x 42". Subcut (3) 6-7/8" x 6-7/8" and (10) 2.5" x 2.5" squares. Cut 6-7/8" squares diagonally once to yield (6) half-square triangles (will use only 5).
E		41929-2 Charcoal	1/4	Pieced blocks: Cut (5) pieces each for I, G, K using provided templates.
F		41926-1 Dove Grey	5/8	Pieced corner and side setting triangles: (5) 2.5" x 42". Subcut (72) 2.5" x 2.5" squares. (2) 2-7/8" x 42". Subcut (24) 2-7/8" x 2-7/8" squares. Cut squares diagonally once to yield (48) half-square-triangles.

G		41928-4 Lilac	1/4	Pieced blocks: (2) 2-7/8" x 42". Subcut (20) 2-7/8" x 2-7/8" squares. Reserve 15 squares for constructing HST units. Subcut remaining squares diagonally once to yield 10 half-square-triangles.
н		41930-6 Pink	5/8	Pieced blocks: (1) 2-7/8" x 2-7/8" squares. Subcut (5) 2-7/8" x 2-7/8" squares. Binding: (7) 2-1/4" x 42" strips
I		41926-2 Charcoal	3/4	Outer border: (6) 4" x 42". Piece strips and subcut (2) 4" x 56" and (2) 4" x 63" strips.
J		41932-5 Olive	7/8	Pieced corner and side setting triangles: (6) 2.5" x 42". Subcut (88) 2.5" x 2.5" squares. (1) 2-7/8" x 42". Subcut (8) 2-7/8" x 2-7/8" squares. Inner border #3 (6) 1.5" x 42". Piece strips and subcut (2) 1.5" x 54" and (2) 1.5" x 56" strips.

1. HST units:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) \mathbf{H} 2-7/8" x 2-7/8" square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) \mathbf{A} 2-7/8" x 2-7/8" square. Sew 1/4" from, on right and left sides, of drawn line. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield 2 HST units. Sq to 2-1/2"



Repeat process to make HST units in the following color ways:


(6) HST units G, (8) HST units B, (8) HST units C

2. Section 1:

Arrange and sew (1) **A** 2.5" x 2.5" square, (1) **H** HST Unit, (3) **G** HST units, and (1) **G** half-square-triangle to make Row #1.

Arrange and sew (1) **D** 2.5" x 2.5" square, (1) **H** HST unit, (4) **B** HST units, and (1) **B** half-square triangle to make Row #2. Arrange and sew (1) **D** 2.5" x 2.5" square, (1) **G** HST unit, (1) **B** HST unit, (4) **C** HST units, and (1) **C** half-square-triangle to make Row #3.

Sew Rows together, and add (1) **A** 6-7/8" half-square-triangle to the right of sewn pieced row unit to complete Section 1.



3. Section 2:

Arrange and sew (2) G HST units, and (1) G half-square-triangle to make Column #1.

Arrange and sew (3) **B** HST units, and (1) **B** half-square-triangle to make Column #2.

Arrange and sew (4) C HST units, and (1) C half-square-triangle to make Column #3.

Sew Columns together, and add (1) **A** 6-7/8" half-square-triangle to the right of sewn pieced row unit to complete Section 2.


4. Section 3:

Template piece F, H, I, J, D, G, K.






Add (1) D 6-7/8" half-square-triangle C and (1) A 4-7/8" half-square-triangle (E) to complete Section 3, as shown.



5. Sew Sections 2 and 3 together, and add Section 1 on top of the sewn unit to complete 1 block. Square to 16 1/2".



Repeat to make a total of 5 pieced tree blocks.

Constructing Pieced Corner Setting Triangles


6. Arrange and sew together (6) 2.5" x 2.5" squares [3 **F** and 3 **J**] and 2 half-square-triangles [1 **F** and 1 **J**] to make column #1.

Arrange and sew together (4) 2.5" x 2.5" squares [2 **F** and 2 **J**] and 2 half-square-triangles [1 **F** and 1 **J**] to make column #2.

Arrange and sew together (2) 2.5" \times 2.5" squares [1 **F** and 1 **J**] and 2 half-square-triangles [1 **F** and 1 **J**] to make column #3

Arrange and sew together (2) half-square-triangles [1 F and 1 J] to make column #4.

Sew columns together to complete 1 pieced corner setting triangle.




Repeat to make a total of 2 pieced corner setting triangles, and 2 mirror-imaged pieced corner setting triangles.



Constructing Pieced Side Setting Triangles

7. Arrange and sew together (7) 2.5" x 2.5" squares [4 J, 3 F] and 1 F half-square-triangle to make Column #1. Arrange and sew together (6) 2.5" x 2.5" squares [3 J, 3 F] and 1 F half-square-triangle to make Column #2. Arrange and sew together (5) 2.5" x 2.5" squares [3 J, 2 F] and 1 F half-square-triangle to make Column #3. Arrange and sew together (4) 2.5" x 2.5" squares [2 J, 2 F] and 1 F half-square-triangle to make Column #4. Arrange and sew together (3) 2.5" x 2.5" squares [2 J, 1 F] and 1 F half-square-triangle to make Column #5. Arrange and sew together (2) 2.5" x 2.5" squares [1 J, 1 F] and 1 F half-square-triangle to make Column #6. Arrange and sew together (1) 2.5" x 2.5" J and 1 F half-square-triangle to make Column #7. Sew columns together. Add 1 F half-square-triangle right by Column #7 to complete 1 pieced side setting triangle.



Repeat to make a total of 4 pieced side setting triangles.

Quilt Top Assembly

Quilt Center.

Pieced diagonal rows:


8. Arrange and sew together 1 pieced block, (2) **A** 1.5" x 16.5" sashing rectangles, and 2 pieced setting triangles into a diagonal row. Repeat to make 2 rows (Row 1 & 3).

Arrange and sew together 3 pieced blocks, (4) A 1.5" x 16.5" sashing rectangles into a diagonal row (Row 2).

Arrange and sew together pieced diagonal rows and (2) 1.5" x 19.5" and (2) A 1.5" x 53.5" sashing rows.

Add a pieced corner setting triangle to each corner to complete quilt center.

Some of the A sashing pieces might be "sticking out". Trim around quilt center to include 1/4" seam allowance all around. The quilt center should measure 48.5" x 48.5" at raw edge to raw edge at this point.






Border Assembly

9. Inner border #1. Sew (2) \mathbf{A} 1.5" x 48.5" strips to the opposite sides of quilt center. Sew (2) \mathbf{A} 1.5" x 50.5" strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.

Inner border #2. Sew (2) **K** 2-1/4" x 50.5" strips to the opposite sides of quilt center. Sew (2) **K** 2-1/4" x 54" to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.

Inner border #3. Sew (2) \mathbf{J} 1.5" x 54" strips to the opposite sides of quilt center. Sew (2) 1.5" x 56" \mathbf{J} strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center.

Outer border. Sew (2) I 4" x 56" strips to the opposite sides of quilt center. Sew (2) 4" x 63" I strips to the remaining opposite sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



Quilting Instructions:

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.
