Before You Start

- Success with this pattern starts with reading the directions through to the end!
- As you follow the cutting chart you may find it helpful to use inexpensive paper plates for organizing your cut borders and block pieces. Write the names of the items on the plates and stack them to save space
- If you have any questions about the processes suggested here, check first with your local quilt shop. Look on line for helpful videos.
- Now is the time to accurately cut, sew with a ¼" seam allowance, press diligently and be patient and enjoy each step in the creation of this design.
- This pattern may have some fabric leftover. (Not always a bad thing!) We have not allowed for shrinkage. Purchase extra if you prefer to prewash your fabrics.

16	1/8 yard	41291-1 Charcoal	Block Rectangles	Cut eight 2 ½" x 4 ½".
	3/8 yard	41292-2 Bone	Block Rectangles	Cut two 4 ½" strips. Recut into four 4 ½" x 12 ½"rectangles.
	1/2 yard	41292-3 Stone	Block Strips Block Squares	Cut four 2 ½" strips. Recut into four 2 ½" x 30 ½" and eight 2 ½" squares.



		Star Points	Cut two 2 7/8" strips. Recut into 16 squares and cut once diagonally to make 32 triangles.
3/8 yard	41293-1 Charcoal	Star Points Block Rectangles	Cut two 2 7/8" strips. Recut 20 – 2 7/8" squares. Cut once diagonally to make 40 triangles. Cut eight 2 ½" x 4 ½".
3/8 yard	41291-2 Bone	Rectangles Block Squares	Cut four 2 ½" strips. Recut into four 2 ½" x 20 ½" and eight 2 ½" squares.
3/4 yard	41294-1 Charcoal	Narrow Border Binding	Cut four 1 ½" strips. Measure across center of quilt to get accurate lengths, add to each side. Cut six 2 ¼" strips.
1/8 yard	41292-1 Charcoal	Star Point Triangles	Cut four 2 7/8" squares. Cut once diagonally to make 8 triangles.
1/4 yard	41296-2 Bone	Block Squares	Cut two 3 3/8" strips. Recut into 20 – 3 3/8" squares.
3 1/3 yards	Your choice	Backing	Cut two 58" long pieces. Sew together lengthwise.

Using these elements and referring to the quilt picture assemble in strips and join to the center square. Pay close attention to the proper orientation of the blocks. Using a design wall, the floor or bed, etc. lay out all the elements before sewing together. Check and double check!

After completing the top make a quilt sandwich and quilt and bind as desired.
