Subcut 25 (2 1/2" x 2 1/2") squares and 100 (2 1/2" x 4 1/2") rectangles.            2 (3 1/2" x WOF). Subcut 25 (2 1/2" x 3 1/2") rectangles            6 (4 1/2" x WOF). ### Constructing Pieced Blocks (top left block as example)

1. Leaf section. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 1 (2" x 2") **P** square. Place square, right sides together, on 1 (2" x 2") **A** square. Sew 1/4" away from, on right and left sides of drawn line. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield 2 HST units. Repeat to make a total of 4 HST units. Block will use 3, save remaining for other blocks. Trim each HST to measure 1-1/2 square.

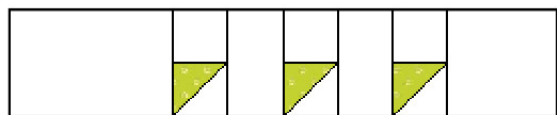


Sew 1 (1 1/2" x 1 1/2") **A** square to the top of HST unit.

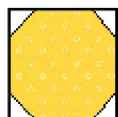


Repeat to make 3 subunits.

Arrange and sew together 3 subunits, 2 (1 1/2" x 2 1/2") **A** rectangles, 1 (2 1/2" x 2 1/2") **A** square and 1 (2 1/2" x 3 1/2") **A** rectangle to complete leaf section.



2. Fruit section. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 1 (1" x 1") **A** square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of 1 (2 1/2" x 2 1/2") **Q** square. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **A** corner triangle. Repeat with 3 additional (1" x 1") **A** squares at the remaining corners of the same **Q** square.



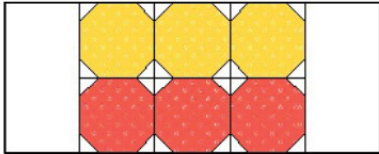


# Fruit Bowls

Repeat to make 3 **Q** and 3 **R** snowball units.

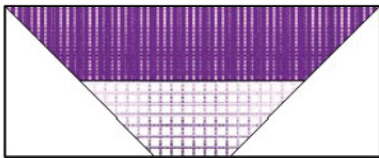
Arrange and sew together 3 **Q** snowball units to make a row. Repeat for 3 **R** snowball units. Sew the rows together.

Sew 2 (2 1/2" x 4 1/2") **A** rectangles to the opposite short sides of the sewn rows to complete fruit section.

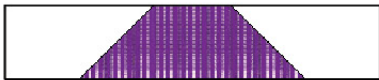


### 3. Fruit bowl section.

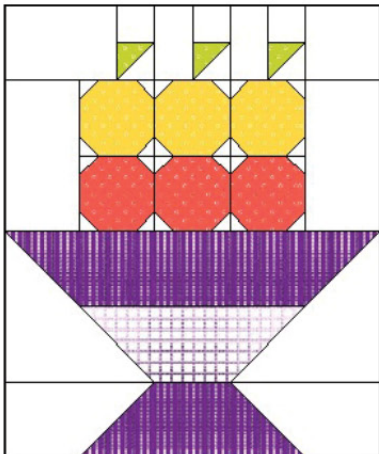
Sew 1 (2 1/2" x 10 1/2") **F** rectangle and 1 (2 1/2" x 10 1/2") **V** rectangle. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 1 (4 1/2" x 4 1/2") **A** square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of the pieced row unit. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **A** corner triangle. Repeat with another (4 1/2" x 4 1/2") **A** square at the other corner of the pieced row unit to complete the top subunit of bowl section.



Sew 2 (2 1/2" x 4 1/2") **A** rectangle to the opposite short sides of 1 (2 1/2" x 6 1/2") **F** rectangle using diagonal seams, as shown to complete the bottom subunit of bowl section.



Sew subunits together to complete section.



4. Refer to quilt center diagram for fabric placements to construct remaining blocks.

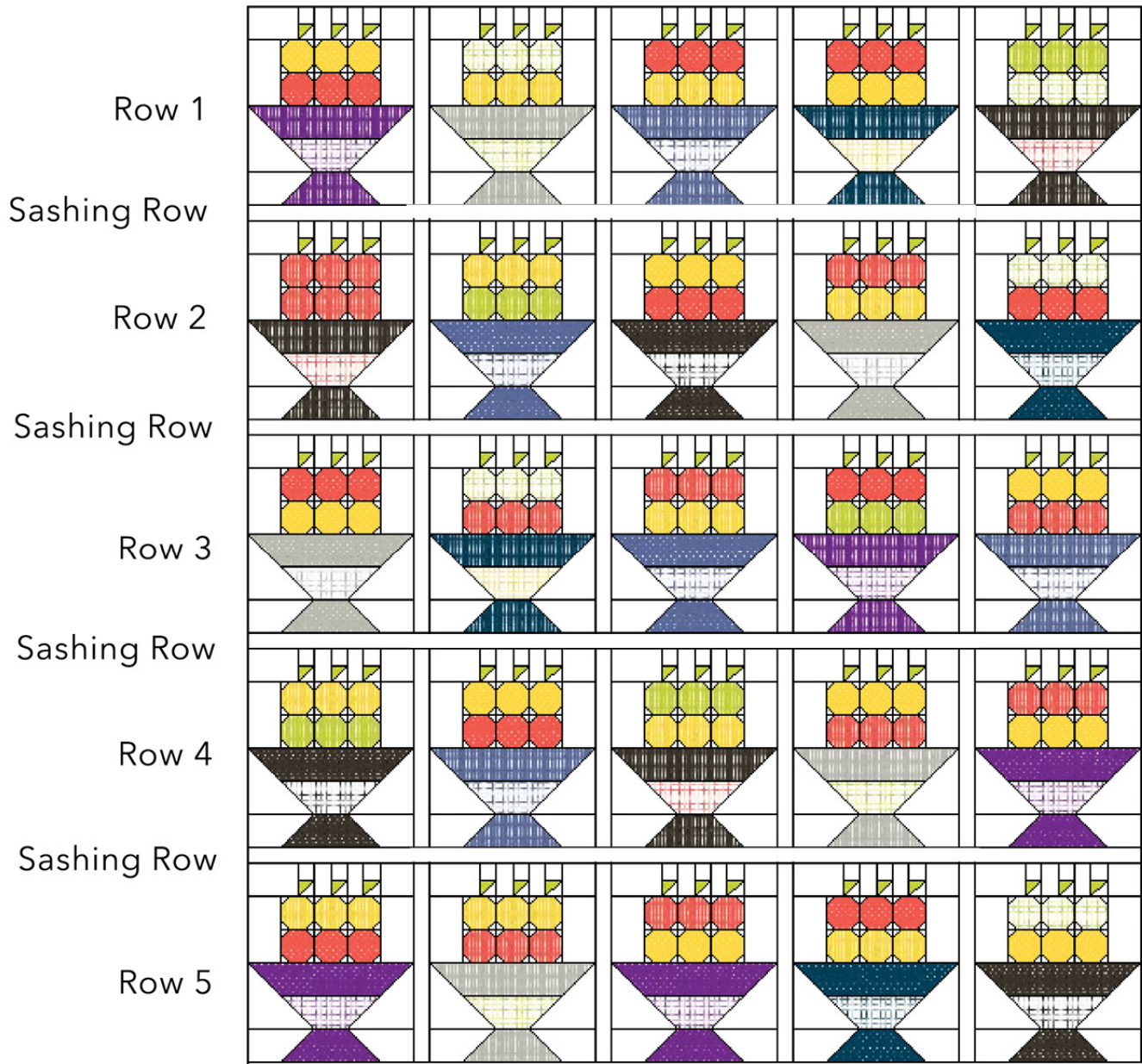




# Fruit Bowls

## Quilt Center Assembly.

1. Pieced Rows. Sew 5 pieced blocks and 4 (1 1/2" x 12 1/2") **A** sashing rectangles to make a pieced row.
2. Sew pieced rows and (1 1/2" x 54 1/2") **A** sashing strips together to complete quilt center. Please note that sashing strips are cut as whole pieces, and not pieced.

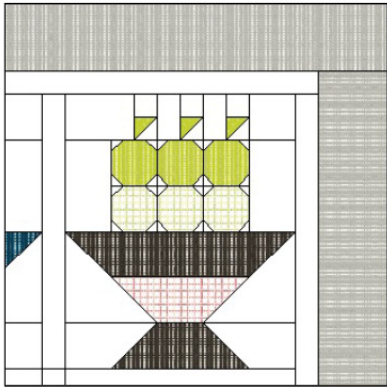




# Fruit Bowls

## Quilt Top Assembly

1. Inner border. Sew 2 (1 1/2" x 64 1/2") **A** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (1 1/2" x 56 1/2") **A** strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
2. Outer border. Sew 2 (3 1/2" x 66 1/2") **B** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew 2 (3 1/2" x 62 1/2") **B** strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



## Quilting Instructions:

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.
