	1/4 yard	38979-3 Blue	Third Border	Cut four 2" strips.
	1/2 yards	38977-2 Green	Fourth Border	Cut four 3 1/2" strips.
	3/8 yard	38977-1 Red	Binding	Cut four 2 1/4" strips
	1 ½ yard	38978-3 Blue	Backing Batting	No cutting needed.

	1/2 yard	33762A-1 Red	Borders Bindings	Cut four 1 inch strips. Cut four 2 ¼ inch strips.
	1 3/4 yards	38976 – X Multi	Backing Borders	Cut four 18" x 24" pieces. Cut four 1 1/4 inch strips.
	1/8 yard	38977-2 Green	Border	Cut two 1 ¼ inch strips.
	1/8 yard	38977-1 Red	Border	Cut two 1 ¼ inch strips.

Batting or fusible fleece needed approximately 18" x 24" for each placemat.

Sewing instructions for wall-hanging:

Making the Quilt

- 1. Measure the length thru the panel middle and cut first border strips to match. Sew and press seams toward the panel.
- 2. Measure across the width of the panel and borders and cut strips to match. Sew and press seams toward the panel.
- 3. Repeat for the next three borders pressing seams toward darker fabric.
- 4. Make quilt sandwich, quilt as desired and bind.

Sewing instructions for placemats:

Making the Quilt

Refer to placemat pictures for correct fabric placement.

Notice which borders and bindings go with each panel.

- 1. Measure the length thru the panel middle and cut first border strips to match. Sew and press seams toward the panel.
- 2. Measure across the width of the panel and borders and cut strips to match. Sew and press seams toward the panel.
- 3. Repeat for the next border pressing seams toward darker fabric.
- 4. Make quilt sandwich, quilt as desired and bind.
