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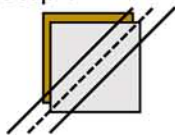
## Piecing Instructions:

Note: All seam allowances are  $\frac{1}{4}$ "

### HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE UNITS

1. Take (1) 4" **G** square and (1) 4" **F** square and place right sides together. Draw diagonal line on wrong side of **F** square, then sew seam  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of drawn line. Cut on drawn line, then press the (2) half square triangles (HST) open with the seam allowance towards **G** fabric. Square to 3-1/2". Repeat to make (40) **GF units**.
2. Repeat Step 1 using (20) **I** 4" squares and (20) **F** 4" squares to create (40) **IF units**.
3. Repeat Step 1 using (20) **J** 4" squares and (20) **F** 4" squares to create (40) **JF units**.
4. Repeat Step 1 using (20) **I** 4" squares and (20) **J** 4" squares to create (40) **IJ units**.

### STRIP UNITS:

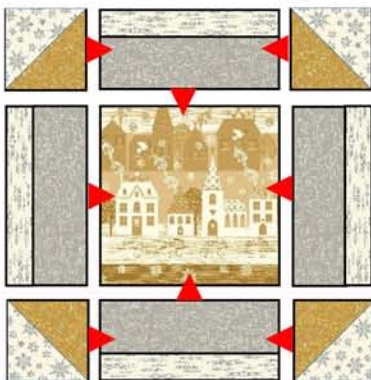
5. Sew (1) **H** 2-1/2" X 6-1/2" strip to (1) **F** 1-1/2" X 6-1/2" strip to create **HF unit**. Repeat to make (40) **HF units**.



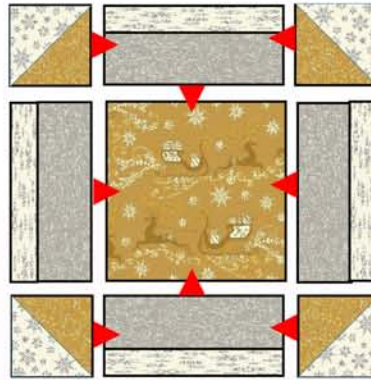
### BLOCKS 1, 2 and 3:

6. Sew (1) **HF unit** to each side of (1) **C** 6-1/2" block. Sew (1) **GF unit** to each side of (1) **HF unit**, make (2) then sew to top and bottom to complete **BLOCK 1**, square to 12-1/2", make (6).
7. Sew (1) **HF unit** to each side of (1) **B** 6-1/2" block. Sew (1) **GF unit** to each side of (1) **HF unit**, make (2) then sew to top and bottom to complete **BLOCK 1**, square to 12-1/2", make (2).
8. Sew (1) **HF unit** to each side of (1) **A** 6-1/2" block. Sew (1) **GF unit** to each side of (1) **HF unit**, make (2) then sew to top and bottom to complete **BLOCK 1**, square to 12-1/2", make (2).

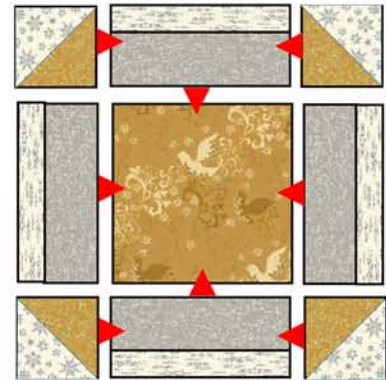

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## BLOCK 4:

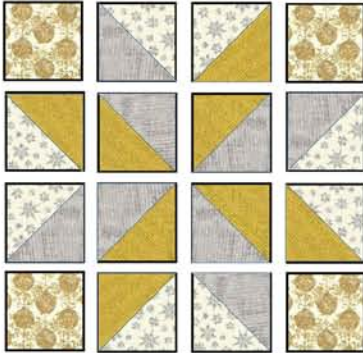
9. Sew the following together in rows, then sew rows together to create BLOCK 4. Square to 12-1/2", make (10).

Row 1: **D** 3-1/2" square – **IF** Unit – **JF** Unit – **D** 3-1/2" square

Row 2: **JF** unit – **IJ** unit – **IJ** unit – **IF** unit

Row 3: **IF** unit – **IJ** unit – **IJ** unit – **JF** unit

Row 4: **D** 3-1/2" square – **JF** Unit – **IF** Unit – **D** 3-1/2" square



## Assembly Instructions: (Refer to cover image for proper placement and rotation of blocks)

### Quilt Assembly:

10. Sew blocks and sashing strips together into horizontal rows.  
ROWS 1, 3 & 5: Block 1 – **F** 1-1/2" X 12-1/2" strip - Block 4 - **F** 1-1/2" X 12-1/2" strip - Block 4 – **F** 1-1/2" X 12-1/2" strip - Block 1  
ROW 2: Block 4 – **F** 1-1/2" X 12-1/2" strip - Block 2 – **F** 1-1/2" X 12-1/2" strip - Block 3 – **F** 1-1/2" X 12-1/2" strip - Block 4  
ROW 4: Block 4 – **F** 1-1/2" X 12-1/2" strip - Block 3 – **F** 1-1/2" X 12-1/2" strip - Block 2 – **F** 1-1/2" X 12-1/2" strip - Block 4
11. Sew rows together with (1) **F** 1-1/2" X 51-1/2" sashing strips between each row.

### Border Assembly:

#### BORDER #1:

12. Sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" X 64-1/2" strip to each side of quilt, then sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" X 53-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of quilt.

#### BORDER #2:

13. Sew (1) **G** 6-1/2" X 66-1/2" strip to each side of quilt. Sew (1) **E** 6-1/2" square to each end of (1) **G** 6-1/2" X 53-1/2" strip, make (2), then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

### Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
