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


A		54075P-1 Multi	1-1/3	<b>Runner:</b> Fussy cut (4) 15-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles <b>Placemats:</b> Fussy cut (4) 15-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.
B		54078-2 Pumpkin Spice	1/2	<b>Runner:</b> (1) 3-1/2" x WOF strip, subcut (8) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles. <b>Placemats:</b> (4) 2" x WOF strips, subcut (8) 2" x 9-1/2" and (8) 2" x 5-1/2" rectangles.
C		54078-5 Sage Mist	FE	<b>Runner:</b> (1) 3-1/2" x WOF strip, subcut (8) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.
D		54078-6 Cloud White	FE	<b>Runner:</b> (1) 3-1/2" x WOF strip, subcut (8) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.

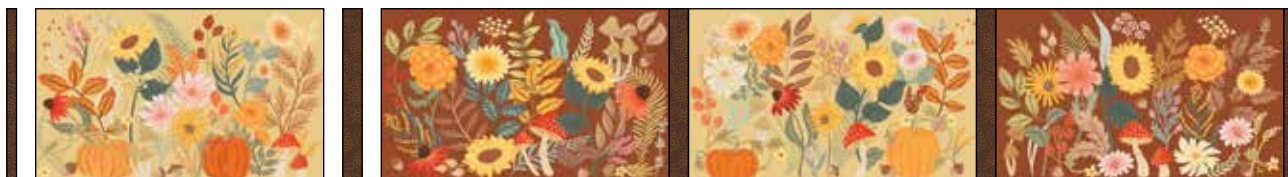

H		54081-8 Bark	7/8	<b>FOR RUNNER BINDING:</b> (5) 2-1/4" x 42" strips, sew short ends together.  (4) 2" x WOF strips, sew short ends together and subcut (2) 2" x 64-1/2" strips. (1) 1-1/2" x WOF strip, subcut (3) 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips. (1) 1" x WOF strip, subcut (2) 1" x 9-1/2" strips.
I		54082-3 Spruce	1/2	<b>Runner:</b> (1) 3-1/2" x WOF strip, subcut (8) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles. <b>Placemats:</b> (4) 2" x WOF strips, subcut (8) 2" x 9-1/2" and (8) 2" x 5-1/2" rectangles.
J		54082-9 Amber	FE	(1) 3-1/2" x WOF strip, subcut (8) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles
K		54083-1 Multi	1	<b>FOR PLACEMAT BINDING:</b> (8) 2-1/4" x 42" strips, sew short ends together.  (4) 1" x WOF strips, sew short ends together and subcut (2) 1" x 64-1/2" strips.
		Backing	3	Batting: 72" x 27" for runner; (4) 21" x 16" for placemats

## MAKE THE TABLE RUNNER

1. Sew together the (4) **A** 15-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles together alternating with (3) **H** 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips. Sew **H** 1" x 9-1/2" strips to each end.

2. Sew together (32) assorted 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles along long edges as shown to make a top pieced row. In the same way, make a bottom pieced row.

3. Sew **H** 2" x 64-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of the **Runner Center** from step 1. Add **K** 1" x 64-1/2" strips to the top and bottom.

4. Sew the **Top** and **Bottom Pieced Rows** to the top and bottom to complete the runner top, measuring 64-1/2" x 19-1/2".



## FINISHING

Layer runner top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **H** 2-1/4" strips.

## MAKING THE PLACEMATS

1. Sew (1) **B** 2" x 5-1/2" rectangle short ends together to (1) **I** 2" x 5-1/2" rectangle to make (1) short B-I unit. Make (4) and (4) in reverse.

2. In the same way, sew (1) **B** 2" x 9-1/2" rectangle short ends together to (1) **I** 2" x 9-1/2" rectangle to make (1) long B-I unit. Make (4) and (4) in reverse.

3. Sew (1) short **B-I** unit and (1) short **B-I** unit reversed to opposite sides of (1) **A** 15-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangle, noting orientation. Sew (1) long **B-I** unit and (1) long **B-I** unit reversed to the top and bottom, noting orientation. Unfinished placemat top measures 18-1/2" x 13-1/2".



4. Repeat step 3 to make a total of (4) placemat tops.

## FINISHING

Layer each placemat top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **K** 2-1/4" strips.
