

Applique blocks: (6) 16 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (12) 16 1/2" x 16 1/2" squares. Inner border #1: (8) 2 1/2" x WOF. Piece strips and subcut (2) 2 1/2" x 75 1/2" and (2) 2 1/2" x 79 1/2" strips.

Constructing pieced blocks

1. Star units. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" print square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 1 3/4" x 3" **A** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal print corner triangle. Repeat with another 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" print square at the opposite comer of the same (1) 1 3/4" x 3" **A** rectangle to complete (1) flying geese unit measuring 1 3/4" x 3" raw edge to raw edge.



Make a total of (4) flying geese units.

2. Sew (2) flying geese units to the opposite sides of (1) 3" x 3" print square to make a row unit.




Sew (2) 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" A squares to the opposite short sides of (1) flying geese unit to make a row unit. Make a total of (2) row units.






3. Sew row units together to make (1) star unit, measuring 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" raw edge to raw edge



- 4. Make (13) star units each for the following prints: B,D,E,F,G
- 5. Arrange and sew (5) star units and (4) 5 $1/2" \times 5 1/2" \land$ squares in 9-patch fashion to complete (1) pieced block.



Make a total of (13) blocks.



Constructing applique blocks

- 1. Prepare applique pieces using method of choice. Finger fold (1) 16 $1/2" \times 16 1/2" \times 16$ square in half. Use the folds as guides to center applique block, arrange applique pieces on **A** square. Once happy with placement, sew pieces in place using method of choice. Trim blocks 15 $1/2" \times 15 1/2"$ raw edge to raw edge.
- 2. Make a total of (3) blocks for each B, K, L, N flowers.



Quilt Center Assembly

1. Pieced rows. Arrange and sew (5) blocks to make a pieced row.

Pieced rows 1, 3, 5: (3) pieced blocks, and (2) applique blocks

Pieced rows 2, 4: (3) applique blocks, and (2) pieced blocks


2. Sew pieced rows together to complete quilt center.

Quilt Top Assembly

- 1. Inner border #1. Sew (2) 2 $1/2" \times 75 1/2"$ **A** strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 2 $1/2" \times 79 1/2"$ **A** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
- 2. Inner border #2. Sew (2) 1 $1/2" \times 79 1/2"$ **H** strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 1 $1/2" \times 81 1/2"$ **H** strips to top and bottom of quilt center.
- 3. Outer border. Sew (2) 7" \times 81 1/2" **C** strips to the opposite sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 7" 94 1/2" **C** strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.






Quilting Instructions

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.
