	1 1/3 yards pieced Or 2 yards cut lengthwise	40056-3 Cream	Outside Border	For pieced border cut six 6 ½" strips and make into two: 6 ½" x 64 ½" and two: 6 ½" x 56 ½". For seamless border cut lengthwise two: 6 ½" x 64 ½" and two: 6 ½" x 56 ½".
	½ yard	40059-2 Aqua	Inner Border	Cut six 2 ½" strips. Join into two: 2 ½" x 60 ½" and two: 2 ½" x 44 ½".
	2 yards	40060-3 Cream	Block Background	First cut six 2 ½" strips WOF, Recut into twelve 2 ½" x 20 ½". Cut three 16 ½" strips. From each strip cut two 14 ½" squares and four 2 ½" x 16 ½" LOF for a total of six squares and twelve rectangles.
	1 yard	40060-4 Celery	Applique Circle Parts	For Hand Applique Method Cut two 10 ½" strips WOF. Recut using Template G/E into 24 quarter circle pieces. Cut one 2 ½" WOF. Using Template E cut 10 end pieces.
	1 ¼ yards	40060-5 Blue	Applique Motifs	For Hand Applique Method Cut six 10" squares - Ibiza Motifs. Cut two 12" squares - Cross Motifs. Cut six 12" x 6" - Half Cross Motifs. Cut four 6" squares - Quarter Cross Motifs.
	1 ¼ yards Includes binding	40058-1 Cocoa	Inner Block Border Binding	Cut twelve 1 ½" strips. Recut into twelve: 1 ½" x 14 ½" and twelve: 1 ½" x 16 ½". Cut six: 2 ½" WOF for binding.
	3 ½ yards	40057-2 Aqua	Backing	Cut in half and sew sides together. Seam will be horizontal.

Twin Size Quilt Batting





- Success with this pattern starts with reading the directions through to the end.
- Note that the circles and the blue motifs are appliqued.
- If you choose to hand applique decide whether you want to pre-prepare the
 edges or do the needle turn method, both are portable. Inserting the ends of the
 circles will require snipping a few threads of the sewn seams of the foundation
 block Cocoa Inner Border.
- If you want faster results follow the directions on your purchased lightweight
 paper backed fusible webbing. You will not need to pre-cut the applique circles or
 motifs as described in the Cutting Directions since you will trace them on to the
 paper backed fusible web.
- If you have any questions about the processes suggested here, check first with your local quilt shop. Look on line for helpful videos.
- Now is the time to accurately cut, sew with a ¼" seam allowance, press diligently
 and be patient and enjoy each step in the creation of this design.
- This pattern may have some fabric leftover. (Not always a bad thing!) We have allowed for shrinkage and/or fussy cutting. Fabrics are directional.

Directions

1. Decide on your applique method. If you choose to hand applique make templates by tracing the motifs on to paper or template plastic.



- 2. Repeat for the applique circles.
- 3. To create background blocks sew 14 ½" Cocoa strips to opposite sides of the six 14 ½" squares. Press seams toward Cocoa strips. Add the 16 ½" Cocoa strips to top and bottom of squares. Press seams toward strips.
- 4. Sew 16 ½" Cream border strips to sides. Sew the 20 ½" Cream border strips to top and bottom. Note the direction of the fabric design as you are piecing. Press seams toward the Cocoa Inner Border.

 Applique (or fuse) the Ibiza Motif to the center of each block.
 You can find the center alignment by folding the block in half both ways and finger pressing a crease. Save the application of all the Cross Motifs until after the blocks are joined.




- 2. Join the six blocks together in two rows of three, press seams open. Then join the two rows together, press seams open.
- 3. Apply the two Cross Motifs using the seams of the blocks as a guide.
- 4. Referring as needed to the quilt picture, apply the Circle Parts using your favorite applique method up to ½" from the edges of the Cocoa Inner Border. Stop.
- 5. Using a sharp seam ripper carefully remove a few stitches and slip the ends of the circles through. Finish the applique, and re-stitch the Cocoa Inner Border.
- Sew the Inner Border strips to the top and bottom, press seams toward the border. Now add the side Inner Border strips and press seam toward the Inner Border.
- 7. Now is the time to applique the Half Cross and Quarter Cross Motifs as pictured.
- 8. Attach the Outside Borders to the sides.
- 9. Sandwich the quilt top and backing with batting. We suggest quilting with a small stipple in all the background spaces. Quilt as desired in the borders, bind and enjoy!

Connect pieces E and G to make Quarter Circle Template. Add 1/2 inch to each end for seam allowance.

Use template E to make the ten End Pieces. Add 1/2 inch to each end for seam allowance.
