

Α		42942M-1 Blue	1 3/4	Cut (10) 6" strips x WOF. Using your favorite template cutting method such as freezer paper or template plastic, cut 64 rounded Template A pieces. Be sure to use the outermost solid line when cutting out your templates for your seam allowance.
В		37098-02 Ash *Palette	1 3/4	Cut (10) 6" strips x WOF. Using your favorite template cutting method, cut 64 rounded Template B pieces. Be sure to use the outermost solid line when cutting out your template for your seam allowance.
С		42946-3 Teal	1/4	Cut (2) 2 ¼" strips. Cut (32) 2 ¼" squares.
D		42946-6 Magenta	1/2	Cut (2) 2" strips x WOF. Subcut to (32) 2 inch squares. Cut (2) 2 1/4" strips x WOF. Subcut to (32) 2 1/4" squares.
Е		42946-2 Grey	3/4	Cut (16) 1 ½" strips x WOF. Subcut (64) 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
F		42946-1 Blue	1	Cut (3) 2" strips x WOF. Subcut to (32) 2 inch squares. Cut (6) 1 ½" strips for border 1. Cut (2) of the strips in half to create 8 strips total. (4) short and (4) WOF. Cut (6) 2 ½" strips x WOF for binding.
G		42945M-3 Blue	3/4	Cut (6) 3 ½" strips for border 2. Cut (2) of the strips in half to create 8 strips total, (4) short and (4) total WOF.




Piecing Instructions

Curved Blocks

Use your favorite curved piecing tools or methods for piecing the curved templates. You may use pins, wonder tape or any other preferred method.

Sew Template A (Fabric A) and Template B (Fabric B) together using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam to create a curved edge. The two templates will create a 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " block. This is $\frac{1}{4}$ of the interior of your block. Repeat to sew a total of 64 curved 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks.





After sewing your curved blocks, you are ready to attach the diamond centers. Draw a straight line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the 2 ¼ inch squares cut from Fabrics C and D. Place the square right sides together, edges aligned, on the Fabric B portion of the curved block. Sew a straight line on the drawn line from corner to corner. Trim the edge to a ¼" beyond your stitched seam (see dotted line below). Press out with your iron to flip the fabric to the right side.







Alternate Fabrics C and D as seen in the diagram below. Sew together 4 curved blocks with your diamonds attached in a four patch formation as seen below.



Sashing Instructions

Use your 2 inch squares cut from Fabrics D and F to create HST for the corners of your sashing. Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of Fabric D and place right sides together with Fabric F. Sew a ¼" away from the drawn line on both sides. Use your rotary cuter to divide the HST by cutting on the drawn line. Trim your HST to 1 ½ inches and press towards Fabric D. You will create a total of 64 HST.

Use 32 of your Fabric E rectangles to attach your HST. Sew one HST to each side of 32 Fabric E rectangles. Be sure that the Fabric D side of the HST is sewn to your sashing to create consistency. Press towards the rectangle.



Sew your remaining 32 Fabric E rectangles to the sides of your curved blocks. Press towards the sashing.





Sew the HST sashing to the tops and bottoms of your blocks as shown below.



Border Assembly

Use your border strips from Fabrics F and G to sew one short border strip to 1 long border strip to create 4 equal border strips in each fabric.

Trim two strips from Fabric F to 4". Trim the remaining two strips from Fabric F to 50 1/2".

Trim two strips from Fabric G to 50 ½". Trim the remaining two strips from Fabric G to 56".

Quilt Assembly

Sew the blocks together row by row as shown below.

Attach borders 1 and 2 as shown in the diagram below. Attach Fabric F borders first, sewing on the side borders followed by the top and bottom borders. Repeat with Fabric G borders.

Create your binding using the Fabric F 2 ½" strips.

Quilt and bind.
