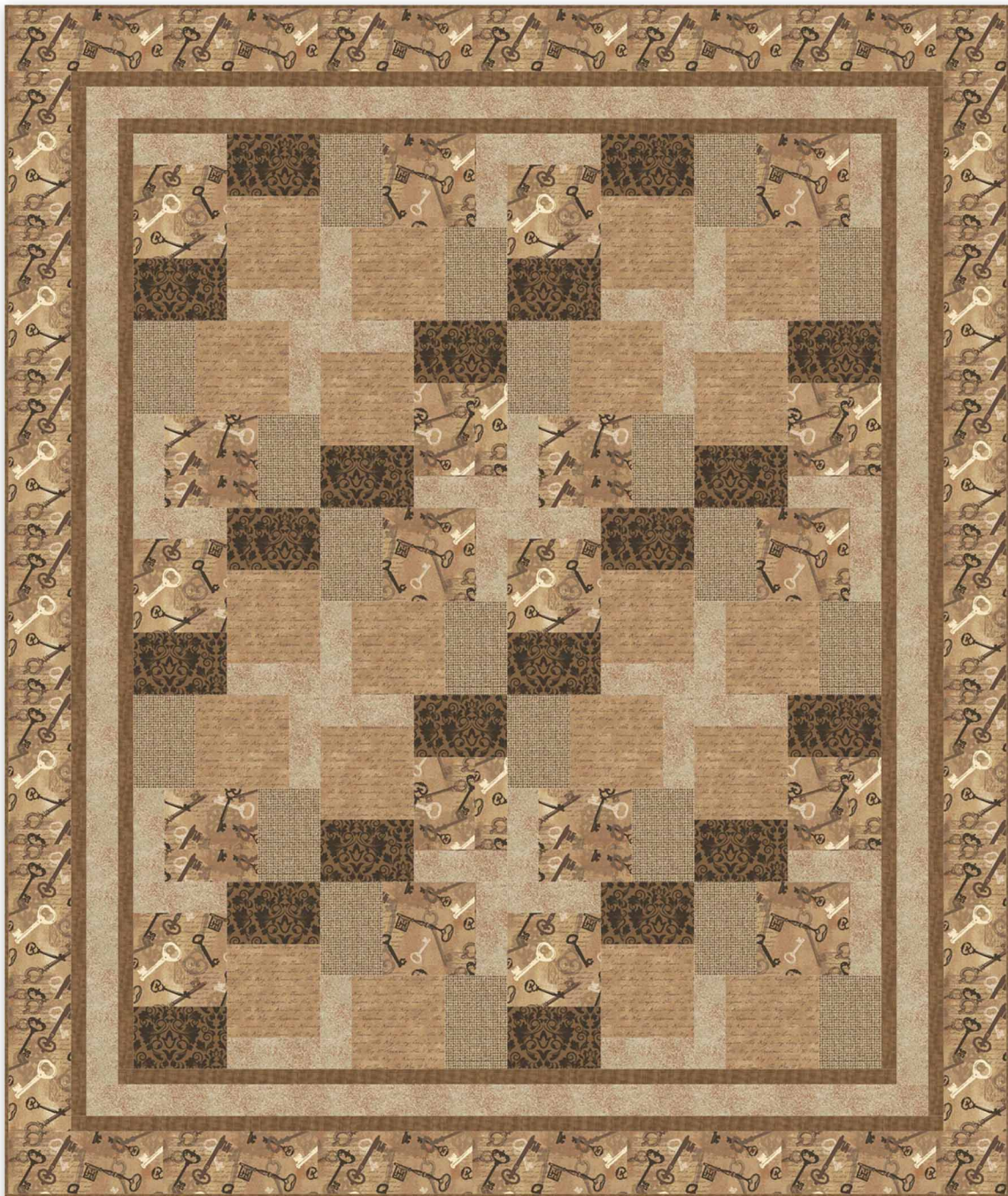

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




Turn the Key

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WOF = Width of Fabric

@ = Directional Fabric

NOTE: All seams are 1/4 inch.

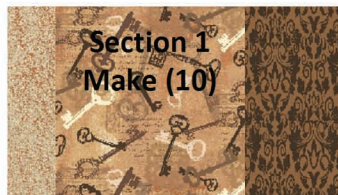

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Piecing Instructions

Sections 1 and 2:

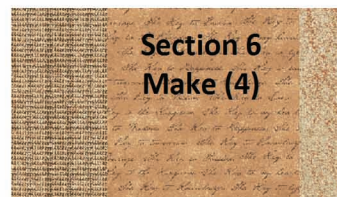
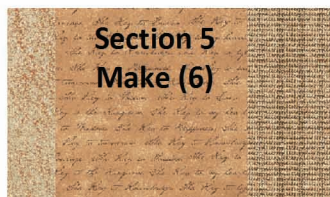
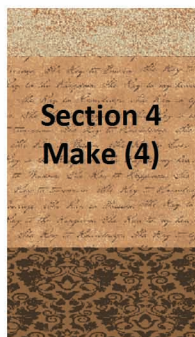
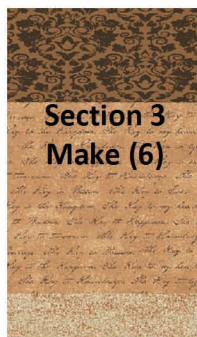
1. Sew (1) E 2-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle to one side of (1) A 6-1/2" square, then sew (1) C 4-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle to the other side to create Section 1. Repeat to make (10).
2. Repeat Step 1 using E 2-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle, A 6-1/2" square and D 4-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle to create Section 2. Repeat to make (10).



Sections 3, 4, 5 and 6:

(NOTE: Fabric B is directional, refer to diagrams for proper orientation of text)

3. Sew (1) E 2-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle to bottom of (1) B 6-1/2" square, then sew (1) C 4-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle to top to create Section 3. Repeat to make (6).
4. Sew (1) E 2-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle to top of (1) B 6-1/2" square, then sew (1) C 4-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle to bottom to create Section 4. Repeat to make (4).
5. Sew (1) E 2-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle to left of (1) B 6-1/2" square, then sew (1) D 4-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle to right to create Section 5. Repeat to make (6).
6. Sew (1) E 2-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle to right of (1) B 6-1/2" square, then sew (1) D 4-1/2" X 6-1/2" rectangle to left to create Section 6. Repeat to make (4).



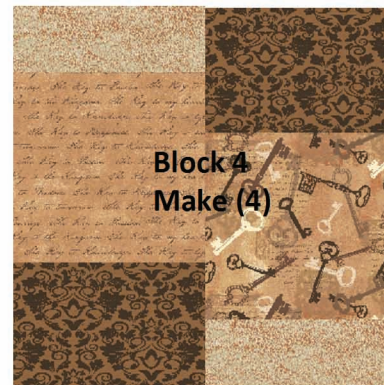
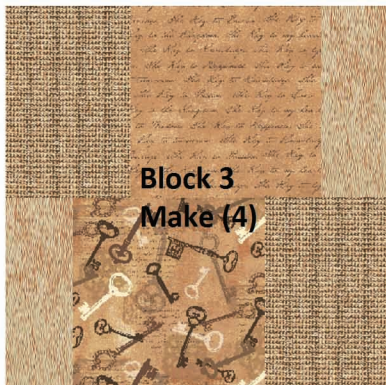
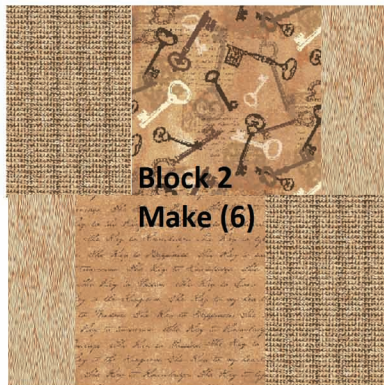
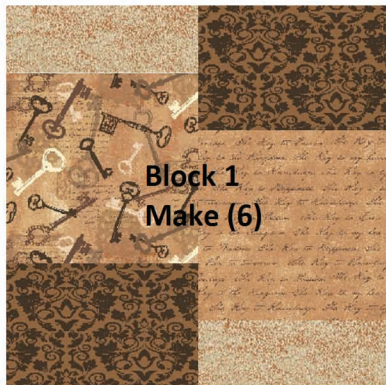
Blocks 1, 2, 3 and 4:

(NOTE: Follow Diagrams for proper rotation of Sections)

7. Sew (1) Section 1 to the left of (1) Section 3 to make Block 1. Repeat to make (6).
8. Sew (1) Section 2 to the top of (1) Section 5 to make Block 2. Repeat to make (6).
9. Sew (1) Section 6 to the top of (1) Section 2 to make Block 3. Repeat to make (4).
10. Sew (1) Section 4 to the left of (1) Section 1 to make Block 4. Repeat to make (4).

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Assembly Instructions

Quilt Assembly:

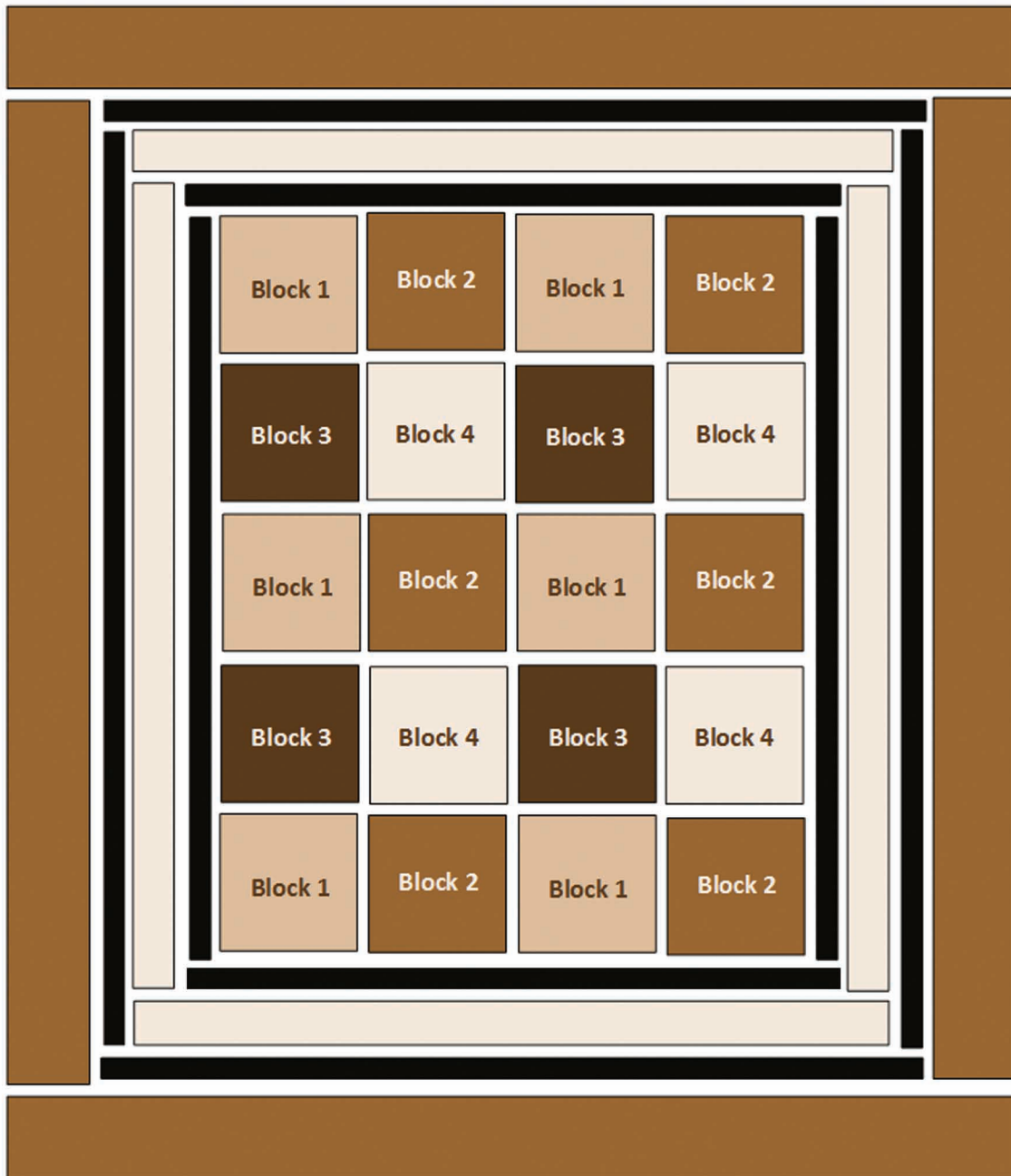
1. Sew the following blocks together into rows, then sew rows together.
ROWS 1, 3, 5: Block 1 – Block 2 – Block 1 – Block 2
ROWS 2, 4: Block 3 – Block 4 – Block 3 – Block 4

Border Assembly:

2. **Border #1:** Sew (12) 1-1/2" F strips together via the short ends using a straight seam. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 60-1/2"), cut (2) strips and sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom (ours is 50-1/2), cut (2) strips and sew to top and bottom of quilt. Set remainder aside for Border #3.
3. **Border #2:** Sew (6) 2-1/2" E strips together via the short ends using a straight seam. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 62-1/2"), cut (2) strips and sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom (ours is 54-1/2), cut (2) strips and sew to top and bottom of quilt.
4. **Border #3:** Measure sides of quilt (ours is 66-1/2"). Using remainder of 1-1/2" F strip, cut (2) strips and sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom (ours is 56-1/2), cut (2) strips and sew to top and bottom of quilt.
5. **Border #4:** Sew (7) 4-1/2" A strips together via the short ends using a straight seam. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 68-1/2"), cut (2) strips and sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom (ours is 64-1/2), cut (2) strips and sew to top and bottom of quilt.

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Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!

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
