

41334-2 Stone	3/4 yard
41336-3 Carrot	1/2 yard
41335-1 Green	1/2 yard
41339-5 Sky Blue	3/4 yard
41339-6 Sunshine	3/4 yard
41338-4 Navy	1 1/4 yards
31836 Navy OR 40171-30 Green	3 1/8 yards

Fabric	Quantity Needed
Backing	4 1/2 yards
Binding ::: 31836 OR 40171-30	5/8 yard















Before You Begin:

- Read through all directions first
- All seam allowances are a scant 1/4"
- RST stands for "Right Sides Together"
- WOF stands for "Width of Fabric"
- Fabric requirement assumes 40" between selvages
- Extra fabric will be required if using directional prints

NAVY COLORWAY

Cutting Instructions

Stone 41334-2

• Cut (3) 6 1/2" x WOF strips, from (2) of the WOF strips sub-cut each into (6) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares. From remaining 6 1/2" x WOF strip, cut (1) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" square.

Carrot 41336-3

Cut (2) 6 1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut each into (6) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.

Green 41335-1

• Cut (2) 6 1/2" x WOF strips, from (1) of the WOF strips sub-cut into (6) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares. From remaining 6 1/2" x WOF strip, cut (2) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.

Sky Blue 41339-5

• Cut (5) 4 1/2" x WOF strips, from (4) of the WOF strips sub-cut into (15) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. From remaining 4 1/2" x WOF strip, cut (6) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.

Sunshine 41339-6

• Cut (5) 4 1/2" x WOF strips, from (4) of the WOF strips sub-cut into (15) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. From remaining 4 1/2" x WOF strip, cut (6) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.

Navy 41338-4

• Cut (11) 3" x WOF strips, sub-cut each into (12) 3" x 3" squares.

Navy 31836

- Cut (11) 3" x WOF strips, sub-cut each into (12) 3" x 3" squares.
- Cut (6) 10 1/2" x WOF strips, from (5) of those WOF strips sub-cut each into (3) 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" squares. From remaining 10 1/2" x WOF strip, cut (1) 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" square.

GREEN COLORWAY

Cutting Instructions

Stone 41334-2

• Cut (3) 6 1/2" x WOF strips, from (2) of the WOF strips sub-cut each into (6) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares. From remaining 6 1/2" x WOF strip, cut (1) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" square.

Carrot 41336-3

Cut (2) 6 1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut each into (6) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.

Green 41335-1

• Cut (2) 6 1/2" x WOF strips, from (1) of the WOF strips sub-cut into (6) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares. From remaining 6 1/2" x WOF strip, cut (2) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares.

Sky Blue 41339-5

• Cut (5) 4 1/2" x WOF strips, from (4) of the WOF strips sub-cut into (15) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. From remaining 4 1/2" x WOF strip, cut (6) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.

Sunshine 41339-6

• Cut (5) 4 1/2" x WOF strips, from (4) of the WOF strips sub-cut into (15) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. From remaining 4 1/2" x WOF strip, cut (6) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.

Navy 41338-4

• Cut (11) 3" x WOF strips, sub-cut each into (12) 3" x 3" squares.

Green/Copper 40171-30

- Cut (11) 3" x WOF strips, sub-cut each into (12) 3" x 3" squares.
- Cut (6) 10 1/2" x WOF strips, from (5) of those WOF strips sub-cut each into (3) 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" squares. From remaining 10 1/2" x WOF strip, cut (1) 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" square.





(The following piecing instructions reflect the NAVY color way. For the GREEN colorway, replace any 31836 fabric with 40171-30 fabric)

Piecing The HST (Half Square Triangles):

- 1. Take (1) 3" x 3" Navy 41338-4 square and (1) 3" x 3" Navy 31836 square and place them RST.
- 2. With a pencil, mark a diagonal line from one corner to the next.
- 3. Sew a scant 1/4" away from the pencil line on both sides as shown in the diagram.
- 4. Cut on the line, separating the two halves; which now creates 2 HST (Half Square Triangles).
- 5. Trim blocks if needed to a finished size of 2 1/2" x 2 1/2".
- 6. Repeat the steps above for all of the Navy 41338-4 and Navy 31836 squares for a total of 264 HST; when using a directional print, the diagonal line in Step 2 may need to rotate.









Piecing Block A:

- 1. Following the Block A diagram, sew the rows together being sure to pay attention to the direction of the HST.
- 2. Start by sewing (3) HST to (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Sky Blue 41339-5 rectangle RST as shown. Press. This creates the top row of the block.
- 3. Repeat Step 2 to create the bottom row of the block.
- 4. Sew (1) HST to (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Sunshine 41339-6 rectangle RST as shown. Press. This creates the left side of the block.
- 5. Repeat Step 3 to create the right side of the block.
- 6. Taking the units created in Step 4 and 5, sew them RST to (1) 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" Stone 41334-2 square. Press.
- 7. Now sew the rows created in Step 2 and 3 RST to the center unit. Press.
- 8. Repeat the above steps until you have created (13) of Block A.

(The following piecing instructions reflect the NAVY color way. For the GREEN colorway, replace any 31836 fabric with 40171-30 fabric)

Piecing Block B:

- 1. Following the Block B diagram, sew the rows together one at a time being sure to pay attention to the direction of the HST. The process is very similar to Block A; but the layout is slightly different.
- 2. Start by sewing (3) HST to (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Sky Blue 41339-5 rectangle RST as shown. Press. This creates the top row of the block.
- 3. Repeat Step 2 to create the bottom row of the block.
- 4. Sew (1) HST to (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Sunshine 41339-6 rectangle RST as shown. Press. This creates the left side of the block.
- 5. Repeat Step 3 to create the right side of the block.
- 6. Taking the units created in Step 4 and 5, sew them RST to (1) 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" Carrot 41336-3 square.

 Press.
- 7. Now sew the rows created in Step 2 and 3 RST to the center unit. Press.

8. Repeat the above steps until you have created (12) of Block B using Carrot 41336-3 as the center square. Then Repeat the above steps until you have created (8) of Block B using Green 41335-1 as the

center square.





Laying Out The Blocks & Sewing Rows:

- Following the quilt diagram, lay out Blocks A and B as shown, adding in the 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" Navy 31836 squares.
- Sew the blocks RST one row at a time. Press.
- Repeat the steps above until all rows are finished.
- Sew the rows RST. Press.

Finishing The Quilt:

- Due to the size of the quilt, you will need to piece the back. Please be sure to leave a minimum of 4" excess on all sides for ease of quilting.
- Press your quilt top and backing, so they are wrinkle-free and flat.
- · Layer your quilt top, batting and backing.
- Baste.
- Quilt as desired.
- · Bind the quilt using your favorite method.
