A		50000-1	1 3/8	(2) 20 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (1) 8 1/2" x 20 1/2", (1) 19 1/2" x 20 1/2" and (1) 20 1/2" x 35 1/2" rectangles.
B		50001-4	1/8	Heart blocks: (1) 2 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (2) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.
C		50002-8	1/8	Heart blocks: (1) 2 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (2) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.
D		50003-2	1/8	(1) 1 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (2) 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" rectangles
E		50004-6	1/8	Heart blocks: (1) 2 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (2) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.
F		50006-5	1/8	Heart blocks: (1) 2 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (2) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.
G		50007-2	1/8	Heart blocks: (1) 2 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (2) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles.
H		50009-10	1/4	Sashing: (1) 1 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (2) 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" rectangles. Heart blocks: (1) 1 1/4" x WOF. Subcut (20) 1 1/4" x 1 1/4" squares. (1) 2 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (10) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.



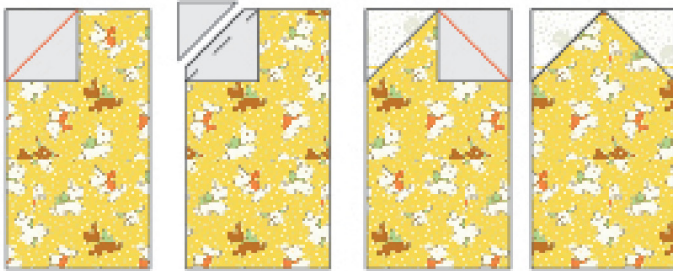
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Pillowcase Assembly

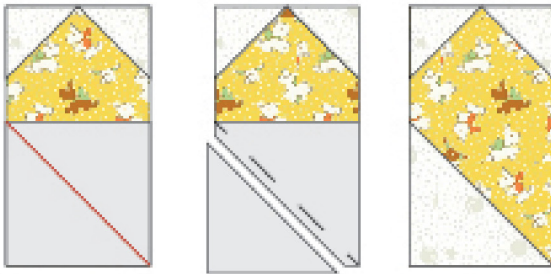
Pillowcase Front

Construct heart block using the following method:

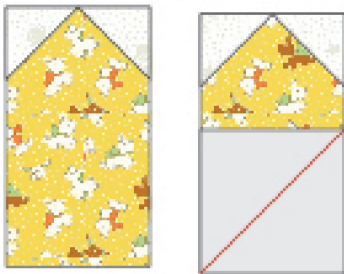
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $1\frac{1}{4}'' \times 1\frac{1}{4}''$ **H** square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ **E** rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}''$ away from the sewn line. Open and press to reveal **H** corner triangle. Repeat with another $1\frac{1}{4}'' \times 1\frac{1}{4}''$ **H** square at the adjacent corner on the short side of the same **E** rectangle.



1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{2}''$ **H** square. Place square, right sides together, at the bottom corner at the other end of the same (1) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ print rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}''$ away from the sewn line. Open and press to reveal **H** corner triangle to complete left half of a heart block.



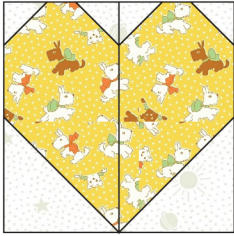
Repeat to make a mirror-image for the right half of heart block.



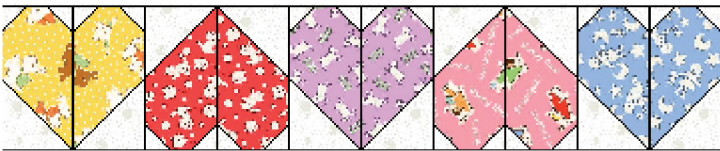


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Sew both halves to complete (1) heart block.



2. Construct 1 heart block each using fabrics B, C, E, F, and G. Arrange the sew heart blocks into a pieced column as shown.



3. Sew (2) 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" **H** rectangles to the opposite long sides of heart column, followed by (2) 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" **D** rectangles. Then add (1) 19 1/2" x 20 1/2" **A** rectangle to the left.





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4. Sew (1) 8 1/2" x 20 1/2" **A** rectangle to the right. Measure at raw edge 1/4", turn under and press along the raw edge. Turn under another 5", and matching seam between the inner **H** strip on the right and the heart column, edge stitch flap in place.

Pillowcase Back

Measure 1/4", turn under and press along one short side of the 20 1/2" x 35 1/2" **H** rectangle. Turn under another 5", and press. Edgestitch the flap in place using an edgestitch foot.

Sewing Pillowcase Front and Back together

1. Place the pillowcase front and back, right sides together and with the flaps matching. Sew along the two long sides, and one short side (NOT the flap side) to assemble the pillowcase.
2. Finish the seam with a zig-zag stitch, or serging.
3. Turn the pillowcase right side out. Press to complete the pillowcase.
