

Estimated Fabric Requirements:

1 yard 40085-X Multi 1/4 yard 40086-X Multi 1/4 yard 40087-1 Fuschia 1/4 yard 40087-2 Turquoise



Fat Quarter each of the coordinating solids from Palette: 37098-14 Duckling, 37098-16 Cherry, 37098-17 Papaya 37098-24 Pink, 37098-31 Caribbean, 37098-35 Mint 2 1/2 yards of 31835 30s White Solid 1/2 yard 37098-24 Pink for Binding 3 1/2 yards Backing

Cutting instructions:

Print fabrics

A1: Cut print fabrics into 5.5" x 6.5" pieces until you have 20 sets of 4 rectangles.

Cut (5) strips 5" x WOF from the butterfly print. Join the pieces until you have (2) strips 5" x 53" and (2) strips 5" x 52.5".

White solid

A2 and A5: Cut into (160) pieces 6.5" x 1.5".


A4 and A7: Cut into (160) pieces 4.5" x 2.5".

A8: Cut into (80) pieces 5" x 3".

Colored solids

A3 and A6: Cut into 5.5" x 1.5" pieces until you have 20 sets of 8 rectangles.

Borders

From the pink solid, cut (5) strips 2" x WOF. Cut two of the strips down to 2" x 40.5". Cut 2 pieces from one of the remaining strips and attach them to the other two remaining strips so that they are $2" \times 53.5"$.

Piecing instructions:

- 1. Cut out 80 copies of the paper pieced Mariposa block making sure not to cut off the seam allowance.
- 2. Dab a glue stick onto the back of the paper block in the middle of the "A1" area and stick a 5.5" x 6.5" rectangle onto the back of the paper block with the wrong side of the fabric touching the paper. Make sure that the entire area is covered and that there is a 1/4" overlap on each side.
- 3. Place a 1.5" x 6.5" onto A1, right sides together, so that the white fabric overlaps 1/4" into the A2 section. Turn the paper over so that you can see the printed line and stitch along the line between A1 and A2 with a short stitch length.
- 4. Trim the seam allowance to 1/4" and press the white fabric into the A2 area.
- 5. Repeat with the remaining A3 A8 pieces.
- 6. Once the block is pressed, turn it over so that you can see the printed lines. Trim along the edge of the paper. Your block should be 5.5" x 5.5".
- 7. Carefully pull away the paper from the back of the block.
- 8. Join together 4 identical blocks as shown in Figure 1.
- 9. Piece the blocks into a quilt that is 4 blocks x 5 blocks.
- 10. Add the 2" x 40.5" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt and press. Add the 2" x 53.5" strips to the remaining sides and press.
- 11. Add the 5" x 53" butterfly border to each of the longer sides of the quilt and press. Add the 5" x 52.5" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt and press.
- 12. Baste, quilt, and bind as desired.



