



Making the Blocks

1. HST units. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 4" A square. Place square, right sides together, on (1) 4" L square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the drawn line. Cut along drawn line. Open and press to yield (2) HST units. Trim HST units to measure 3 1/2" square. Make a total of (4) A/L HST units.









2. Middle Units. Sew 1 1/2" x 2" **L** pieces to opposite sides of (1) 1 1/2" x 2" **A** piece. Add (1) 2" x 3 1/2" **L** piece to the top to make a middle unit. Make a total of (4) middle units.





3. Lay out (4) HST units, (4) middle units, and (1) 3 1/2" **A** square into (3) rows of (3) units each as shown. Sew the units into rows and join the rows to complete a block. Block should measure 9-1/2" square.














4. In the same way, make a total of (2) blocks each using the following fabrics:

A/L, C/L, D/L, E/L, F/L, G/L, H/L, I/L, J/L, K/L



Assembly

- 5. Lay out (4) blocks and (3) $2'' \times 9-1/2'' \mathbf{L}$ strips to make a piece rows. Join the pieces together. Repeat to make a total of (5) pieced rows.
- 6. Sew the rows together alternating with (4) 2" x 41" L strips to complete the quilt center.
- 7. Inner border. Sew 2" x 51-1/2" $\bf L$ strips to opposite long sides of the quilt center. Sew 2" x 44" $\bf L$ strips to the top and bottom.
- 8. Outer border. Sew 4-1/4" \times 54-1/2" **B** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center. Sew 4-1/4" \times 51-1/2" **B** strips to the top and bottom to complete quilt top.

Finishing

- 9. With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich and quilt as desired.
- 10. Bind the quilt using the (6) 2-1/4" x WOF **K** strips.
