

### **General Instructions:**

- A. All seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- B. Read through all instructions before beginning your project.
- C. Press all seams open.


**Piecing Instructions:** (Refer to block diagrams below for proper fabric placement)

### BLOCK 1A, 1B, 1C (Envelope Block):

- 1. Sew (1) E QST to (1) F QST, then add (1) E HST to create BLOCK 1A. Square to 6-1/2", make (4).
- 2. Sew (1) D QST to (1) C QST, then add (1) D HST to create BLOCK 1B. Square to 6-1/2", make (4).
- 3. Sew (1) A QST to (1) B QST, then add (1) A HST to create BLOCK 1C. Square to 6-1/2", make (4).












### BLOCK 2A, 2B, 2C (Half Square Triangle Block):

- 4. Sew (1) E HST to (1) F HST to create BLOCK 2A. Square to 6-1/2", make (24).
- 5. Sew (1) C HST to (1) D HST to create BLOCK 2B. Square to 6-1/2", make (16).
- 6. Sew (1) A HST to (1) B HST to create BLOCK 2C. Square to 6-1/2", make (8).













### BLOCK 3A, 3B (Nine Patch Block):

- 7. Sew together (1) H 2-1/2" square, (3) J 2-1/2" squares and (5) K 2-1/2" squares as shown to create BLOCK 3A. Square to 6-1/2", make (8).
- 8. Sew together (2) H 2-1/2" squares, (2) J 2-1/2" squares and (5) K 2-1/2" squares as shown to create BLOCK 3B. Square to 6-1/2", make (24).

**Assembly Instructions** (Refer to quilt diagram for proper placement of blocks)

### Quilt Assembly:

Sew Blocks, K and G squares, K QSTs and HSTs into diagonal rows, then sew rows together.

Rows 1 and 17: K HST

Rows 2 and 16: K QST – BLOCK 1A – K QST

Rows 3 and 15: K QST – BLOCK 2A – BLOCK 3A – BLOCK 2A – K QST

Rows 4 and 14: K QST – BLOCK 2A – BLOCK 3B – BLOCK 1B – BLOCK 3B - BLOCK 2A – K QST

Rows 5 and 13: K QST – BLOCK 2A – BLOCK 3B – BLOCK 2B – K SQUARE – BLOCK 2B – BLOCK 3B – BLOCK 2A – K QST

Rows 6 and 12: K QST – BLOCK 2A – BLOCK 3B – BLOCK 2B – K SQUARE – BLOCK 1C – K SQUARE - BLOCK 2B – BLOCK 3B – BLOCK 2A – K QST

Rows 7 and 11: K QST – BLOCK 2A – BLOCK 3B – BLOCK 2B – K SQUARE – BLOCK 2C – BLOCK 3A – BLOCK 2C – K SQUARE - BLOCK 2B – BLOCK 3B – BLOCK 2A – K QST

Row 8: K QST – BLOCK 2A – BLOCK 3B – BLOCK 2B – K SQUARE – BLOCK 2C – BLOCK 3B – G SQUARE – BLOCK 3A – BLOCK 1C - K SQUARE - BLOCK 1B – BLOCK 3A – BLOCK 1A – K HST

Row 9: K QST – BLOCK 2A – BLOCK 3B – BLOCK 2B – K SQUARE – BLOCK 2C – BLOCK 3B – G SQUARE – BLOCK 3B – BLOCK 2C – K SQUARE – BLOCK 2B – BLOCK 3B – BLOCK 2A – K OST

Row 10: K HST – BLOCK 1A – BLOCK 3A – BLOCK 1B – K SQUARE – BLOCK 1C – BLOCK 3A – G SQUARE – BLOCK 3B – BLOCK 2C – K SQUARE – BLOCK 2B – BLOCK 3B – BLOCK 2A – K QST

### **Border Assembly:**

#### Border #1

1. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 77"), cut (2) **H** 2-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 64") cut (2) **H** 2-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

### Border #2

2. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 81"), cut (2) **K** 3-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 70") cut (2) **K** 3-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

#### Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
