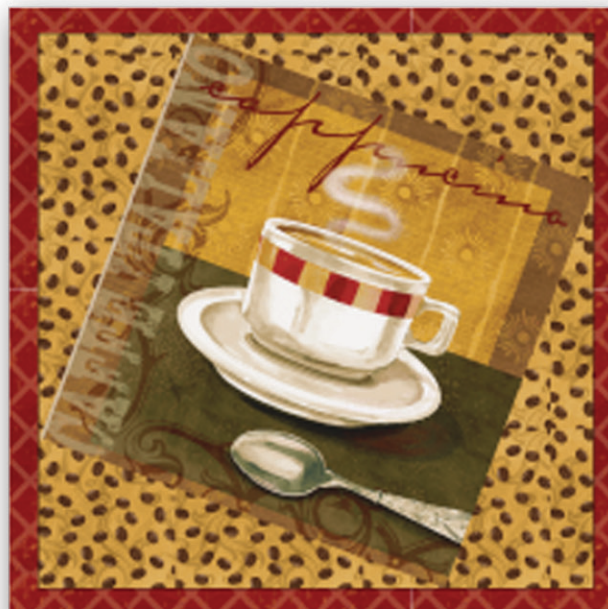

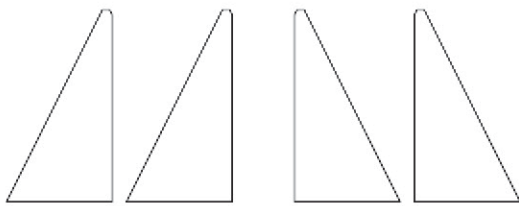


Mug Rugs

Cutting for Four Mug Rugs:

1. From **F**, cut: four cup panels into 5-1/2" x 5-1/2" squares.
2. Transfer template markings from Mug Rug Template A to template material and cut out.
3. Each of the four triangle patches in the mug rugs must be cut from a single layer of fabric. Each set tilts in the same direction.
4. Use the template provided to cut eight triangle patches from the **A** (for two mug rugs). Place template on the RIGHT side of the fabric in order to get the correct "tilt."
5. Use the template provided to cut four triangle patches from **B**. Cut these out from the WRONG side of the fabric in order to get the mirror image tilt. Do this also for the **C** fabric. All cutting is done on a single layer of fabric.

Mug Rugs

Sewing

1. Diagrams 1-3 show the sewing sequence for making the two mug rugs from fabric **A**.
2. Diagrams 4-6 show the sewing sequence for making the two coasters from the **B and C** fabrics
3. Use a 1/4" seam throughout. Press seams toward the triangles. Square to 7 1/2".

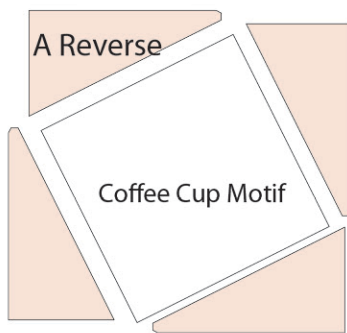

Finishing

1. Layer coasters and quilt as desired. Trim batting and backing even with the mug rug.
2. Cut binding from fabrics **D and E**. You will need approximately 30" length for EACH mug rug. Cut binding at 2-1/4" wide, fold in half and bind each mug rug.
