



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Assembly Instructions

(Refer to quilt diagram for proper placement and rotation of blocks)

Quilt Assembly:

5. Sew blocks together into horizontal rows, then sew rows together.

ROW 1: Block 1 – Block 2 ROW 2: Block 3 – Block 4

Border Assembly:

BORDER #1:

- 6. Sew (1) M2 to each side.
- 7. Sew (1) D 2-1/2" X 33-1/2" strip to (1) C 2-1/2" X 33-1/2" strip to create LEFT BORDER UNIT, then sew to left side.
- 8. Sew (1) A 2-1/2" X 33-1/2" strip to (1) B 2-1/2" X 33-1/2" strip to create RIGHT BORDER UNIT, then sew to left side.
- 9. Sew (1) M6 to top and bottom.
- 10. Sew following together to create TOP BORDER UNIT, then sew to top:

 B 2-1/2" square M7 D 2-1/2" X 24-1/2" strip A 2-1/2" X 24-1/2" strip M7 C 2-1/2" square
- 11. Sew following together to create BOTTOM BORDER UNIT, then sew to bottom:

 A 2-1/2" square M7 C 2-1/2" X 24-1/2" strip B 2-1/2" X 24-1/2" strip M7 D 2-1/2" square

BORDER #2:

12. Sew (1) M1 to each side of quilt, then sew (1) M5 to top and bottom.

Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
