









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WOF=WIDTH OF FABRIC

KEY	FABRIC	SKU	YD	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A		54060D-4 Mist	2-1/8	(6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips together to make a long strip using diagonal seams, subcut: (2) 2-1/2" x 50-1/2" and (2) 2-1/2" x 54-1/2" strips. (24) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut the following: (24) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2", (48) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" and (24) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles. BINDING: (6) 2-1/4" x WOF strips, sew short ends together.
B		54055D-1 Green	3/4	Fussy cut (8) 6-1/2" squares.
C		54054D-1 Green	3/8	Fussy cut (4) 6-1/2" squares.
D		54056D-2 Ivory	1/2	(2) 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (9) 6-1/2" squares.
E		54056D-3 Shale	1/4	(1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 6-1/2" squares.
F		54058D-8 Aqua	5/8	(11) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (26) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" and (26) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles.
G		54058D-6 Pasture	5/8	(11) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (16) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" and (16) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.
H		54058D-7 Tan	1/3	(7) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut (10) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" and (10) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.
		Backing	3-1/2	Batting 62" x 62"



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BLOCK ASSEMBLY

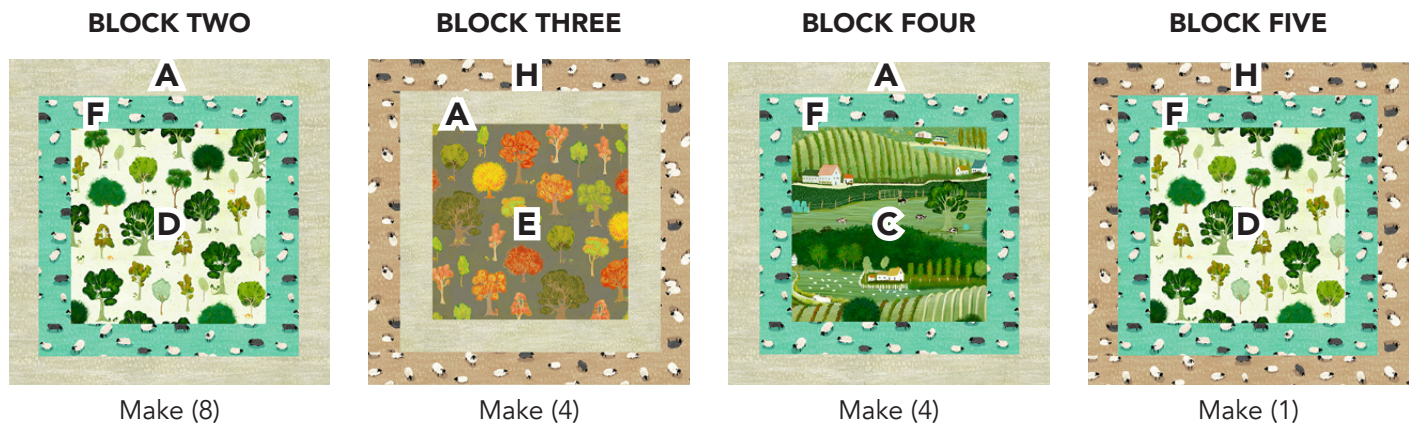
PLEASE NOTE: Blocks are pieced using the courthouse steps method. Sew the rectangles onto the center square in the order written.

1. AB UNIT: Sew (1) **A** 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle to either side of (1) **B** 6-1/2" square. Press outward. Sew (1) **A** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle to the top and bottom of **AB** unit. Press outward. Unit should measure 8-1/2" square unfinished.

2. BLOCK ONE: Sew (1) **G** 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle to either side of the **AB** unit. Press outward. Sew (1) **G** 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangle to the top and bottom of the **AB-G** unit. Press outward to complete Block One. Block should measure 10-1/2" square unfinished. Make (8) Block Ones.



3. Similar to Block One assembly make following blocks as shown:





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QUILT ASSEMBLY

4. ROW ASSEMBLY: Sew blocks in 5 horizontal rows, as shown in quilt diagram.

Note proper placement of blocks. Sew rows together to complete quilt top. Quilt center should measure 50-1/2" square unfinished.

5. BORDER ASSEMBLY: Sew (1) **A** 2-1/2" x 50-1/2" strip to either side of quilt center. Press outward. Sew (1) **A** 2-1/2" x 54-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **A** 2-1/4" strips.
