

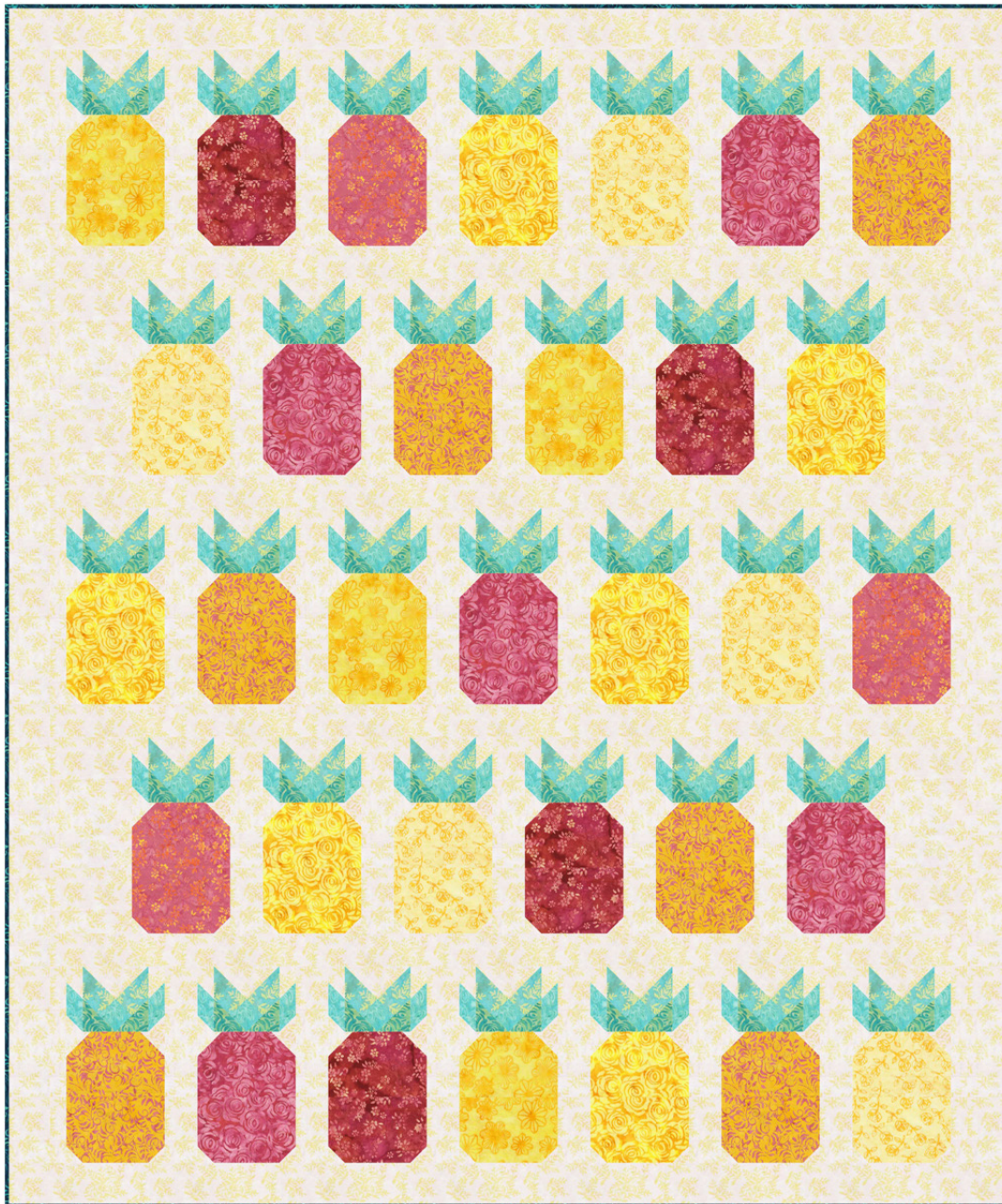

B		3382Q-X Pink	3/8	(1) 8-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (5) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.
C		3384Q-X Daisy	3/8	(1) 8-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (6) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.
D		3394Q-X Navy	2/3	BINDING: (8) 2-1/4" x WOF strips.
E		3380Q-X Raspberry	1/3	(1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (4) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.
F		3389Q-X Light Blue	5/8	(3) 3" x WOF strips; subcut (33) 3" squares. (2) 3-3/8" x WOF strips; subcut (17) 3-3/8" squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield (68) QST (will use 66).
G		3387Q-X Yellow	3/8	(1) 8-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (5) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.
H		3390Q-X Teal	5/8	(2) 3-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (56) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles. (2) 3-3/8" x WOF strips; subcut (17) 3-3/8" squares. Cut squares diagonally twice to yield (68) QST (will use 66). (1) 1-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (10) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.

I		3388Q-X Lemon	3-1/3	Sashing Strips (3) 12-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (28) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips, (6) 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips, and (4) 5-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles. (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (4) 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" strips. (7) 3" x WOF strips. Piece strips and subcut (2) 3" x 61-1/2" strips and (2) 3" x 68-1/2" strips.
J		3385Q-X Marigold	3/8	(1) 8-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (6) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.
K		3386Q-X Sunshine	1/3	(1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut (4) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.
L		3383Q-X Pink	1/3	(1) 6-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (3) 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles.
		Backing	3-7/8	69" x 81" piece of batting.

PINEAPPLE BLOCK

- Half-Square Triangle (HST):** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **I** 3" square. Place **I** square, right sides together, on (1) **F** 3" square. Sew 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line. Cut along drawn line to yield (2) **HST units**. Open and press. Square measures 2-1/2".



- Sew together (1) QST each of **F** and **H** and (1) **A** HST. Position the intersection of fabrics at 1-1/4" and trim unit to 2-1/2" square. Make (1) **A-F-H** unit and (1) **A-F-H** unit reversed.





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3. Sew together units made in **Steps 1-2** (note rotation). Make a mirror-image unit, and sew units together. Unit measures 4-1/2" square.

4. **Corner Triangles:** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **I** 1-1/2" square. Place **I** square, RST, at a corner of (1) **H** 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **I** corner triangle. Repeat with another **I** square at the opposite corner of the same **H** rectangle, as shown. Make (1) **H/I** unit and (1) **H/I** unit in reverse.



Draw diagonal line on wrong side of **I** square.

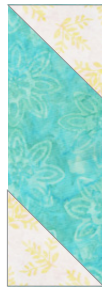


Sew on drawn line and trim 1/4" away from sewn line.



Open and press to reveal **I** corner triangle.

H / I UNIT



Repeat with **I** square at the opposite corner.

H / I UNIT REVERSED

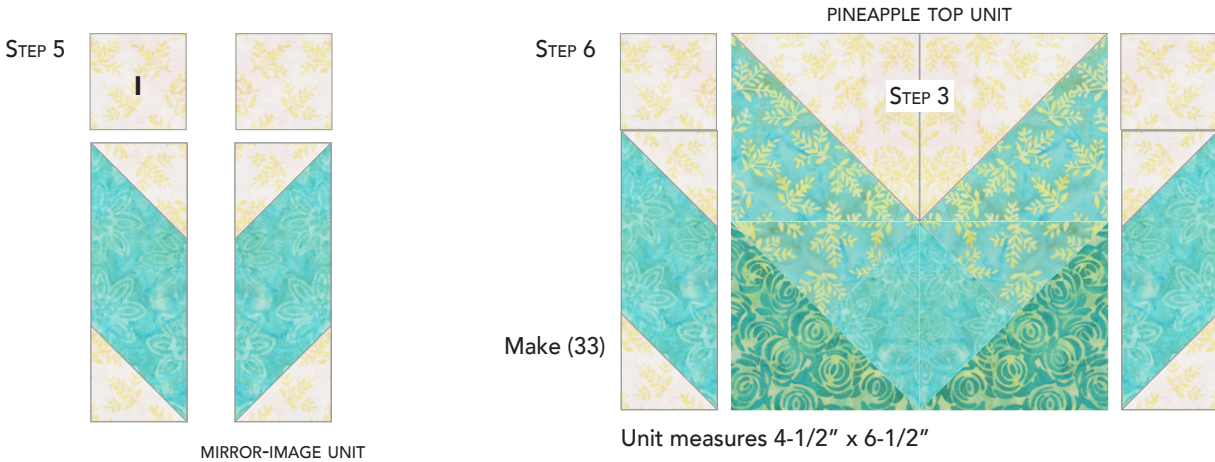


Make (1) of each.



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5. Add (1) **I** 1-1/2" square to the top of the **H/I** unit. Repeat to make a mirror-image unit.
6. Pineapple Top: Sew Step 5 units to the left and right sides of unit made in Step 3, as shown. Make (33). Unit measures 4-1/2" x 6-1/2".



7. Similar to Step 4, create corner triangles using (2) marked **I** 2" squares and (1) **K** 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle. Place squares, RST, at the top left and right corners of the **K** rectangles, as shown. Repeat sewing (2) **I** 1-1/2" squares at the bottom left and right corners of the same **K** rectangle. Unit measures 6-1/2" x 8-1/2".
8. Sew together units made in Steps 6 and 7 to complete (1) Pineapple Block, measuring 6-1/2" x 12-1/2". Make (4).





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9. Make a total of number of Pineapple Blocks using the following fabrics:



QUILT ASSEMBLY

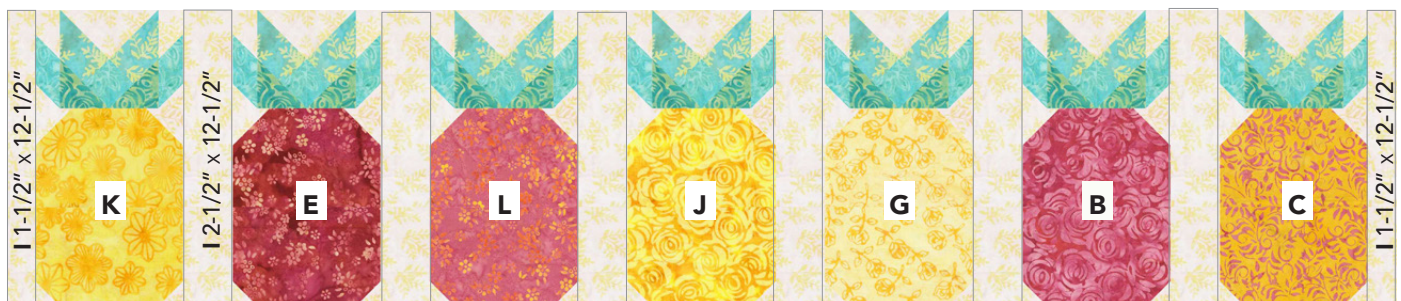
REFER TO QUILT DIAGRAM ON PAGE 6 FOR PROPER PLACEMENT OF BLOCKS AND ROWS

10. Arrange and sew together Pineapple Blocks, using **I** 1-1/2" x 12-1/2", **I** 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" and **I** 5-1/2" x 12-1/2" sashing strips as follows:

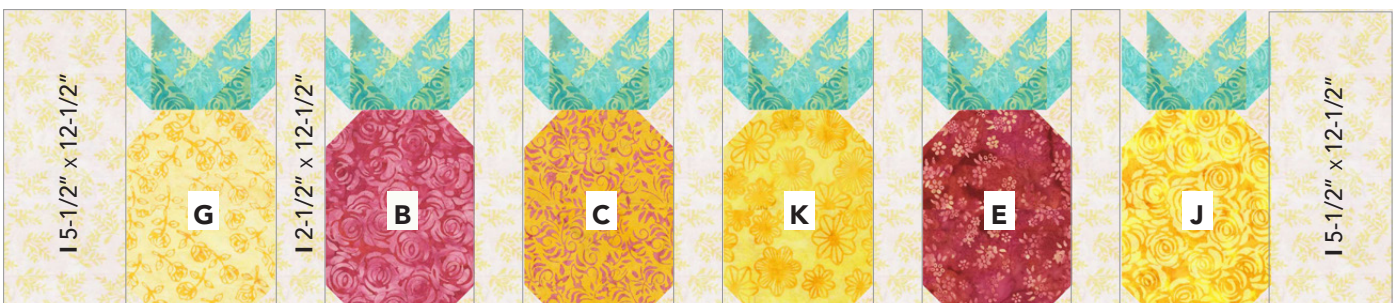
Row 1, 3, 5: (7) Pineapple Blocks, (6) **I** 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" (INNER) and (2) **I** 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" (ENDS)

Row 2, 4: (6) Pineapple Blocks, (5) **I** 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" (INNER) and (2) **I** 5-1/2" x 12-1/2" (ENDS)

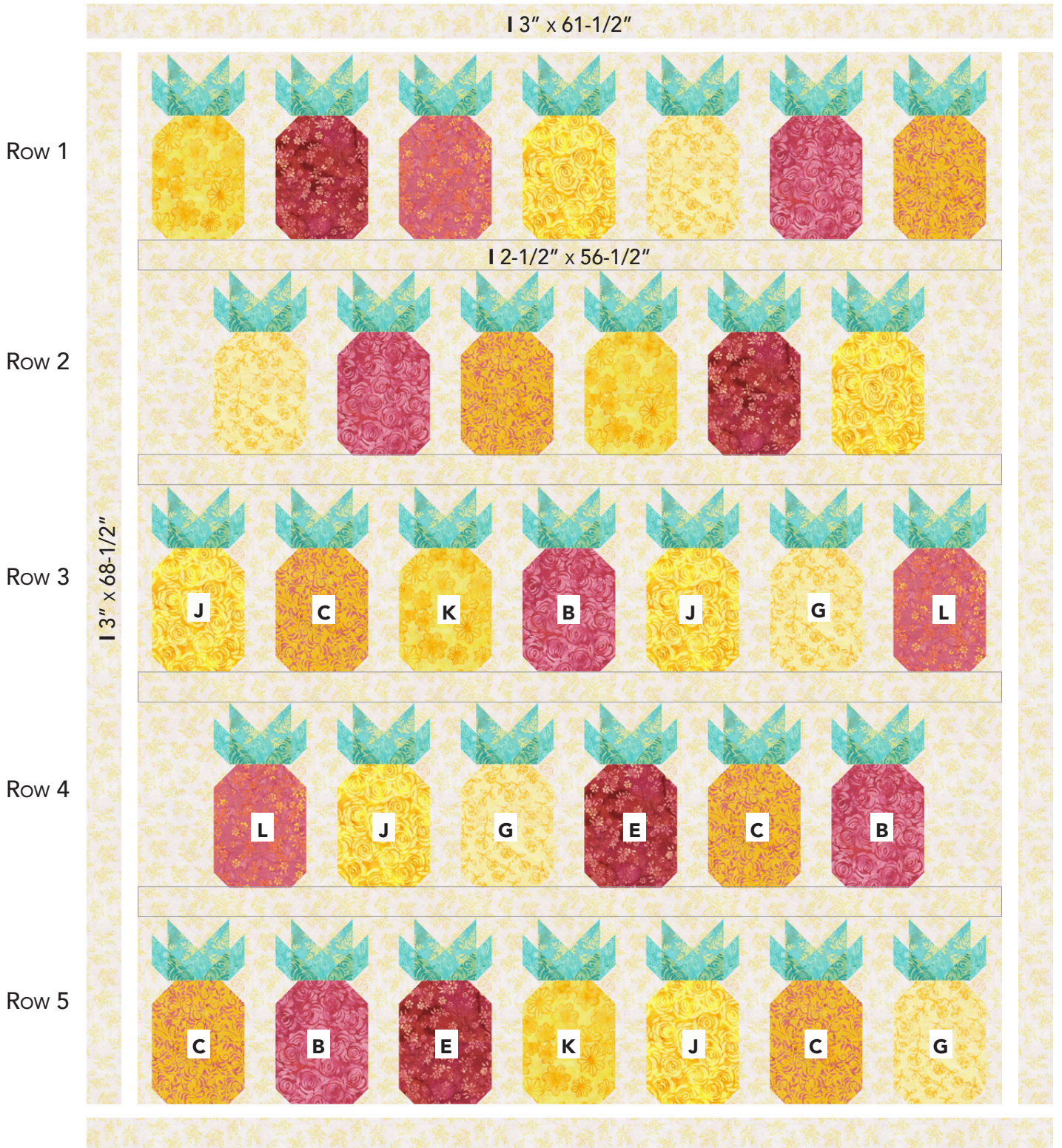
11. Sew together pieced rows and (4) **I** 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" sashing strips to complete quilt center.

12. **OUTER BORDER:** Sew (2) **I** 3" x 68-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **I** 3" x 61-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.



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QUILT DIAGRAM



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **D** 2-1/4" strips.
