## PIECED BLOCK

## STAR UNIT

1. Flying Geese Unit: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) $\mathbf{J} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place square, right sides together (RST), at a corner of (1) B 2" $\times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal J corner triangle. Repeat with another $\mathbf{J}$ square at the opposite corner of the same $\mathbf{B}$ rectangle to make (1) flying geese unit. Make (2).

2. Pieced Rectangle Unit: Sew together (1) A $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle and (1) B $1^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, along the long sides, to make a $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieced rectangle unit.
3. Striped Flying Geese Unit: Repeat Step 1 using (2) J 2" squares and (1) Pieced Rectangle Unit. Make (2).

4. Sew (1) stripe flying geese unit and (1) flying geese unit to the left and right sides, respectively, of (1) J 3-1/2" square to make a row unit.

5. Sew together (1) A 1-1/2" $\times 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle and (1) B $1^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, as shown, to make a pieced square unit. Make (2).
6. Add (1) pieced square unit to the left of (1) flying geese unit, followed by (1) B 2" square to the right of the flying geese unit.

7. Sew together (1) B $1^{\prime \prime}$ square and (1) A $1^{\prime \prime} \times 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, and add to the top of (1) A $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to make a pieced corner unit.

8. Sew (1) pieced corner unit and (1) pieced square to the left and right sides of (1) stripe flying geese unit.

9. Sew together units made in Steps 4, 6 and 8 to make a Star Unit.

10. Sew together (1) A 1-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle and (1) B 2-1/2" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, and add to the right of Star Unit made from Step 9.

11. Sew together (1) A $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle and (1) B $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, and add to the top of Star Unit.

12. Sew (1) A 1-1/2" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the right and (1) A $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the top of Star Unit made in Step 11 to complete (1) Pieced Block. Measures 9-1/2" square unfinished. Make (4).

## QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

REFER TO QUILT DIAGRAM ON PAGE 8 FOR BLOCK PLACEMENT AND ROTATION.
14. Pieced Rows: Arrange and sew together (6) Pieced Blocks and (5) C 1-1/2" $\times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing rectangles. Make (7).
15. Sew together pieced rows and (6) C $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 59-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips to complete quilt center. Rows 1 and 2 are shown below.


OUTER BORDER
16. Sew (2) C $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 69-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) C 3-1/2" $\times 65-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom of quilt center.
