



| В | | 41696-4 Red | 3/4 | Sashing: (2) 12.5" x WOF strips. Subcut (40) 12.5" x 1.5" pieces. |
| С | **** | 41695M-1 Green | 7/8 | Blocks: (6) 4" x WOF strips. Subcut (64) 4" x 3.5" pieces for #1. Cornerstones: (4) 4.5" squares. Sashing Cornerstones: (1) 1.5" x WOF strip. Subcut (25) 1.5" squares. |
| D | * | 41695M-2 Cream | 1 5/8 | Border: On length of fabric, cut (4) 4.5" x Length of Fabric. Blocks: (6) 6.5" x WOF strips. Subcut (64) 6.5" x 2.5" pieces for light gold #3 |
| E | ***** | 41695M-4 Red | 3/4 | Blocks: (6) 4" x WOF strips. Subcut (64) 4" x 3.5" pieces for #1. |
| F | | 38934EM-3 Metallic Gold | 5/8 | Binding: (8) 2.5" x WOF strips. Join together with diag- onal seams. Press in half. |
| G | | 41696M-3 Gold | 3/4 | Blocks: (4) 6.5" x WOF strips. Subtuc (64) 6.5" x 2.5" pieces for dark gold #3. |
| Н | | 41692M-X Multi | 4 | Backing: Cut in half across width. Cut off selvedges before seaming together for a piece about 80" x 80" |




- This quilt is made of 16 blocks which are 12" square finished.
- Each block is comprised of 8 sections. 4 of the sections have a red #1 piece and 4 of them have a green #1 piece. The center star is made of two different gold fabrics. The green sections have a dark gold and the red a light gold. They are illustrated below.
- THIS ILLUSTRATION IS NOT TO SCALE. There are foundation patterns at the end of the pattern for you to copy and use. You will need 32 copies of the pattern page.



- The cutting instructions have listed the rectangle size needed to cover the designated part of the block.
- The arrows above indicate where the straight of grain of the fabric should be. It does NOT matter if it is the lengthwise or crosswise of the fabric.
- The numbers indicate the order in which the pieces should be sewn to the foundation.
- Trim off the excess fabric leaving 1/4" past the sewing line.




- Sew all 64 sections.
- Join one red and one green section together as shown. Make 64 units.
- Sew 4 units together to create a block as shown. Make 16 blocks.



• On 20 sashing strips, sew a green cornerstone to the left end as shown.




• On each block, sew a sashing strip to the left side and the sashing strip with the cornerstone to the bottom as shown. Make 16 units.



Make 16 blocks.




• Sew 4 blocks together and add a sashing strip with a green cornerstone at the end to make one row. Make 4 rows.



Make 4 rows.


- Sew the 4 rows together.
- Sew the remaining sashing strips together (4) with a green cornerstone between each and one cornerstone on each end.
- Sew to the top of the quilt, completing the center.






CUTTING THE BORDERS—

- With the center complete, measure down the center of the quilt from top to bottom.
- Measure across the center of the quilt from side to side.
- They should measure the same: 53 1/2".
- If they don't measure the same, take the average of the two numbers as the border length.
- Trim your border pieces to this length.
- Sew a border to each side of the quilt.
- On each end of the top and bottom borders, sew a cornerstone.
- Add to the top and the bottom of the quilt.
- Make a sandwich of the top, batting and backing.
- Quilt as desired.
- Square up the quilt and bind with a 3/8" binding.
- If you are going to use as a wall hanging, add a sleeve at the top.
- Sew on a label.
- Enjoy!!!!

These foundations are the REVERSE of the finished block. Sew the fabric to the unprinted side.
