A	REAL A	51646-X Multi	1-1/3	(1) 4" x 43-1/2" LOF borders. (3) 4" x 34" WOF strips; sew ends together. Subcut (2) 4" x 45-1/2" borders. (1) 4-3/4" x 34" strip; subcut (7) 4-3/4" x 4-1/2" rectangles.

L		50087-56 Candy	5/8	FOR BINDING:  (6) 2-1/4" x WOF; sew ends together on the diagonal.  (3) 1-1/4" x WOF; subcut (21) 1-1/4" x 4-1/2" strips.
		Backing	3-1/4	Batting 58" x 63"

#### ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Thread to match fabrics Basic sewing supplies

Sewing machine Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

#### **BLOCKS**

- **1.** Sew (1) **K** 1-1/4" x 4-1/2" strip to the top of (1) **A** 4-1/2" x 4-3/4" rectangle. Finished block should measure 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" including seam allowance. Make 4.
- 2. In the same way, sew the following combinations of strips and rectangles together: K/F, K/G, J/B, J/F, L/B and L/H. Make the number of blocks indicated.

- **3.** Sew (1) **J** 1-1/4" x 4-1/2" strip to the bottom of (1) **I** 4-1/2" x 4-3/4" rectangle. Finished block should measure 4-1/2" x 5-1/2" including seam allowance. Make 7.
- 4. In the same way, sew the following combinations of strips and rectangles together: J/A, J/E, K/B, K/E, L/F and L/G. Make the number of blocks indicated.



#### **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

5. Arrange (9) blocks as shown in (2) horizontal rows. Sew the blocks in each row together. Each row should measure  $36-1/2" \times 5-1/2"$ . Make (4) Row 1 and (3) Row 2.


**6.** Following the Quilt Layout on page 4, arrange Rows 1 and 2 alternating with the (8) **D** 1-1/4" x 36-1/2" strips. Sew the rows and strips together.

#### **BORDERS**

- **7.** Sew (1)  $\mathbf{C}$  1-1/2" x 41-1/2" border to sides of quilt. Sew (1)  $\mathbf{C}$  1-1/2" x 38-1/2" border to top and bottom of quilt.
- **8.** Sew (1)  $\mathbf{A}$  4" x 43-1/2" border to sides of quilt. Sew (1)  $\mathbf{A}$  4" x 45-1/2" border to top and bottom of quilt.
- **9.** Sew (1) **J** (2) 1-1/4" x 50-1/2" border to sides of quilt. Sew (1) **K** 1-1/4" square to ends of (2) **J** 1-1/4" x 45-1/2" borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
- **10.** Sew (1)  $\bf D$  2" x 52" borders to sides of quilt. Sew (1)  $\bf D$  2" x 50" border to top and bottom of quilt.



### **QUILT LAYOUT**



**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using  $\bf J$  2-1/4" strips.
