## ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Thread to match fabrics
Basic sewing supplies

Sewing machine
Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

## BLOCKS

1. Sew (1) K $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top of (1) A 4-1/2" $\times 4-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Finished block should measure 4-1/2" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ including seam allowance. Make 4.
2. In the same way, sew the following combinations of strips and rectangles together: $\mathbf{K} / \mathbf{F}, \mathbf{K} / \mathbf{G}$, J/B, J/F, L/B and L/H. Make the number of blocks indicated.

3. Sew (1) J $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the bottom of (1) I 4-1/2" $\times 4-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Finished block should measure 4-1/2" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ including seam allowance. Make 7.
4. In the same way, sew the following combinations of strips and rectangles together: J/A, J/E, K/B, K/E, L/F and L/G. Make the number of blocks indicated.

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## QUILT ASSEMBLY

5. Arrange (9) blocks as shown in (2) horizontal rows. Sew the blocks in each row together. Each row should measure $36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Make (4) Row 1 and (3) Row 2.

6. Following the Quilt Layout on page 4, arrange Rows 1 and 2 alternating with the (8) $\mathbf{D} 1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ $36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Sew the rows and strips together.

## BORDERS

7. Sew (1) C 1-1/2" $\times 41-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to sides of quilt. Sew (1) C $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 38-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to top and bottom of quilt.
8. Sew (1) A $4^{\prime \prime} \times 43-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to sides of quilt. Sew (1) A $4^{\prime \prime} \times 45-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to top and bottom of quilt.
9. Sew (1) J (2) 1-1/4" $\times 50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to sides of quilt. Sew (1) $\mathbf{K} 1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square to ends of (2) J 1-1/4" $\times 45-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
10. Sew (1) D $2^{\prime \prime} \times 52^{\prime \prime}$ borders to sides of quilt. Sew (1) D $2^{\prime \prime} \times 50$ " border to top and bottom of quilt.

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## QUILT LAYOUT



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using J 2-1/4" strips.
