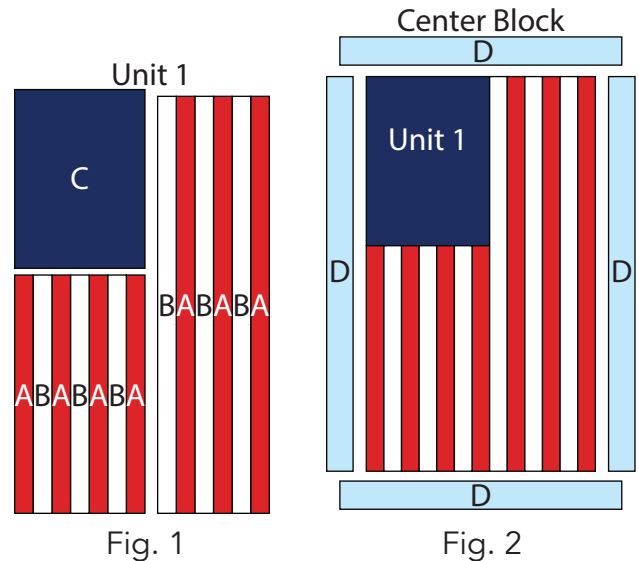
Block Assembly:

Note: The arrows in the figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations while assembling the various components.

1. Sew together (4) **A** 1-3/4" x 16-1/2" strips and (3) **B** 1-3/4" x 16-1/2" strips, lengthwise and alternating them from left to right. Sew (1) 12-1/2" x 9-1/4" Fabric C strip to the top of the newly sewn strip.

2. Sew together (3) **B** 1-3/4" x 28-1/2" strips and (3) **A** 1-3/4" x 28-1/2" strips, lengthwise and alternating them from left to right. Sew the newly sewn strip lengthwise to the right side of the strip from **Step 1** to make (1) **Unit 1** rectangle (**Fig. 1**).

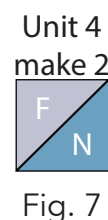
3. Sew (1) **D** 2-3/8" x 28-1/2" strip to each side of the **Unit 1** rectangle. Sew (1) **D** 2-1/2" x 20-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Unit 1** rectangle to make the **Center Block** (**Fig. 2**).



4. Place (1) **E** 4-7/8" square on top of (1) **F** 4-7/8" square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (**Fig. 3**). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (**Fig. 3**). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (**Fig. 4**) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 4-1/2" square to make (2) **Unit 2** squares (**Fig. 5**). Repeat to make (14) **Unit 2** squares total.



5. Repeat **Step 4** and refer to **Figures 6-7** for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (14) **Unit 3** squares and (2) **Unit 4** squares.

6. Sew together (8) **Unit 2** squares to make the **Border 1** strip (**Fig. 8**).

7. Sew together (8) **Unit 3** squares to make the **Border 2** strip (**Fig. 9**).

8. Sew together (6) **Unit 2** squares. Sew (1) **Unit 4** square to the right end of the newly sewn strip to make the **Border 3** strip (**Fig. 10**).

9. Sew together (6) **Unit 3** squares. Sew (1) **Unit 4** square to the left end of the newly sewn strip to make the **Border 4** strip (**Fig. 11**).

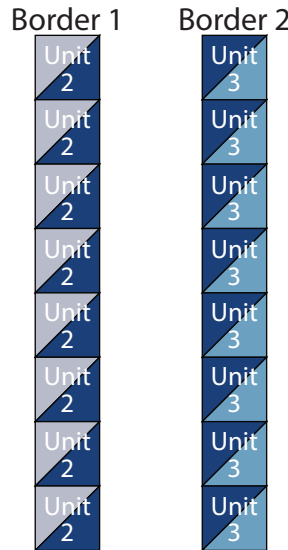

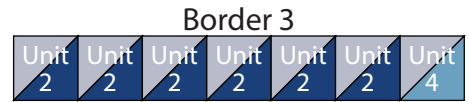

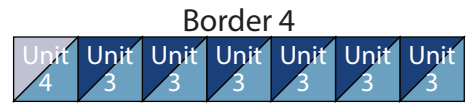

10. Place (1) **J** 2-1/2" square on the top of (1) **H** 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" strip, right sides together and aligning the tops of the fabrics (**Fig. 12**). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (**Fig. 12**). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (**Fig. 13**).

11. Place another **J** 2-1/2" Fabric square on the bottom of the **H** 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" strip, right sides together and aligning the bottoms of the fabrics (**Fig. 14**). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (**Fig. 14**). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) **Unit 5** strip (**Fig. 15**).

12. Repeat **Steps 10-11** to make a second **Unit 5** strip.

13. Repeat **Steps 10-11** and refer to **Figure 16** for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (2) **Unit 6** strips.

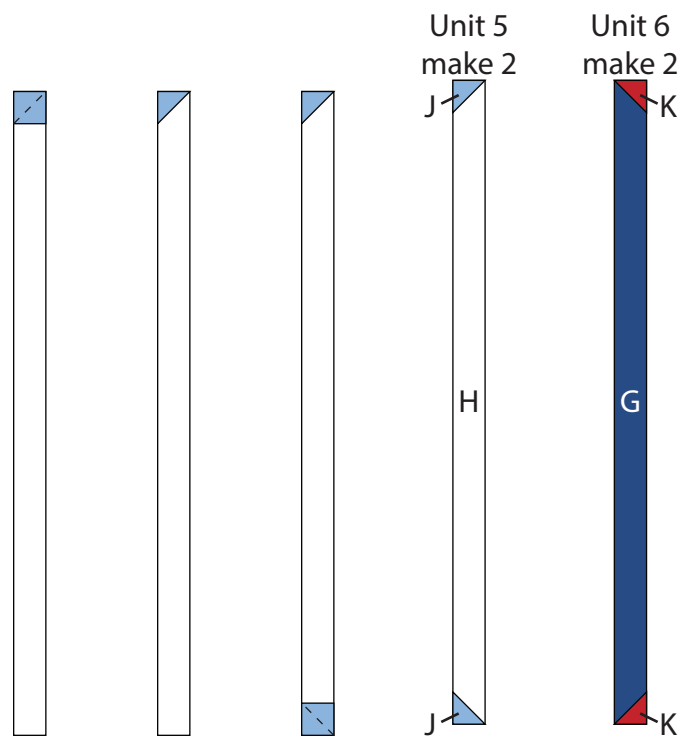

14. Repeat **Steps 10-11** and refer to **Figure 17** for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation while using (2) **H** 2-1/2" x 28-1/2" strips and (4) **K** 2-1/2" squares to make (2) **Unit 7** strips.

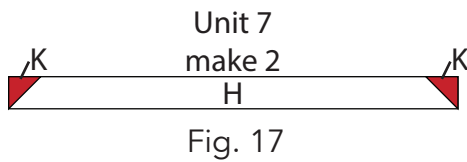

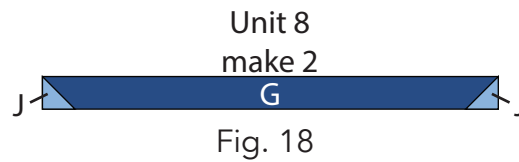

16. Repeat **Step 4** and refer to **Figure 19** for fabric identification and placement while using (8) **K** 2-7/8" squares and (8) **J** 2-7/8" squares to make (16) 2-1/2" **Unit 9** squares.

17. Sew together (4) **Unit 9** squares into a 2 x 2 matrix to make (1) 4-1/2" **Unit 10** square (**Fig. 20**). Repeat to make (4) **Unit 10** squares total.

18. Sew (1) **Unit 5** strip to the left side of (1) **Unit 6** strip lengthwise to make the **Border 5** strip (**Fig. 21**). Repeat to make a second **Border 5** strip.

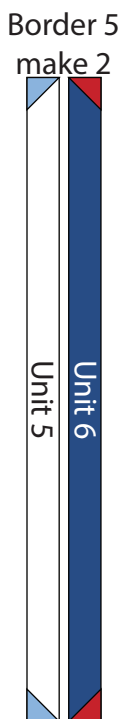

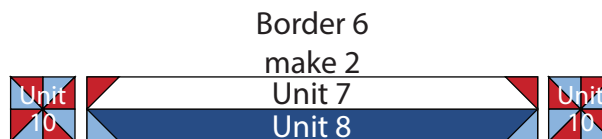

19. Sew (1) **Unit 7** strip to the top of (1) **Unit 8** strip lengthwise. Sew (1) **Unit 10** square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the **Border 6** strip (**Fig. 22**). Repeat to make a second **Border 6** strip.

- 20.** Place (1) **J** 2-1/2" square on the left side of **I** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strip, right sides together (**Fig. 23**). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (**Fig. 23**). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (**Fig. 24**).
- 21.** Place (1) **K** 2-1/2" square on the right side of the **I** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strip, right sides together (**Fig. 25**). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (**Fig. 25**). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) **Unit 11** strip (**Fig. 26**).
- 22.** Repeat **Steps 20-21** to make (4) **Unit 11** strips total.
- 23.** Repeat **Steps 20-21** and refer to **Figure 27** for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (4) **Unit 12** strips.

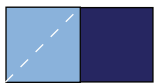

- 24.** Sew (1) **Unit 11** strip to the top of (1) **I** 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" strip. Sew (1) **Unit 12** to the bottom of the **I** strip to make (1) **Border 7** strip (**Fig. 28**). Repeat to make a second **Border 7** strip.
- 25.** Sew (1) **Unit 11** strip to the left end of (1) **I** 2-1/2" x 28-1/2" strip. Sew (1) **Unit 12** strip to the right end of the **I** strip. Sew (1) **L** 2-1/2" square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make (1) **Border 8** strip (**Fig. 29**). Repeat to make a second **Border 8** strip.

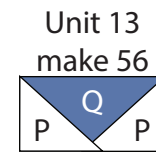

26. Repeat **Steps 20-21** and refer to **Figure 30** for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation while using (56) **Q** 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips and (112) **P** 2-1/2" squares to make (56) **Unit 13** strips.

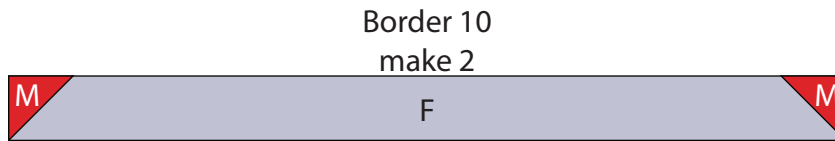

29. Repeat **Step 4** and refer to **Figure 33** for fabric identification and placement while using (10) **M** 2-7/8" squares and (10) **P** 2-7/8" squares to make (20) 2-1/2" **Unit 14** squares.

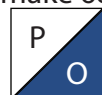

30. Repeat **Step 29** and refer to **Figures 34-36** for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (24) **Unit 15** squares, (68) **Unit 16** squares and (8) **Unit 17** squares.

31. Follow **Figure 37** and sew together (32) assorted unit squares to make (1) **Border 11** strip. Repeat to make a second **Border 11** strip.

32. Follow **Figure 38** and sew together (28) assorted unit squares to make (1) **Border 12** strip. Repeat to make a second **Border 12** strip.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Refer to the Quilt Diagram while assembling the quilt top.)

33. Sew the **Border 1** strip to the left side of the **Center Block**. Sew the **Border 2** strip to the right side of the **Center Block**. Sew the **Border 3** strip to the top of the **Center Block**. Sew the **Border 4** strip to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

34. Sew (1) **Border 5** strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **Border 6** strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

35. Sew (1) **Border 7** strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **Border 8** strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

36. Sew (1) **L** 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **L** 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

37. Sew (1) **Border 9** strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **Border 10** strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block**.

38. Sew (1) **Border 11** strip to each side of the **Center Block**. Sew (1) **Border 12** strip to the top and to the bottom of the **Center Block** to make the quilt top.

Finishing

39. Layer and quilt as desired

40. Sew the (7) **K** 2-1/2" x WOF strips together end-to-end with 45-degree seams to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

41. Bind as desired.
