## **General Instructions:**

- A. All seam allowances are  $\frac{1}{4}$ " unless otherwise noted.
- B. Read through all instructions before beginning your project.
- C. Press all seam allowances towards the darker fabric unless otherwise noted.
- D. We recommend using spray starch or sizing on all fabrics before cutting to reduce bias stretch.



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
<u>Piecing Instructions:</u> (Refer to block diagrams and images for proper placement and rotation)

#### Block 1:

1. Sew (2) B1, (1) C1 and (1) D1 squares together as show to create BLOCK 1. Square to 6-1/2", make (16).

### Block 2:

2. Sew (2) D1 squares together, then sew to (1) B2 as show to create BLOCK 2. Square to 6-1/2", make (4).



Assembly Instructions: (Refer to quilt diagram for proper block placement and rotation)

## **Quilt Assembly:**

3. Sew squares and blocks into rows, then sew rows together.

Rows 1 & 9: A1 - E1 - Block 1 - A1 - Block 1 - E1 - A1

Rows 2 & 8: E1 - Block 1 - A1 - F1 - A1 - Block 1 - E1

Rows 3 & 7: Block 1 - A1 - F1 - Block 2 - F1 - A1 - Block 1

Rows 4 & 6: A1 - F1 - Block 1 - E1 - Block 1 - F1 - A1

Row 5: F1 - Block 2 - E1 - A1 - E1 - Block 2 - F1

## Border Assembly:

#### Border 1:

4. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 54-1/2"), cut (2) D 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 44-1/2") cut (2) D 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

#### Border 2:

5. Measure top and bottom or quilt (ours is 44-1/2), cut (2) B 3-1/2" strips to fit and set aside. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 56-1/2"), cut (2) B 3-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Sew (1) E2 to each end of top and bottom strips, then sew to quilt.

#### Border 3:

6. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 62-1/2"), cut (2) A 6-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 62-1/2") cut (2) A 6-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.

## Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind with **D** strips using your preferred method ... and enjoy!



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
