- B. Read through all instructions before beginning your project.
- C. Press all seam allowances towards the darker fabric unless otherwise noted.






<u>Piecing Instructions:</u> (Refer to block diagrams and images for proper placement)


**Block 1:** (*Make 4, square to 12-1/2"*)


- 1. Sew (1) **B1** to right side of (1) **D1** and press, then sew (1) **B2** to bottom and press.
- 2. Sew (1) G1 to left side and press, then sew (1) G2 to top and press.
- 3. Sew (1) **B3** to right side and press, then sew (1) **B4** to bottom and press.
- 4. Sew (1) **H1** to left side and press, then sew (1) **H2** to top and press.
- 5. Sew (1) E1 to right side and press, then sew (1) E2 to bottom and press to complete BLOCK 1.













### Blocks 2A, 2B, 3A, and 3B:

6. In the same manner as BLOCK 1, use the chart below to sew pieces around the center D rectangle. Make 2 of each block and square to the size indicated.

Assembly Instructions: (Refer to quilt diagram for proper block placement and rotation)

#### **Quilt Assembly:**

- 7. Sew (1) BLOCK 3A to (1) BLOCK 3B, then sew to right side of A Panel.
- 8. Sew (1) **BLOCK 3A** to (1) **BLOCK 3B**, then sew to left side of **A Panel**.
- 9. Sew together (2) BLOCK 1s, (1) BLOCK 2A and (1) BLOCK 2B, then sew to top of quilt.
- 10. Sew together (2) BLOCK 1s, (1) BLOCK 2A and (1) BLOCK 2B, then sew to bottom of quilt.

#### **Border Assembly:**

- 11. Measure sides of quilt (ours is 62-1/2"), cut (2) H 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to sides of quilt. Measure top and bottom of quilt (ours is 61-1/2") cut (2) H 1-1/2" strips to fit, then sew to top and bottom of quilt.
- 12. Center and pin (2) **F** 3-1/2" X LOF strips along the sides of the quilt center. Sew in place, beginning and ending 1/4" away from the corner of the quilt center, then press. Repeat on top and bottom. *Note: The border strips will extend beyond the quilt center and overlap.*
- 13. Place the upper right corner of the quilt on an ironing board, positioning the border strips so that the side strip overlaps the top strip. Fold the side strip under at a 45° angle, lining up the raw edges with the raw edges of the top strip. Press to create a crease in the border strip.
- 14. Carefully fold the side edge of the quilt up to meet the top edge of the quilt keeping the miter in place. Pin along the crease, then sew in the crease. Open and check to make sure the miter is accurate, then trim the seam allowance to 1/4". Press seam allowance open.
- 15. Repeat on remaining 3 corners.

#### Finishing:

Backing and batting should be 8" larger than finished quilt top. Layer your backing, batting and quilt top, then quilt as desired. Bind using your preferred method ... and enjoy!
