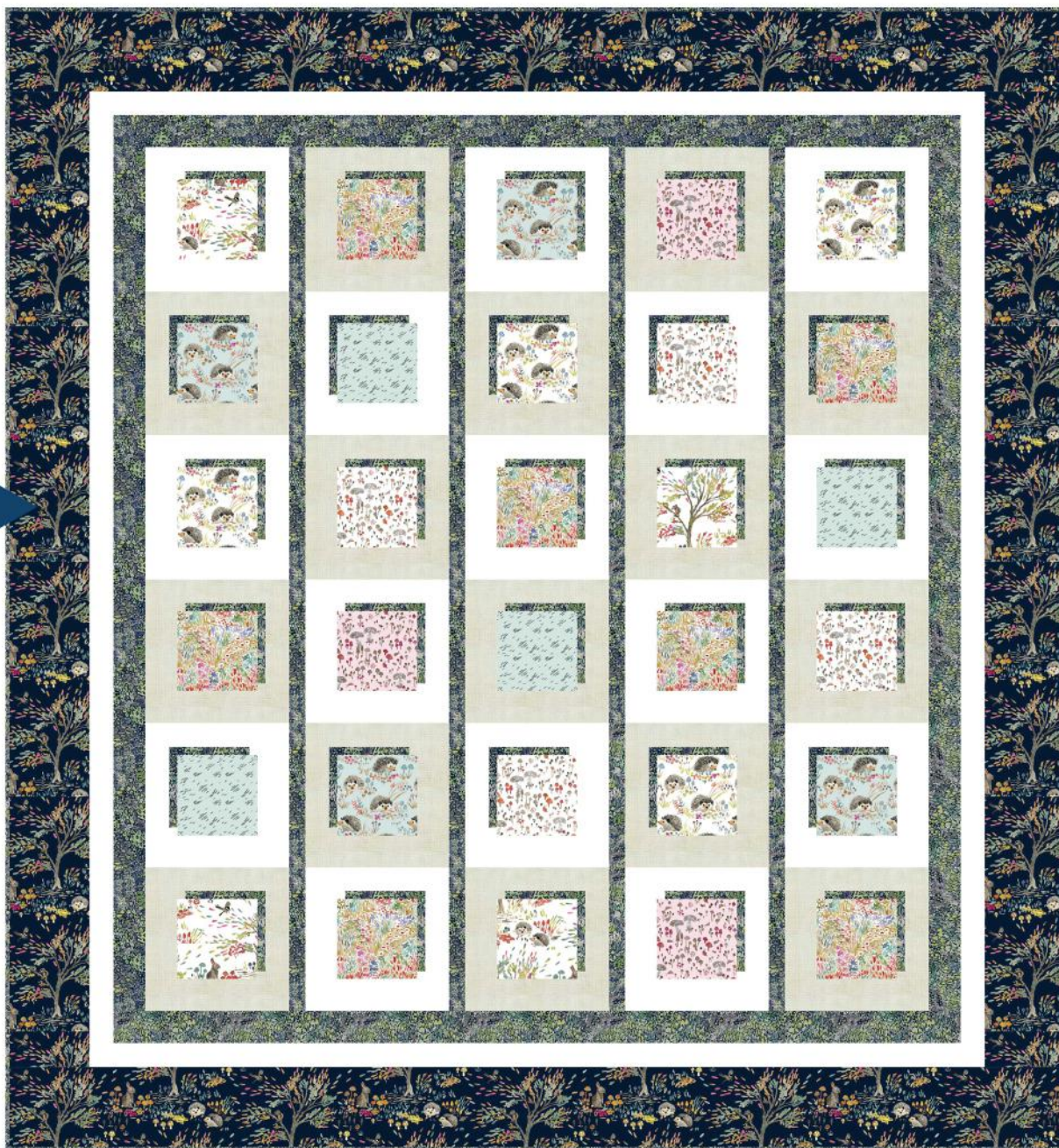

A		31835S Solid White	1 1/2	Pieced blocks: (1) 1 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (15) 1" x 1 1/2" rectangles and (15) 1" squares. (13) 2" x WOF. Subcut (30) 2" x 6 1/2" and (30) 2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. (1) 6 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (15) 1" x 5 1/2" and (15) 1" x 6 1/2" rectangles. Inner border #2: (6) 2" x WOF. Piece strips and subcut (2) 2" x 56 1/2" and (2) 2" x 58 1/2" strips.

D		43499-1 White	1/4	Pieced blocks: (1) 5 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (4) 5 1/2" squares.
E		43499-3 Aqua	1/4	Pieced blocks: (1) 5 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (4) 5 1/2" squares.
F		43500-1 White	1/4	Pieced blocks: (1) 5 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (4) 5 1/2" squares.
G		43500-4 Pale Pink	1/4	Pieced blocks: (1) 5 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (3) 5 1/2" squares.
H		43501-1 White	3/8	Pieced blocks: (1) 5 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (7) 5 1/2" squares.
I		43503-3 Aqua	1/4	Pieced blocks: (1) 5 1/2" x WOF. Subcut (4) 5 1/2" squares.
J		43498-2 Navy	1 1/4	Outer border: (7) 5 1/2" x WOF. Piece strips and subcut (2) 5 1/2" x 61 1/2" and (2) 5 1/2" x 66 1/2" strips.



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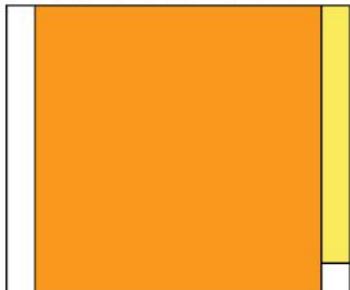

Sashing strips:            (6) 1 1/2" x WOF. Piece strips and subcut (4) 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips.            Inner border #1:            (6) 2 1/2" x WOF. Piece strips and subcut (2) 2 1/2" x 53 1/2" and (2) 2 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips.            Binding:            Cut 5/8 yd into 2 1/4" bias strips. Piece strips to make a continuous binding strip.</p>

## General instructions for constructing pieced blocks (using white blocks as example)

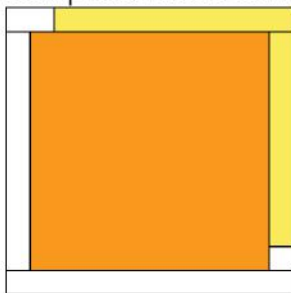
*Note: Orange represents print fabric. Yellow represents fabric K.*

### 1. Block Center

Sew (1) 1" x 5 1/2" **A** rectangle to the left side of (1) 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" print square. Sew (1) 1" x 5" **K** (shown below in yellow) rectangle and (1) 1" **A** square to make a column and add to the right side of the same 5 1/2" x 5 1/2" print square.



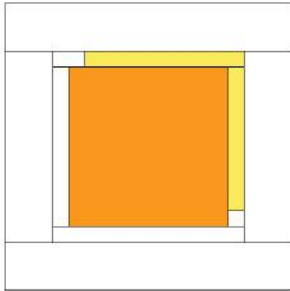
2. Sew (1) 1" x 1 1/2" **A** rectangle and (1) 1" x 5 1/2" **K** (shown below in yellow) rectangle to make a row. Add row to the top of print square, followed by (1) 1" x 6 1/2" **A** rectangle to complete block center.





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3. Sew (2) 2" x 6 1/2" **A** rectangles to the left and right sides of block center, followed by (2) 2" x 9 1/2" **A** rectangles to the top and bottom of block center to complete (1) block.



Some of the blocks are mirror-imaged, as shown, but construction process is the same.

4. Refer to quilt center diagram for fabric placement guide to construct all (30) blocks, noting block orientations.

## Quilt Center Assembly

5. Arrange and sew together (6) blocks to make a column. Repeat to make a total of (5) columns. Sew columns and (4) 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" **K** sashing strips to complete quilt center.



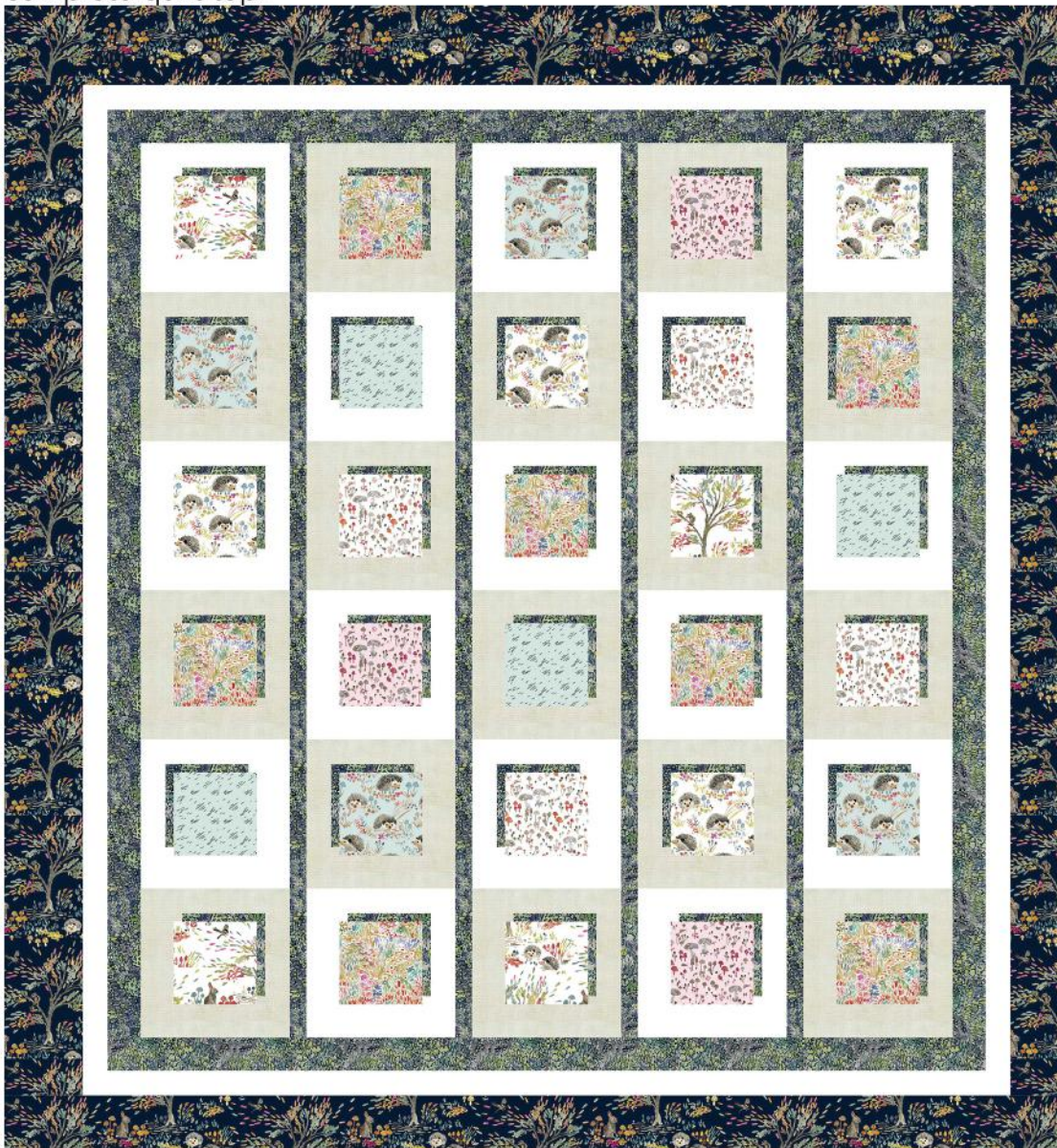

## Quilt Top Assembly

6. Inner border #1. Sew (2) 2 1/2" x 54 1/2" **K** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 2 1/2" x 53 1/2" **K** strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
7. Inner border #2. Sew (2) 2" x 58 1/2" **A** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 2" x 56 1/2" **A** strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center.
8. Outer border. Sew (2) 5 1/2" x 61 1/2" **J** strips to the opposite long sides of quilt center, followed by (2) 5 1/2" x 66 1/2" **J** strips to the remaining opposite short sides of quilt center to complete quilt top.



## Quilting Instructions

With the backing fabric laying taut, place batting and then quilt top to form quilt sandwich. Baste sandwich. Quilt as desired. Bind to finish quilt.
