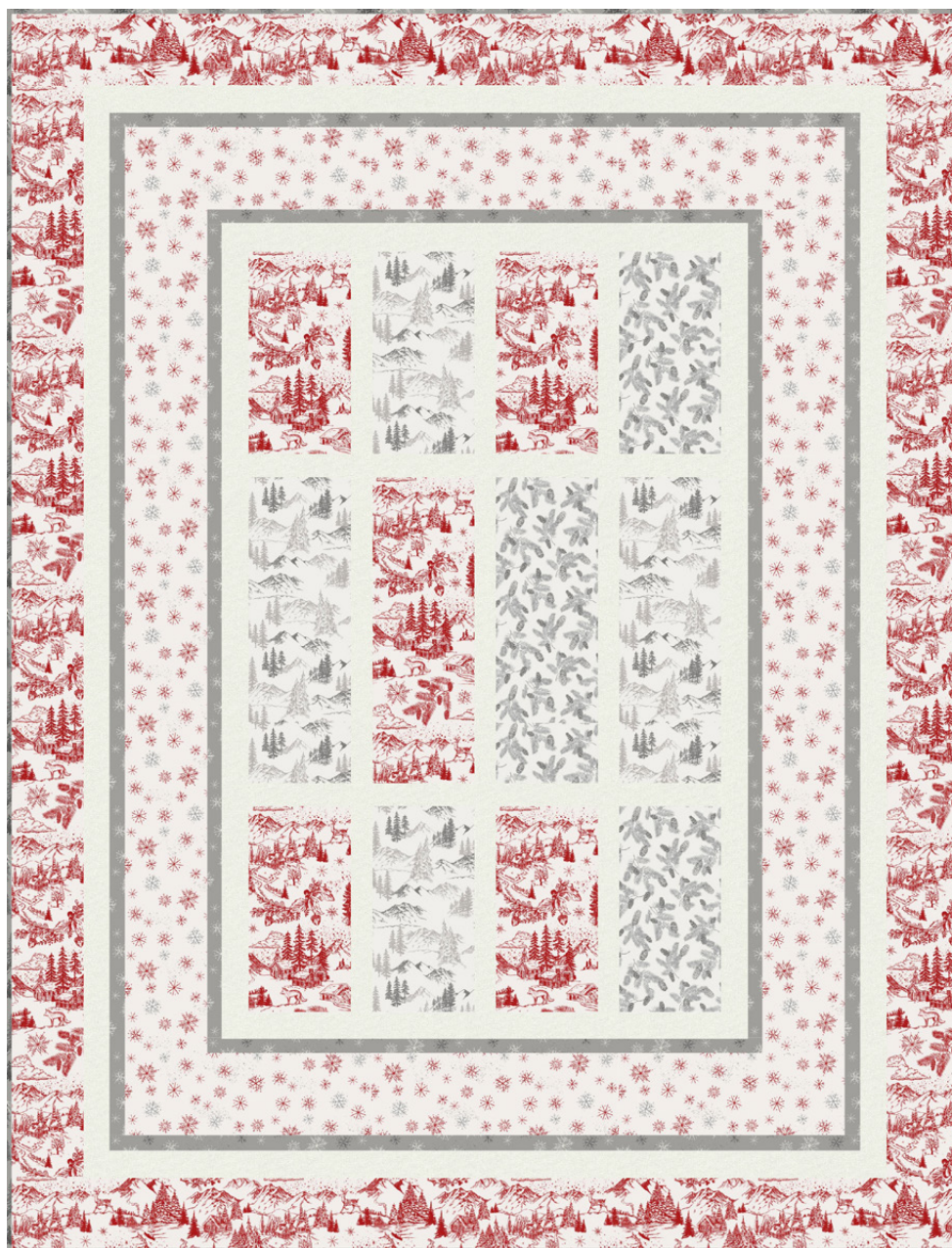

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

A		54042-2 Berry	1 5/8	<p><b>OUTER BORDER:</b>            (2) 4" x 53 1/2" LOF strips.            (4) 4" x 32" WOF strips. Piece strips in pairs and subcut (2) 4" x 46 1/2" strips.</p> <p><b>QUILT CENTER PATCH BLOCKS:</b>            From remainder, cut the following, noting fabric orientation:            (4) 5 1/2" wide x 10 1/2" tall rectangles            (1) 5 1/2" wide x 15 1/2" tall rectangles</p>
B		54043-4 Snow	5/8	<p><b>QUILT CENTER PATCH BLOCKS:</b>            (1) 15 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut            (2) 5 1/2" x 15 1/2" and (2) 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles</p>
C		54044-4 Snow	1/4	<p><b>QUILT CENTER PATCH BLOCKS:</b>            (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut            (2) 5 1/2" x 10 1/2" and (1) 5 1/2" x 15 1/2" rectangles</p>
D		54045-2 Berry	5/8	<p><b>INNER BORDER #3:</b>            (4) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut            (2) 4 1/2" x 35 1/2" strips and (2) 4 1/2" x 41 1/2" strips</p>
E		54045-3 Grey	1/2	<p><b>INNER BORDER #2:</b>            (4) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut            (2) 1 1/4" x 27 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/4" x 40" strips</p> <p><b>INNER BORDER #4:</b>            (5) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut            (2) 1 1/4" x 37" strips from (2) WOF strips; piece remaining (3) WOF strips and subcut            (2) 1 1/4" x 49 1/2" strips</p>

<b>F</b>		Sparkle 53969-6 Sugar	$\frac{7}{8}$	<b>QUILT CENTER SASHING:</b> (5) 1½" x WOF strips. Subcut (6) 1½" x 10½" strips, (3) 1½" x 15½" strips and (2) 1½" x 23½" strips <b>INNER BORDER #1:</b> (4) 1¾" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 1¾" x 26" strips and (2) 1¾" x 37½" strips <b>INNER BORDER #5:</b> (5) 1¾" x WOF strips. Subcut (2) 1¾" x 39½" strips from (2) WOF strips; piece remaining (3) WOF strips and subcut (2) 1¾" x 51" strips
<b>G</b>		54043-3 Grey	$\frac{1}{2}$	<b>BINDING:</b> (6) 2¼" x WOF strips. Piece strips together to make continuous binding strip.
		Backing	$3\frac{7}{8}$	56" x 72" piece of batting.

## QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

**1. Pieced Rows 1 & 3.** Arrange and sew together (2) **A** 5 ½" x 10 ½" rectangles, (1) **B** 5 ½" x 10 ½" rectangle, (1) **C** 5 ½" x 10 ½" rectangle, and (3) **F** 1 ½" x 10 ½" sashing rectangles to make a pieced row. Make a total of (2) pieced rows.



MAKE (2) PIECED ROWS

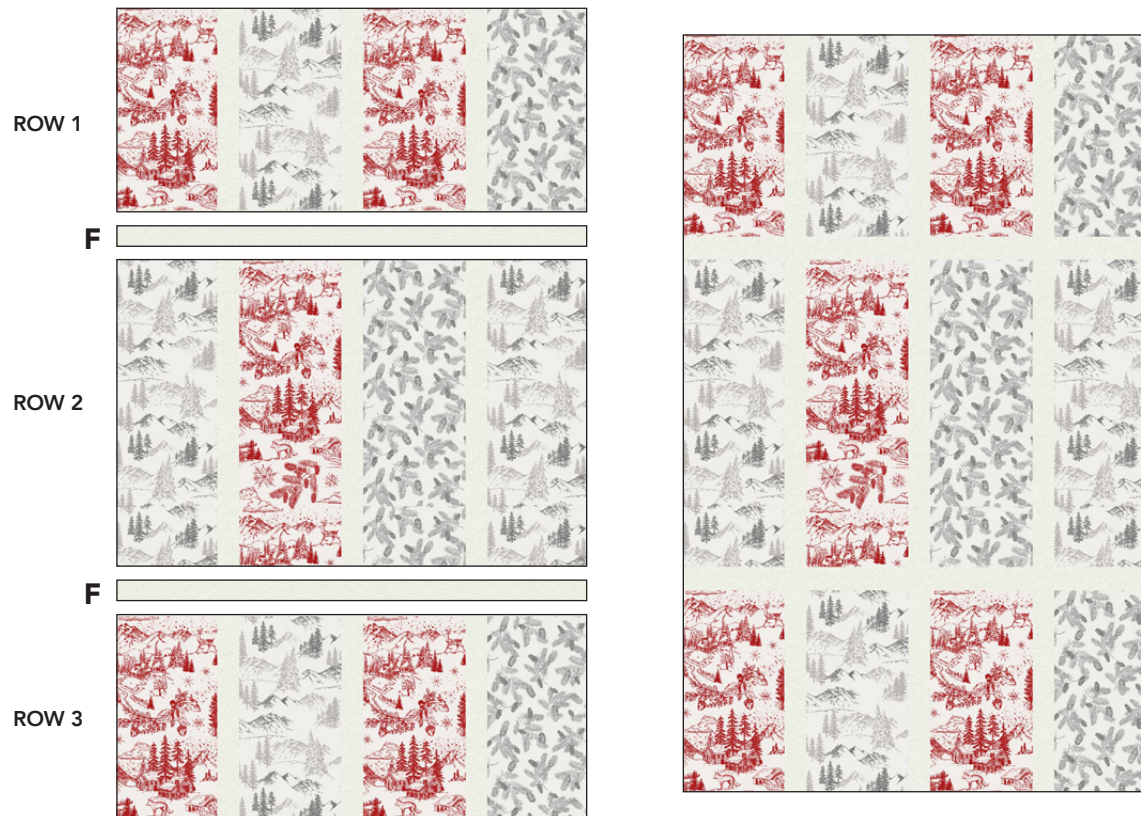
**2. Pieced Row 2.** Arrange and sew together (2) **B** 5 ½" x 15 ½" rectangles, (1) **A** 5 ½" x 15 ½" rectangle, (1) **C** 5 ½" x 15 ½" rectangle, and (3) **F** 1 ½" x 15 ½" sashing rectangles to make a pieced row.





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3. Sew together pieced rows and (2) **F** 1 ½" x 23 ½" sashing strips to complete quilt center.



## BORDER ASSEMBLY

*Refer to Quilt Assembly Diagram on Page 4 for the following instructions.*

**4. Inner Border #1.** Sew (1) **F** 1 ¾" x 37 ½" strip to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (1) **F** 1 ¾" x 26" strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.

**5. Inner Border #2.** Sew (1) **E** 1 ¼" x 40" strip to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (1) **E** 1 ¼" x 27 ½" strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.

**6. Inner Border #3.** Sew (1) **D** 4 ½" x 41 ½" strip to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (1) **D** 4 ½" x 35 ½" strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.

**7. Inner Border #4.** Sew (1) **E** 1 ¼" x 49 ½" strip to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (1) **E** 1 ¼" x 37" strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.

**8. Inner Border #5.** Sew (1) **F** 1 ¾" x 51" strip to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (1) **F** 1 ¾" x 39 ½" strip to the top and bottom of quilt center.

**9. Outer Border.** Sew (1) **A** 4" x 53 ½" strip to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (1) **A** 4" x 46 ½" strip to the top and bottom of quilt center to complete quilt top.

**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **G** 2-1/4" strips.
