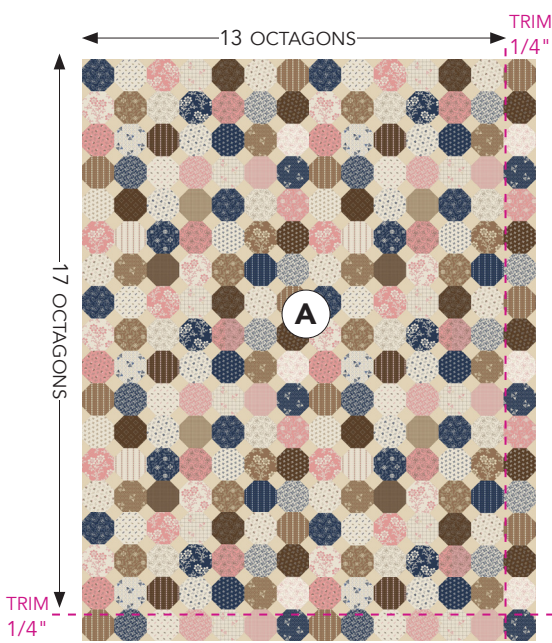

KEY	FABRIC	SKU	YD	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A		52960-1 Cream	1-2/3	Fussy Cut Cheater Cloth 1/4" past the outer edge of (13) horizontal octagons and (17) vertical octagons (about 44-1/2" x 58-1/2"). <i>Refer to diagram below.</i> <i>Note: If needed, fussy cut 1/4" past the outer edge of how many octagons your yardage has.</i>
B		52963-2 Tan	1/2	(6) 2" x WOF strips for inner border.
C		52967-5 Brown	1-2/3	(7) 4-1/2" x WOF strips for outer borders. (7) 2-1/4" x WOF strips for binding.
D		Backing	3-3/4	Batting 64" x 78" piece.

ADDING BORDERS

Refer to Quilt Assembly Diagram on the next page. Note: Your finished quilt size may vary based on the size of your A center cut.

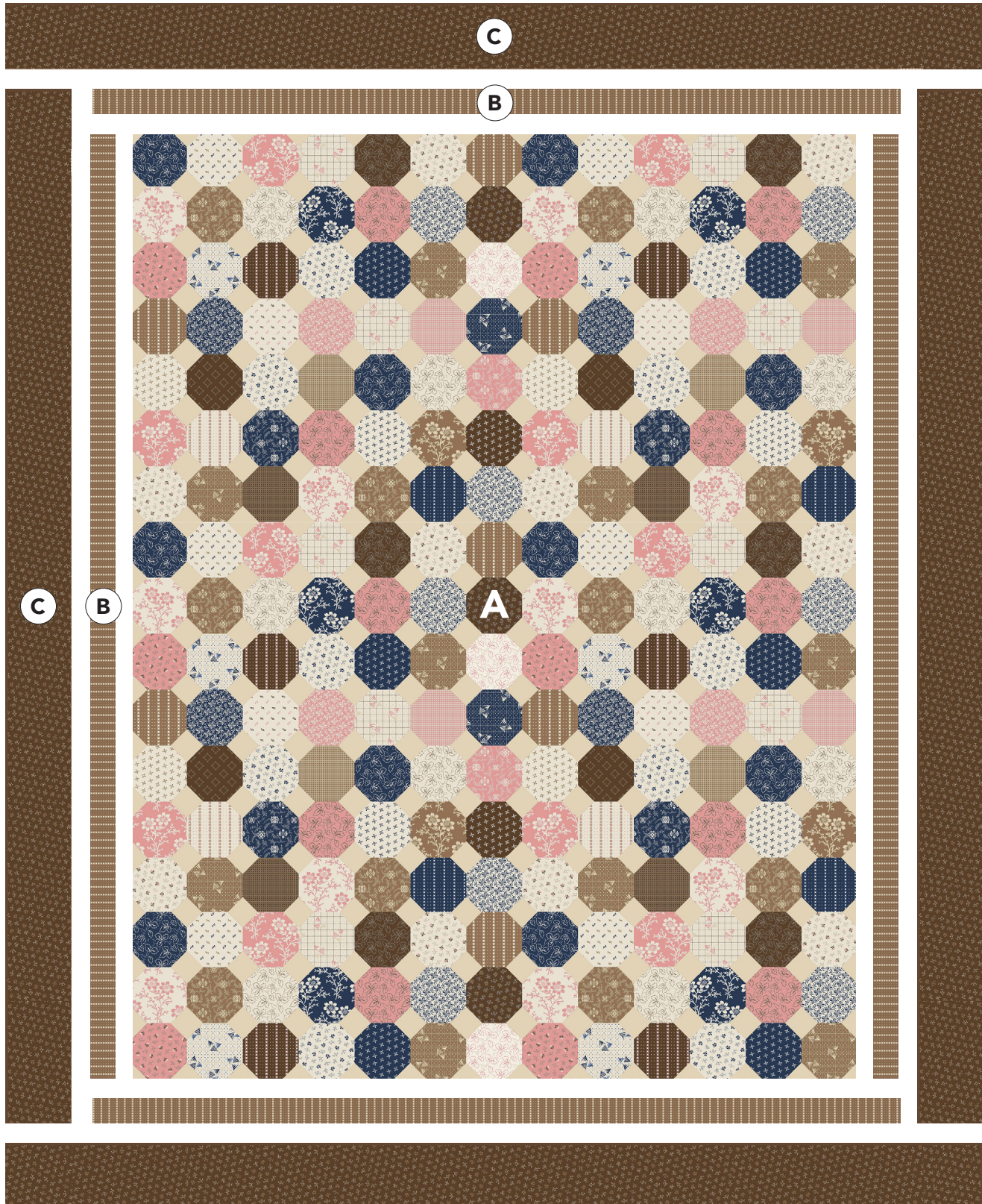
1. Inner Border: Sew the (6) B 2" x WOF strips together via short ends to make a long strip. Measure the length of your A center and cut (2) B strips to that length. Sew (1) B strip to opposite sides of A center. Measure the width of A/B center and cut (2) B strips to that length. Sew (1) B strip to the top and to the bottom of quilt center.

2. Outer Border: Sew the (7) C 4-1/2" x WOF together via short ends to make a long strip. Measure the length of the quilt center and cut (2) C strips to that length. Sew (1) C strip to opposite sides of quilt center. Measure the width of the A/B/C center and cut (2) C strips to that length. Sew (1) C strip to the top and to the bottom quilt top.



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QUILT ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **C** 2-1/4" strips.
